Issue of Takeover Notice by SICOM LIMITED under section 29 of State Financial Corporation Act, 1951 to the company for recovery of its dues The "Going Concern' status of the Company is not affected as physical possession of the assets have not been taken.
		The company could not make payments to SICOM LIMITED due to severe financial crunch caused by sharp decline in sales year over year because of failure on the part of SICOM Ltd to realise the dues from some of the approved vendors. However the management of the company is making their sincere efforts to settle the dues to SICOM LIMITED. The sales turnover of the Company has also improved substantially over the previous year. Non-provision of doubtful debts amounting to Rs. 20,41,57,589/- and to that extent the loss for the year is understated.
		The company has issued legal notice to some of it customers. The management is hopeful for realisation of amount from its customers gradually and hence no provision is made in the accounts.
		Non-compliance of AS-15 with regard to Accounting of Retirement Benefits, except Provident Fund. The exact amount in respect of these benefits is not provided in the accounts as no actuarial valuation in respect of these benefits is made by the Company.
