Karnataka BJP MLA, sons get 2-yr jail for corruption

Bengaluru: BJP MLA Nehru Olekar, his two sons and six associates have been sentenced to two-year imprisonment on charges of corruption. The case dates back to 2009-11 when the BJP was in power in Karnataka and Olekar, MLA from Haveri city in north Karnataka, used his position to get civil contracts granted to his sons for the utilisation of Rs 1 crore of MLA funds available to him. "The accused No.1 has abused his position as a public servant and dishonestly and fraudulently obtained pecuniary advantage to his children by creating false work done certificate..." the special court ruled on Monday. Day after woman & daughter die, two held, SDM, cops booked for murder

ADAY after a 46-year-old woman and her 22-year-old daughter were killed during an anti-encroachment drive at Madauli village in Kanpur Dehat district of Uttar Pradesh, police on Tuesday registered a murder FIR against 39 people, including sub-divisional magistrate (SDM), lekhpal (revenue officer) and the station house officer of the local police station. Police have also arrested two persons - lekhpal Ashok Singh and the driver of the bulldozer Deepak.

While the family of the women claimed that officials set fire to their thatched house on Monday causing the death of Pramila Dixit and her daughter Neha, the district administration denied the charge and instead claimed that the two women set fire to their hut after locking it from inside.

On a complaint lodged by Pramila's son, Shivam, police registered the FIR under IPC sections 302 (murder), 307 (attempt to murder), 436 (mischief by fire with intent to destroy house, etc), 429 (mischief by killing or maiming cattle), 323 (voluntarily causing hurt), and 34 (act done by common persons).

In his complaint, Shivam claimed that 22 goats owned by the family were killed in the fire. Among the eight named in the FIR are local SHO Dinesh Kumar Gautam and four residents of the village - Ashok Dixit, Anil Dixit, Nirmal Dixit, Vishal. The FIR has also been lodged against three unidentified lekhpals, revenue officers and policemen.

"Two persons, including the lekhpal and the JCB driver have been arrested. The role of other accused is being probed," said Superintendent of Police (Kanpur Dehat) BGG TSMurti.

Meanwhile, the district administration has placed SDM (Maitha) Gyaneshwar Prasad and lekhpal Singh under suspension.

Earlier in the day, the Dixit family and the residents of the village refused to allow post-mortem of the bodies, demanding action against officials. They also demanded Rs 1 crore compensation, land, and a government job for a family member. As the protests continued, Deputy Chief Minister Brajesh Pathak intervened and spoke with the family through video call. "The deputy CM listened patiently to our grievances and demands. He assured to look into them and provide all possible help. I am satisfied with the government's assurance and therefore ending our protest," said 29-year-old Shivam Dixit, who works as a farmer.

Kanpur Divisional Commissioner Raj Shekhar said the administration was providing all possible help to the family of the deceased, including a police gunner for protection. Shivam alleged that on Monday, a team of district administration led by the SDM arrived with a bulldozer in tow. "My par-

IIT-M cancels classes for a day after protest over student's suicide

FOLLOWING A night-long student protest against the callous handling of a student's suicide and an attempted suicide by an-

other student on the campus Sunday, IIT-Madras decided to cancel classes and academic work on Monday. The unusual decision to declare Monday a "non-instructional day" was made after the institute's director Kamakoti Veezhinathan addressed the student gathering and promised to take action. A second-year research student in the electrical engineering department allegedly died by suicide on Sunday afternoon in a hostel room on the campus. According to reliable sources, a second, unconnected suicide attempt was also reported on the campus Sunday. The student was rescued and is currently under treatment at a hospital in Chennai. It was the administration's callous handling of the first student's death that sparked the protest. A stu-

dent representative who did not wish to be identified told The Indian Express that the administration did not inform the elected student representatives about the death, and that they learnt of it through unofficial channels by late evening. "Suicides may have many reasons, but why would they deal with it in secrecy? We demanded the administration to not let a small group of people at the top management handle things secretly. Student representatives or professors should be informed," the student said. After learning of the news around evening, students began marching from their hostels to Gajendra Circle at the centre of the campus where the administration building is located. Around 11.15 pm, as the crowd swelled, Niles J Vasa, the dean of students, informed everyone via email about the student's death. The students, however, chose to sit in protest in a bid to catch the attention of the dean and the director Veezhinathan and get an explanation for how they handled a student's death. The protest started before midnight. The students refused to follow dean Vasa's instructions when he arrived after midnight. They demanded a response directly from the director. According to a senior IIT-Madras official, Veezhinathan spoke to the student gathering. "It was promised that the administration will host an open house meeting in ten days when all students can voice their views. Considering their feelings, we decided to grant leave for classes today (Monday)," the official said. The students asked the administration to create a panel of experts from outside to study the mental health of the students. They called for better amenities at the campus hospital and 24x7 operation of the campus pharmacy which closes early. Students also sought to address other complex issues as well as the excessive pressure in research projects, besides their relationship with guides.
