

Attention is drawn to the fact that the figures for the 3 months ended 31 March 2021 as reported in these financial results are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of the full previous financial year and the published year to date figures up to the third quarter of the previous financial year. The figures up to the end of the third quarter of previous financial year had only been reviewed and not subjected to audit.
6. Based on our review conducted and procedures performed as stated in paragraph 3 above and based on the consideration of the review reports of other auditors referred to in paragraph 7 below, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the aforesaid Indian Accounting Standard and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
7. We did not review the interim financial information of five subsidiaries included in the Statement, whose interim financial information reflect total revenues (before consolidation adjustments) of Rs. 9,141.16 lakhs, total net profit after tax (before consolidation adjustments) of Rs. 483.20 lakhs and other comprehensive income (before consolidation adjustments) of Rs. 51.36 lakhs, for the quarter ended 30 June 2021, respectively, as considered in the Consolidated Unaudited Financial Results. The interim financial information of these subsidiaries has been prepared in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in their respective countries. The Parent Company's Management has converted the interim financial information of these subsidiaries located outside India from accounting principles generally accepted in their respective countries to accounting principles generally accepted in India, which have been reviewed by us. The Consolidated Unaudited Financial Results also includes the Group's share of net loss after tax (and other comprehensive loss) (before consolidation




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adjustments) of Rs. 255.20 lakhs for the quarter ended 30 June 2021, as considered in the Statement, in respect of three joint ventures, whose interim financial information has not been reviewed by us.
