Govt readies draft guidelines to protect power consumers rights

New Delhi, September 16

THE POWER MINISTRY has prepared draft rules providing for rights of electricity consumers for the first time, an official statement said on Wednesday.

"Union power ministry in a historic pro-consumer move drafts Electricity (Rights of Consumers) Rules, 2020; invites suggestions/comments by September 30, 2020," the ministry said in the statement.

The objective is to provide consumers better services and facilities, it said adding that electricity consumers are the most important stakeholders in the power sector and the sector exists because of them.

Having provided access to electricity to all citizens, it is now important to focus on consumer satisfaction and for this, it is imperative to identify the key services, prescribe minimum service levels and standards with respect to these services and recognize them as rights of consumers, it noted.

The draft rules propose a

DBT for power sector may face operational challenges: Experts

THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT in the Electricity Act 2003 providing subsidy on power to farmers via direct benefit of transfer may not be practically possible, say experts.

In the draft amendment, the power ministry has proposed to initiate direct benefit transfers (DBT) in the power sector by making payment of

the subsidy into the accounts of consumers maintained by discoms and not directly into their bank accounts. "There will be operational challenges in its implementation. Whether the proposal is going to be a game changer or not, depends on when the subsidy is released on time," BSES Rajdhani Power CEO Amal Sinha said. —PTI

Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum with 2-3 representatives of consumers at various levels starting from sub-division.

The draft also pertains to timely and simplified procedure for connection. A person would require only two documents for connection up to a load of 10 kw, and no estimation of demand charges for load up to 150 kw to expedite giving connection. It also fixes the time period for providing connection. The time period will not exceed 7 days in metro

cities, 15 days in other municipal areas and 30 days in rural areas, to provide new connections and modify existing connections.

As per the draft, SERCs (State Electricity Regulatory Commission) will fix the average number and duration of outages per consumer per year for DISCOMs. Another feature of the draft rules is a 24x7 toll free call centre, web-based and mobile applications for common services like new connection and others.

Govt provided ₹5,000 cr to 2 cr building workers

LABOUR MINISTER SANTOSH Gangwar on Wednesday said the central government has taken a number of steps for the welfare of labourers during the pandemic, including disbursement of ₹5,000 crore relief to over 2 crore building and construction workers. Besides with efforts of the government, stuck wages of about ₹295 crore were released to about two lakh workers during Covid.

In statement issued by the labour ministry, Gangwar said, "a number of unprecedented steps have been taken by the union government for labour welfare and employment including for migrant workers across India during Covid-19 pandemic."

According to the statement, immediately after the lockdown, directions were sent from the ministry of labour & employment to all the states/UTs instructing them to provide financial assistance to construction workers. —PTI

European Commission seeks public comments on India's plea to register basmati rice under GI

THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION has sought public comments on India's plea to register the name 'Basmati' under geographical indication (GI). The GI application was filed by India in 2018.

Similar applications have also been filed by Agricultural & Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (Apeda) to register the aromatic rice variety under GI in Thailand and Malaysia. Considering the past instances of attempts to sell aromatic rice of other countries under basmati, registration under GI will help India to protect the name legally.

Apeda has also sought registration of 'Basmati' under copyright law in some 15-16 countries where there is no concept of GI, officials said.

Basmati rice is grown below the foothills of the Himalayas in the Indo-Gangetic plains, which include some areas in Pakistan also. However, the application by India does not mention Pak-



istan. The government recognises 34 Indian rice varieties, both traditional and evolved, as basmati while Pakistan has also a few more. The European Union, a major market for traditional varieties of basmati, has also been buying a large quantity of evolved varieties since last one decade.

India's basmati exports to EU countries dropped 9% to \$207 million during FY20 and was \$63.7 million in the first two months of the current fiscal. The EU had a share of about 8% in India's total basmati rice exports of \$787 million during April-May.

"Being an important application in international registration of Basmati rice, this will un-

dergo a detailed scrutiny and interpretation in the context of western, Asian and Bharatiya values. This will present opportunities and challenges in the context of 'construct of product' and current geopolitical environment to set the future history," said S Chandrasekaran, a trade policy analyst and author of a book on Basmati GI.

Chandrasekaran also wondered if the move to register in the EU would help India thwart the claim of Pakistan using this current matrix.

After a long battle, Apeda was able to get GI tag for basmati in 2018, when the GI registry dismissed Madhya Pradesh's plea for its inclusion

in the growing region of the aromatic rice variety saying there was no "corroborative evidence" to suggest that the variety was grown in the state. The Chennai-based Intellectual Property Appellate Board (IPAB) in February 2016 had directed the GI Registry to issue a certificate of registration to Apeda and reconsider the plea of inclusion of 13 districts of Madhya Pradesh.

Apeda, which had applied for the GI tag for basmati rice in 2008 and got the registration after seven years of legal battle, had moved the Intellectual Property Appellate Board in 2014 challenging GI Registrar's first decision (in December 2013) that directed it to file an amended GI application by all areas where basmati rice is cultivated, including Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and Bihar.

While other states stayed away from the legal battle, MP's chief minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan made it a political issue by raising it during assembly election and has since been pursuing it.

States asked to undertake relief steps as locust attacks declared natural disaster

THE MINISTRY OF HOME Affairs has now identified locust attacks as a natural disaster and has directed states to undertake relief operations under the State Disaster Response Fund as per established procedure and the norms for assistance.

Until now, no state government has reported distribution of relief to the farmers affected by the locust attack. Crop losses of farmers due to the attacks are now covered under the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY). The yield losses are assessed via crop cutting experiments and compensation are given to insured farmers as per the provisions of the scheme.

During 2020-21, the locust incursions were reported in 10 states of Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Punjab, Gujarat, Uttar Pradesh, Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Haryana and Uttarakhand, where operations were undertaken in coordination with the state governments for locust control.

The governments of Gujarat, Chhattisgarh, Punjab and Bihar have not reported any crop losses. However, Rajasthan has reported crop damage of 33% and more due to locust attack in 2,234.92 hectares area in Bikaner, 140 hectares in Hanumangarh and 1,027-hectares area in Sri Ganganagar.

The Haryana government has reported below 33% crop loss in approximately 6,166 hectares area, while Madhya Pradesh has reported 10% loss in soybean crop in 4,400 hectares in Damoh district, according to a statement given in the Parliament. The Maharashtra government reported below 33% of crop loss in 805.8-hectares area in Nagpur, Bhandara, Gondiya and Amravati districts. The government of Uttarakhand also reported a loss of 2 hectares (5% loss) in Pithoragarh district.

Rajasthan has further issued instructions for surveying to estimate crop losses. The Uttar Pradesh government has also issued orders to field units for submitting the status of crop losses. Significantly a high-level virtual meeting on Desert Locust in Southwest Asian countries was held in early March with representatives of four member countries (Afghanistan, India, Iran and Pakistan) and the Plant Protection Division of FAO, Rome participated in the meeting. Subsequently, 24 virtual meetings of technical officers of member countries have been held so far via skype for sharing of strategic information on actual status, movement and control of locust in member countries.

Accordingly, the pest attack has been notified as a natural disaster by the Ministry of Home Affairs and States can undertake relief operations under the State Disaster Response Fund as per established procedure and the norms for assistance.

Oxygen-starved Pune hospitals choke

OXYGEN-STARVED PUNE hospitals, especially the smaller hospitals and rural hospitals, are facing a huge challenge in dealing with the deluge of Covid-19 cases, which has led to a spike in its demand. This has, in turn, resulted in an acute shortage of oxygen supply in

the district and has crippled operations at many hospitals. This is one of the reasons why hospitals are refusing to admit new patients.

At 83,809, Pune has the highest number of active cases in the country and the pandemic has spread into rural parts of Pune district. A majority of the patients from the rural areas are seeking treatment in city

hospitals and occupying close to 28% of the beds, data shared by the Pune divisional commissioner revealed.

Pune has till now reported 2.41 lakh positive cases and is adding between 3,500 and 4,500 cases every day. The largest state-run hospital providing Covid-treatment — the Sassoon Hospital — has stopped admitting patients till

work on augmenting the oxygen system is done. Many patients had to move out to a newly created hospital after oxygen supply at Sassoon was disrupted.

The hospital had a 13-tonne oxygen supply tank but it could not cope with the huge pressure because of the spike in demand. It developed technical glitches. The Maharashtra gov-

ernment has asked the oxygen suppliers to reserve 80% of their production for hospitals and only 20% for industries, but this may not be enough.

Sudhir Mehta, lead and coordinator, Pune Platform for Covid-19 Response (PPCR), said there were 20 to 50 times jump in requirement of oxygen to treat Covid-19 patients.

Even if only 5% of the 80,000 active cases in Pune require oxygen, there was a huge spike in demand that cannot be met instantly.

Ahmedabad-Gandhinagar Metro project faces Covid hurdle

THE ₹1600-CRORE Ahmedabad-Gandhinagar metro rail project will further be delayed by at least a couple of years due to Covid-19 pandemic situation as agencies working for the project are facing labour shortage as well as financial crunch.

Sources in Gujarat Metro Rail Corporation (GMRC), a special purpose vehicle (SPV) earlier known as Metro-Link Express for Gandhinagar and Ahmedabad (MEGA), said till March first week, work for ₹10,700-crore 41-km-long Phase-I was underway in full-

swing, but due to nationwide lockdown it completely stopped till April end.

However, work recommenced as part of unlockdown process from May, but to date, most of the agencies are working hardly at 50% capacity.

"The agencies engaged in the work related to the project are facing a shortage of labourers as most of them are migrants. Moreover, most of the agencies are facing financial crunch, too," said a senior official of GMRC.

Metro services on 6.5-km route between Apparel Park and Vastral station started ahead of the Lok Sabha elec-

developed in two phases.

Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) has extended a soft loan of ₹6,000 crore for the ambitious project. According to sources, the cost of the project was around ₹3,500 crore at the time of conceptualisation in 2003.

Now the cost of the entire project (Phase-I & II) has been scaled up to approximately ₹1,600 crore.

"Phase-I comprises two corridors. The north-south corridor from Agriculture Produce Market Committee (APMC) to Motera will cover 18.87 km. The 2.1.16 km-long east-west corridor would connect Vastral

station in east to Thaltej in western Ahmedabad. We were aiming to complete Phase-I by July, but due to Covid-19 and other reasons it would be delayed by at least a couple of years," said the official.

The 2.8.2 km-long Phase-II would connect the twin cities of Ahmedabad and Gandhinagar. The work for the ₹5500 crore Phase-II would take even more time.

According to the Ahmedabad-Gandhinagar metro rail blueprint, there will be many as 54 stations. Of these stations, 32 would be part of Phase-I and 22 will be constructed during the second phase.

Notes:

- These Financial results have been prepared in accordance with recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standards prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India.
- The financial results for the quarter ended 30th June 2020 were reviewed by the Audit Committee on 15.09.2020 and approved by the Board of Directors in its meeting held on 15.09.2020.
- In view of the default by the company in paying due interest amount to the banks, STC was declared NPA. The lender banks have initiated DRT proceedings against the company which is likely to be withdrawn soon and Syndicate bank also initiated NCLT proceedings, which have been withdrawn on 11.12.2019. The company is in the process of finalizing the OTS proposal with the lender banks and has already paid Rs. 1100 crore against the dues of Rs. 1906.24 crore as on 31.12.2018. Subsequent to the high level meeting dated 29.08.2019, the OTS with banks shall be completed upon transfer of immovable properties worth Rs. 300 Crore. The DRT proceedings are in the process of being withdrawn and OTS agreement is in final stages and is being vigorously followed up by the Company at appropriate level.
- Out of the total trade receivable of Rs. 1117.11 Crore includes Rs. 973.19 Crore "having significant increase in credit risk" being under dispute/litigation. Trade receivables, against which dispute/legal proceedings are under process, have been considered as "Having Significant increase in credit risk". The company feels that even if no amount would eventually be recovered, no credit impairment is required for the credit risk since the creditor will be paid by the company only to the extent the amount is realized from the debtors. Further, for the remaining balance of Rs. 143.92 Crore approx. is recoverable hence no provision is considered necessary.
- Contingent Liability includes a demand of Rs. 132.32 Crore raised by L&DO vide its letter no. L&DO/LS2A/9225/133 dated 26th March 2018 from 2004-05 onwards for non-compliance of various conditions of the Lease Deed (including non-deposits of 25% of the gross rent received by STC from its tenants). However, the company has taken up for waiver of liability with L&DO.
- The Company is a CPSE under administrative control of the Ministry of Commerce & Industry. The Company is a trading organization to undertake promotion of export and market intervention operations in commodities specified by Government of India from time to time. For last few years the company is facing mismatch in inflows and outflows of funds due to huge recoverable from associates with whom the company had undertaken trade transactions in the past and who had defaulted in making timely payment to STC. Due to this the Company has led to temporary financial crunch, operating losses, reduction of net worth. Simultaneously the company initiated legal action against the defaulting associates. One of the major associates has made sufficient payment to STC on direction of Hon'ble Supreme Court. This has eased out the financial crisis of the Company to some extent. The Company is in process of One Time Settlement (OTS) with the lender banks and an amount of Rs. 1100 Crore was paid towards OTS. The lender banks had proceeded in NCLT/DRT against the Company. The proceeding in NCLT Court has since been withdrawn. Simultaneously, the company has undertaken various cost reduction measures to improve the liquidity/profitability such as closure of unviable branches, undertaking trade in commodities fetching higher trade margins without involvement of STC's funds, etc. Subsequent upon the high level meeting dated 29.08.2019, Presently, the Company is undertaking the business without involvement of own funds. The status will be revisited during the current financial year. Considering the facts given above,
 - Accounts for the period ended June 30, 2020 have been prepared on going concern basis.
 - The company is continuing to carry forward deferred tax assets, which will be available for set off against future profits.
 - No provision for impairment of non-current assets has been considered necessary.
 - Depreciation is being computed on the basis of expected economic life of fixed assets rather than their current market value.
- As a matter of accounting prudence, Deferred Tax Assets for the period ended 30.06.2020 have not been recognized.
- Impact of COVID-19: There was a nation-wide lockdown imposed during the end of March, 2020 due to COVID-19. There was partial lifting of the lockdown since 03.05.2020. The Company has resumed operations at corporate office and branch offices with minimal staff after adopting safety measures and following standard operating procedures mandated by Govt. of India like disinfection of office premises, keeping social distancing, work-from-home with minimal attendance. Despite the constraints of lockdown, the Company ensured timely deliveries of essential items viz. edible oil, pulses and sugar for on-going contracts for supply to the Tamil Nadu Civil Supplies Corporation through e-processing procedure during lockdown. However, due to the unpredictable and continuing impact of Covid-19 situation, it is very difficult to assess the future impact of Covid-19 on the financial performance and business operations at this juncture. Further, the company does not foresee any significant impairment to the carrying value of its assets, which is dependent on market conditions.
- Figures of the previous period have been recasted /reclassified to make them comparable with those of the current period wherever necessary.
- Figures for the quarter ended 31st March 2020 are the balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of full financial year and the published year to date figures upto 3rd quarter of that Financial Year.

संपादकीय पवारांची खेळी यशस्वी
