# NFR recovers Rs 23 Cr. from ticket-less travelers



**Assam Rising Guwahati, April 29:** In a bid to keep a check on unauthorized traveling, the Northeast Frontier Railway (NFR) has been conducting regular ticket checking drives. With these intensive ticket checking drives, this Railway has detected 448392 cases of passengers traveling without ticket/regular ticket and unbooked luggage during the period from April 2021 to March 2022. An amount of Rs. 23.36 crores was realized from the offenders as fine and penalty. This is about 840.83% more in terms of numbers of penalty cases detected and 1028.50% higher in terms of earnings for the corresponding period of previous year. Moreover during checking over various stations and trains, RPF of NFR apprehended 50701 persons traveling without proper tickets from April 2021 to March 2022. In these cases 25 persons were also prosecuted and fined under various sections of Railways Act and 16 cases were registered against offenders. North-east Frontier Railway regularly conducts drives against ticketless travelers. In its endeavour to provide better services to its bonafide rail users and also to curb ticketless traveling, NFR has regularly been taking necessary steps. NFR urges all rail users to buy proper railway tickets and travel with dignity. As per section 137, of the Indian Railway Act of 1989, traveling without ticket, improper ticket or unbooked luggage is an offense punishable by imprisonment or fine or both.

# Bribe case: Food inspector caught red handed

**Assam Rising, Nagon, April 29:** Binirneli KJ Karz, an food inspector working in the office of Joint Director Health Services, Nagon was caught red handed in the office itself today here by a team of Vigilance and Anti Corruption from Guwahati while accepting a bribe from a businessman. Sources claimed that Karz demanded Rs one lakh from the businessman for issuing a food security license and when Karz accepted Rs 10000 today from the businessman as the first instalment, he was caught red handed by the vigilance and anti corruption squad. Meanwhile the squad of the anti corruption department also seized various documents from the office and also conducted a raid at his Nagon Faudzaripatti residence, sources said, adding further

that the arrested food inspector was later brought to its headquarters in Guwahati for further investigation as well as legal proceedings. Significantly, Karz was working as food security inspector for Nagon, Morigaon, Hojai and West Karbi Anglong districts, sources added further.
