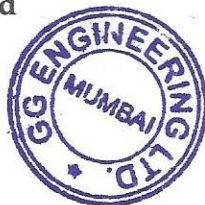

Muchhad Paanwala, Mumbai's millionaire paan seller, arrested by NCB in drug case

Ram Kumar Tiwari, the famous Muchhad Paanwala from Mumbai, has been arrested in a drug case by the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB). He was questioned by the agency on Monday.

Mumbai Muchhad Paanwala, Mumbai's millionaire and famous paan seller at Kemps Corner, who was questioned by the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) on Monday, has been arrested in a drug case. Muchhad Paanwala was arrested on Tuesday following hours of interrogation by the agency. Muchhad Paanwala's name had come up after the NCB busted a major marijuana smuggling racket and arrested a British national and two women from Bandra, Mumbai in connection with a Marijuana supply ring case. Brothers Ram Kumar Tiwari and Jaishankar Tiwari run the famous Muchhad Paan shop at Kemps Corner. While Jaishankar, too, was questioned on Monday, the NCB has arrested only Ram Kumar for drug peddling. He will be produced in court today. Jaishankar Tiwari, too, is known as Muchhad Paanwala. The NCB had on Monday also questioned Jaishankar Tiwari. The two brothers run shops for six months each. Both of them are

famous millionaire paan vendors from South Mumbai and had been called in connection with Marijuana ring busted by the agency on Saturday. The questioning which started on Monday morning went on till late evening. Sources from the NCB confirmed that a scheduled NDPS substance was recovered from Muchhad Paanwala's shop located in the upscale Kemp's Corner locality of South Mumbai. Post recovery of the scheduled substance, Tiwari was summoned to the NCB office where he arrived at around 10:30 am. How did Muchhad Paanwala's name come up in drug probe? On Saturday, the NCB officials arrested a British national and two women from Bandra in Mumbai in connection with a Marijuana supply ring case. During the interrogation, the accused revealed the drug was being supplied to Muchhad Paanwala at Kemps Corner in South Mumbai. It was then the NCB summoned Muchhad Paanwala in the

drug probe. Who is Muchhad Paanwala? People queue up at the Muchhad paan shop in large numbers to buy paan from the famous vendor. The number of customers is so high that Tiwari has employed several people just to roll paan along with his brother at the shop. The shop has been running since the '70s in Mumbai and has been a very famous name. Muchhad Paanwala caters to Bollywood stars, businessmen and also industrialists residing in the plush upscale Kemp's Corner locality of South Mumbai. Tiwari is said to have come to Mumbai in 1977 and started helping his father in the paan vending business. Since then, his clientele grew and his shop became famous amongst locals. Even tourists visit the paan shop which also has its own website. The paan shop also receives orders on online food ordering portals. Tiwari drives a Mercedes and the paan served at his shop are also catered at some of the major events and functions.

Nepal PM KP Sharma Oli says this about Gayatri Mantra

The Nepalese Prime Minister referred to the Gayatri Mantra as the 'mantra of mantras' and said that the country is very proud of its history.



New Delhi: Nepal's Prime Minister KP Sharma Oli recently raised some issues that have created confusion in the age-old relationship between the two South Asian nations. In an exclusive interview with Zee News Editor-in-Chief Sudhir Chaudhary, Prime Minister KP Sharma Oli opened his heart and spoke on different subjects (in Hindi) to convey his sentiments and his understanding of the ancient ties between the two nations as a historian, taking pride in the rich and variegated history of Nepal.

The Nepalese Prime Minister referred to the Gayatri Mantra as the 'mantra of mantras' and said that the country is very proud of its history. "Surely we are proud of our nation, the history of our nation and what our nation gave to the world. Gayatri Mantra is the 'mantra of mantras'. It was written by Kaushika Rishi (Vishwamitra) in Chatra, on the banks of the Kosi river in Nepal. Knowledge was discovered from here, era was invented from here, therefore we have things to

be proud of." Rishi Vishwamitra is considered to be one of the most revered rishis (sages) of ancient India. As per the holy Puranas, there have only been 24 Rishis in India who have the Gayatri Mantra. It is believed that Sage Vishwamitra is the first saint of the 24 saints, and Sage Yajnavalkya the last. Rishi Vishwamitra was born as 'Kaushika' and was the great-grandson of a great sage king, known as Kusha. He was born to Gadhi, one of the four sons of Kusha. Kaushika was one of the names of Vishwamitra who was supposed to have lived in Mithila (presently in Nepal's Terai and India's Bihar) where his sister river Koshi or Kosi still flows turbulently. Vishwamitra is credited with writing many well-known Vedic Hymns on the Banks of the Kosi where he had his hermitage - The Mandala 3, the Rigveda, and the Gayatri Mantra. KP Oli also said the resolution of outstanding issues between India and Nepal would pave a way for better development and further cementation of the ties between the two sovereign nations, which should progress independently respecting each other.

IMD issues Orange alert for Delhi, Punjab, Rajasthan, predicts severe cold wave conditions

NEW DELHI: Delhi's minimum temperature dropped to 4.3 degrees Celsius on Tuesday (January 12), and is likely to dip further in the coming days, the India Meteorological Department (IMD) said. According to reports, the weatherman issued an Orange alert for the national capital along with Punjab, Haryana and Rajasthan, predicting severe to very severe cold condition in these states today. The Sadfarjung Observatory, which provides representative data for the city, recorded a minimum of 4.3 degrees Celsius, three notches below normal, an IMD official said. Delhi had been registering

above normal minimum temperatures till Monday, as a cloud cover persisted over the city under the influence of successive Western Disturbances. The mercury is set to drop further. Moderate to dense fog is also predicted over the capital on Thursday and Friday, the IMD official said. Meanwhile, parts of Tamil Nadu received heavy rainfall on Tuesday, which is likely to continue till January 14, said IMD. "Very heavy rainfall has been reported at Atriramapattinam (13.5cm) of Tamil Nadu, Ariyalur (10 cm), Nagapattinam (8 cm) and Karaikal (6.3 cm) during 0830 hours IST of January 11 to 0530 hrs

Haryana, Chandigarh and Delhi. In another tweet, IMD stated, "It is very likely that cold day/severe cold day conditions at some/many pockets of Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh and Delhi, northwest Uttar Pradesh and north Rajasthan are observed during the next 3 days and cold wave/severe cold wave conditions at isolated pockets also very likely over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh and Delhi, northwest Uttar Pradesh and north Rajasthan during next 3-4 days." On January 14, the temperature in the capital will reduce again, dipping to about 5 degrees Celsius. There might also be dense fog conditions," the IMD said.

IMD forecasts cold wave condition in Delhi, Haryana, Punjab

New Delhi Delhi and its adjoining areas are set to experience cold to severe cold day on Tuesday. According to the India Meteorological Department (IMD), Delhi, Haryana, Chandigarh and Punjab will witness cold wave conditions at several places. The IMD forecast that the maximum and minimum temperatures in Delhi s expected to be around 18 and 7 degrees Celsius respectively. "Mainly clear sky, mist/ shallow fog in the morning. Strong surface winds (speed 20-25 kmph) during the day," the IMD said.
 Around 5:30 am on Tuesday, the temperature in Palam was at 6.8 degrees Celcius, while in Safdarjung, it was at 5.8 degrees Celcius. Meanwhile, the air quality in Delhi is in the poor category with an over Air Quality Index (AQI) at 225, according to Safar. The air quality is likely to improve on Wednesday. The Meteorological (MeT) Department had on Monday issued a yellow alert as cold weather conditions prevailed in north India. Delhi recorded a minimum temperature of 7 degrees Celsius, which likely drop further, and Punjab and Haryana reeled under cold weather conditions on Monday. Uttar Pradesh witnessed dry weather and a few places in Himachal Pradesh witnessed sub-zero temperatures. The MeT also issued a yellow alert for cold wave in several areas for the next 24 hours.
 The MeT department had forecast that due to the prevalence of dry northwesterly winds, the minimum temperature is very likely to gradually fall by 2-4 degrees Celsius over most parts of northwest India during the next 3-4 days, which is very likely to cause severe cold conditions at some parts of Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Delhi, northwest Uttar Pradesh and north Rajasthan.



First Covishield vaccines consignment leaves Serum Institute, set to reach 13 locations

NEW DELHI: A decisive phase in India's fight against coronavirus began in the wee hours on Tuesday as the first consignment of Covishield vaccines left Serum Institute of India for Pune airport, four days ahead of the nationwide inoculation drive launch. Three temperature-controlled trucks rolled out of the Serum Institute gates shortly before 5 am and left for Pune airport, from where the vaccines will be flown across India. The trucks carried 478 boxes of the vaccines, each box weighing 32 kg, a source involved in the vaccine transport arrangements told news agency PTI. The trucks left the Serum Institute of India premises at Manjari and reached the airport, located 15 km from the facility.

From the airport, the vaccines will be dispatched to 13 locations across the country by 10 am, the source said. A 'puja' was performed before the vehicles left the facility. The locations where these Covishield vaccines will be flown from Pune include Delhi, Ahmedabad, Kolkata, Chennai, Bengaluru, Karnal, Hyderabad, Vijayawada, Guwahati, Lucknow, Chandigarh and Bhubaneswar. The vaccines will be flown from Pune in eight commercial flights, including two cargo flights, the source said. The first cargo flight will cover Hyderabad, Vijayawada, and Bhubaneswar and the second cargo flight will go to Kolkata and Guwahati, he added. The consignment for Mumbai will leave by road. Trucks belonging to Kool-ex Cold Chain Ltd are being used to ferry the vaccine stocks from Serum Institute.
