Staff association seeks panel to assist students, St Stephen's After student suicide, principal says no need

A DEMAND by the Staff Association of St Stephen's College, to constitute a committee comprising the heads of all courses to "consider needs" for financial assistance to students, has been shot down by the Principal, who said it will "not be required" and that they could only recommend cases of "deserving students".

In his email response to the Staff Association president Nandita Narain, Principal John Varghese also said he was "disappointed" by the email and that it was "least required". He said "collective responsibility" was the need of the day, and that the pandemic was not the time for "pettifoggery" and "one-upmanship".

Narain said she raised the issue again at a Finance Committee meeting Friday. By evening, the bursar put out a notice inviting applications from second and third year students "for a limited number of college bursaries". To apply, the applicants need to have a first division and family income below Rs 5 lakh per annum. They should also not have any other scholarship above Rs 20,000 per month.

Narain had Thursday written to Varghese asking him to constitute the committee, and also consider the possibility of distributing laptops to those in need. The letter also referred to the suicide of a DU student "as a result of financial distress and lack of institutional support". Aishwarya Reddy (19), a second-year Lady Shri Ram College student, had

committed suicide on November 2 at her Telangana home. Her family couldn't afford a laptop for her to attend online classes.

In his response, Varghese said, "Please be informed that the college and every working part of the college administration/community has ONLY the interest of the students at heart... I feel a little disappointed that a communication of the kind that you have sent was done. It is least required."

"The college administration." including the Principal and the Bursar, are most accessible and, in fact, a recent communication by the Bursar also bears out the fact that some student issues pertaining to fees have been addressed. There has been no instance where a student has ever been turned away for want of funds; in fact the administration has only sought ways and means to ensure that our students face no problems, especially when it comes to academics," he added.

Varghese said that the sugges-

tion for "Heads (of departments) being given the responsibility of forming a committee to handle bursaries...will not be required".

"Heads may recommend the case/s of deserving students and the office of the Bursar will do whatever it takes to ensure that our students enjoy the benefits of an uninterrupted study to help them move on with their stud-

"This time of the pandemic is certainly not one to indulge in pettifoggery, one-upmanship or try to pull in different directions. The focus must be, will be on the students and they alone will be the centre of our focus," he added.

On the possibility of distributing laptops, Bursar Renish Abraham had told The Indian Express Thursday, "We used to issue laptops to students while they were on campus, but now since laptops are provided by the university, I don't think we can send it to their residence... Probably we need to have a policy on this."

LSR announces fee cuts, hostel relaxation

MORE THAN a week after the Lady Shri Ram (LSR) College Students' Union submitted a 12point memorandum to the principal in light of the suicide of Aishwarya Reddy (19), a secondyear student of the college due to financial hardships, college authorities Friday announced they had accepted some demands, including reducing the fee for courses, setting up a committee to provide laptops to students, and allowing some second-year

students to reside in hostels. The Union called this a "partial victory" but said many demands were yet to be achieved.

A document titled "response to the demands met by students", uploaded on the college website, read, "Given the fact that students are not able to avail certain facilities of the college due to being off-campus, the College has removed such charges from the fees this year. This has led to a substantial reduction in the fees... In addition, it is possible to pay the fee in installments."

A revised fee notice states that the annual fee for all courses for second- and third-vear students will now be Rs 7,970. LSR Students' Union general secretary Unnimaya said the fee ranged from Rs 12,000 to Rs

26,000 depending on the course. "While the fee has been revised, it is not transparent under which heads the charges have been waived off. The college authorities should clarify that," she said.

LSR also decided that "keeping in mind the exceptional circumstances of the Covid pandemic, and for one year only" current second years "who lived in the hostel, upon fresh application" and "on the basis of need", will be allowed to stay in the hostel "after the Hostel's commitments to incoming first years and the current third years, who already are in the Hostel, have been met".

"When the pandemic recedes and the situation normalises and hostel seats are once again 288 in number, the College

some more students of the second and third year in the hostel, on the basis of need, during their remaining years of study," the document read.

The college also said it would be removing a sentence which says a student "will not participate in any activity seeking to prolong my/her tenure at the hostel" from the hostel registration form, as it has been "misquoted as preventing students from participating in all protest".

"A committee has been constituted to ensure that each student who needs a device is provided one and each department is in the process of creating a list of students requiring devices and their addresses. The college committee will ensure that these are procured and distributed to all students who need these at the earliest possible," the college said.

However, in its email to the principal, students' union wrote: Regarding this committee, please clearly mention who all are in it, what is their status of work and what is being done by them on priority and kindly mention the deadline by which you will meet the requirements of students since examinations for the students are less than a month away.

Weekend cold wave as city sees frostiest Nov since 2006

A COLD wave is forecast in Delhi on Saturday and Sunday as the minimum temperature on Friday dropped to 7.5 degrees Celsius, lowest for the season so far this year and five degrees below normal.

For the month of November, this is the lowest reading of mercury at night time since 2006, as per India Meteorological Department (IMD).

Minimum temperature last fell below this mark at the IMD's Safdarjung observatory, which is representative of the city, on November 29, 2006 when it was 7.3 degrees Celsius.

Kuldeep Srivastava, head of the IMD's regional weather forecasting centre in Delhi, said, "We are receiving cold winds from northern areas that have witnessed snowfall in the past few days. Delhi also has clear skies at present, which is causing higher radiation and faster cooling at night time."

Srivastava added that areas Himachal Pradesh. Uttarakhand and Jammu & Kashmir had witnessed snowfal earlier this week and winds from these regions were influencing Delhi's temperature.

He said that by Sunday, the minimum temperature is expected to reach 7 degrees Celsius. "Cold wave conditions could persist on Saturday and Sunday, after which the minimum temperature is expected to rise," Srivastava said.

In plains, the IMD's crit

for cold wave is when the minimum temperature is 10 degrees Celsius or lower and the departure from normal temperature is below 4.5 degrees for two days.

Celsius on November 4 to 25.4 degrees Celsius on Friday, two degrees below normal. Meanwhile, the average air quality index (AQI) of Delhi de-

Woman forcibly sent to rehab, court orders probe

THE DELHI High Court has directed the CBI to conduct a preliminary inquiry into the affairs of a Dehradun-based drug rehabilitation centre where a 22-yearold Delhi woman was allegedly detained for at least 22 days on the request of her mother, who objected to her relationship with a married man from a different faith. Delhi Police has also been directed to register an FIR against the centre, its director and others responsible for her illegal deten-

The division bench of Justices Vipin Sanghi and Rajnish

ine "the complete records, activities and ongoings" at Golden Dream Society Rehabilitation Centre, Dehradun, and register a case, if it is made out, under provisions of law. The possibility of the centre being misused for the purpose of forcibly detaining people on the ground that they require rehabilitation cannot be ruled out, said the court.

The order has been passed in a habeas corpus filed earlier this month by a friend of the detained woman. The court was told the 22-year-old was engaged in a property dispute with her mother and was missing since October 17. Delhi Police, in a status report, told the court on November 9 that she

was admitted to a rehabilitation centre as she was addicted to drugs – a claim challenged by her friend, who said it was her brother who was undergoing rehabilitation there once.

The story unfolded on November 12, when the 22-yearold was produced before the court through video-conferencing. Stating that she was not addicted to any substance, the woman told the court she was illegally detained. The rehabilitation centre's director, Vikas Bisht, conceded before the court she was not suffering from any addiction and does not require rehabilitation. It was also revealed that the centre charged Rs 8,000 from the woman's mother, who had laid down conditions for her daughter's release.

After an interaction with the mother, the court came to the conclusion that "her real concern" is that her daughter is "in relation with... a married man with two children". She told the court he had been "exploiting" the 22-year-old for the past 2.5 years.

The court in the order said it has "counselled" the woman separately and she stated that she "does not wish to have any alliance" with either the man or her mother. The court directed police to ensure her release from the centre, noting that she is a major.

Meanwhile, the HC also took note of Delhi Police's failure to act on complaints made by the mother at police stations in Bindapur and Shahdara regarding threats issued to her and her son by the man who was allegedly in a relationship with her daughter. "Unfortunately, this is the usual trend...People who come from the poorer strata of the society hardly ever are heard by the police and their complaints remain unactioned," said the court, as it noted no FIR had been registered and no action had been taken.

Directing the police commissioner to take action "against erring officials", the HC asked him to ensure that appropriate action is taken on the complaints filed by the mother and that the man does not come to her residence or loiter around the place.

Concentration of PM2.5, which has a 24-hour exposure limit of $60 \mu g/m3$, was found to be close to 1,000 µg/m3 on November 10 and around 700 ug/m3 on November 14.

While the analysis attributed

this spike in PM2.5 to mainly crop residue burning in Punjab and Haryana, it also stated that high humidity and low temperature cause smaller PM1 particles to merge and form secondary particles of larger size. Professor Arun Sharma of the University College of Medical Sciences, DU, said, 'Particles of size 1 micron or less are more harmful as they can cross the mucus barrier and, through blood circulation, reach any organ and cause damage or increase the risk of cancer."

As per the analysis, composition of PM1 and smaller particles mainly "contain trace elements" that create a "carcinogenic risk".

Man alleges forced conversion by wife and her parents

New Delhi: A 28-year-old man has filed a complaint against his wife and her family for allegedly forcing him to convert to Islam. Police said the complainant, Mohit, has named his wife Nazreen, her parents Fareed and Shaheen, and uncle Ahmad. The FIR has been filed under sections of criminal intimidation, cheating by personation, extortion and outraging religious feelings. PK Mishra, DCP (Rohini), said the

Police said the woman and her family had also filed a dowry case against Mohit last year. As per the FIR, Mohit claims he met Nazreen on Facebook two years ago and she told him she is Hindu. "Five days before the wedding, I came to know she is Muslim. She told me that she's ready to be a Hindu... Later, she and her parents called me to Ghonda in UP and harassed me. They told me to give them Rs 80,000 and locked me in a hotel," he alleges, adding that they also coerced him to convert, ENS

THE FOOD MINISTRY on Friday said it had given in-principle approval to 185 sugar mills and stand-alone distilleries to avail ₹12,500 crore of loans for capacity addition of about 468 crore litre of ethanol per annum as part of its efforts to achieve 20% blending with petrol.

In the last two years, 70 ethanol projects were sanctioned loans of ₹3,600 crore.

Apart from promoting ethanol production from sugarcane, the ministry is making efforts to manufacture ethanol using surplus rice with stateowned FCI as well as maize. The move is aimed at boosting ethanol blending with petrol, which currently stands at nearly 5%.

MNRE proposes 54 GW wind park scheme for states

TOADDRESSTHE land-related hassles in wind power projects, the Union ministry of new and renewable energy (MNRE) is planning a wind energy park development scheme.

As part of the same, states

will prepare the necessary infrastructure for wind power project developers under the plug- and-play model. MNRE will provide financial assis $tance \ of \ \ \ \ 20 \ lakh \ per megawatt$ (MW) to park developers for preparing the sites — involving land, transmission connectivity and other necessary approvals — required for wind plant installations. The park developers will be designated by states.

MNRE proposed the scheme in a recently released concept note. Though auctions for solar and wind parks have traditionally been done by the central government agencies, MNRE noted that a number of such projects have been delayed due to hurdles over land availability, NoCs and transmission-related issues. MNRE has already identified potential wind park zones

across Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Gujarat, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh and Telangana, with a potential of about 54,000 MW (54 GW) of new wind plants under the scheme.

Wind plant now comprise about 43% of the total installed renewable energy capacity of 89 GW. Annual wind capacity addition has slowed down from 3.4 GW in FY16 to 2.1 GW in FY20. The total installed power generation capacity of the country is 373 GW, of which 62% are thermal power plants.

The policy also allows states to build wind-solar hybrid parks in the earmarked areas, if they choose to do so. Though wind power spear-

headed India's renewable energy growth until 2015, it has begun to lose its sheen, particularly its share in capacity additions."In recent years, the sector has been plagued by weakening monsoons, land availability issues, financial weaknesses of discoms, with ensuing payment delays, and an increase in market risks," a recent report by the Climate Policy Initiative said.

Govt releases back-end code of Aarogya Setu

THE GOVERNMENT ON Friday released the back-end code of Aarogya Setu in the open domain that will help people understand the functioning of the Covid-19 contact-tracing app and allay apprehensions they may have around privacy and security. The source code of the

Android and iOS versions of the Aarogya Setu app was released earlier and the backend source code has been released in accor dance with the government policy to share all code repositories with the developer community, the Ministry of Electronics and IT (MeitY) said in a statement. "Releasing back-end code will help people in understanding the complete functioning of the app. This will clear any doubt that they have regarding privacy and security of their data," a MeitY official explained.

MeitY has released the backend code of Aarogya Setu on the OpenForge platform set up by the government to promote sharing and reuse of e-governance application source codes. Aarogya Setu was launched on April 2 with active involvement of the best of the minds from the Indian industry, academia and government, it said.

CBI, I-T find bureaucratic, political nexus in illegal coal mining

FE BUREAU Kolkata, November 20

THE INCOMETAX (I-T) department and the CBI have found nexus of certain bureaucrats, Eastern Coalfields officials and some politicians in allowing illegal coal mining, tightening the noose around those involved in these operations.

A highly placed CBI official told FE that there are orders from the home ministry to stop the flow of political funding from illegal sources, which has prompted both the I-T department and the CBI to take actions against the illegal miners.

Illegal coal mining, carried out in the abandoned mines of the Eastern Coalfields in the Pandebeswar, Salanpur, Kajora, Sripur, JK Nagar, Kurus-

toria, Khaskenda, Neokonda, Harishpur and Haripur areas, has been estimated to be a thriving business of around ₹800 -1000 crore. Although ECL has done GPS fencing in all its operational mines and every truck leaving, loaded with coal, is fitted with GPS tracking system, illegal activities continue by digging rat holes putting miners' lives at great risks, the CBI official said.

Generally tunnels are dug far from the mines and miners have to get into deep seams to get coal since ECL has already abandoned

those mines after extracting coal from the upper seams. Coal from

such mines are generally of high quality and it caters to the need of more than 250 small and big sponge-iron units in the Durgapur-Asansol belt, supporting livelihood of at least a million people.

The I-T department, after raiding the office of




Anup Majhee — the current kingpin of illegal coal mining at Nituria in Purulia a few weeks ago, had established his links with cross-border cow smuggling.Accordingly the CBI nabbed the cattle smuggling king pins, Enamul Haque and Anarul Seikh followed by the arrest of Satish Kumar, a BSF commandant, alleged to have facilitated cattle smuggling.

A CBI source said there had been traces of money from illegal mining channeled to the bank accounts of some IPS officers' family. Around ₹80 crore per month goes into political funding.

Although the CBI has not been able to arrest Majhee yet, it is in search of six more people whose links have been traced with illegal coal mining from the files seized from Majhee's office.


