**Sub: General Update- Disclosure of continuing event**

This disclosure is being made pursuant to the amendments to the SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (“**LODR**”) dated 14 June 2023, which came into effect from 14 July 2023. Pursuant to the amendment, we are required to disclose “*Pendency of any litigation(s) or dispute(s) or the outcome thereof which may have an impact on the listed entity*” including any continuing event or information which becomes material pursuant to notification of the amendment within thirty days from the effective date of the amendment.


The brief details of a litigation against Blink Commerce Private Limited (“**BCPL**”), now wholly owned subsidiary of Zomato Limited (w.e.f August 10, 2022) as required under Regulation 30 of the LODR read with Schedule III thereunder read with SEBI Circular no SEBI/HO/CFD-PoD-1/P/CIR2023/123 dated 13<sup>th</sup> July 2023 is attached as Annexure-I.

The litigation is currently sub-judice and based on advice received from our external legal advisors on this matter, ZL believes that BCPL has a good case on merit.

Brief details of dispute/litigation	<p>The Plaintiffs had filed a suit bearing OS No. 3994 of 2022, under Order VII Rule 1 and 2 of Civil Procedure Code read with Section 134 of the Trademark Act 1999, read with Section 62 of the Copyrights Act, 1957, before the Learned XVIII Additional City Civil and Sessions Judge at Bengaluru (“<b>Trial Court</b>”), seeking reliefs of permanent injunction, restricting BCPL, now wholly owned subsidiary of Zomato Limited (w.e.f August 10, 2022), from infringing the</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p>Plaintiffs’ registered trademarks and consequential remedies (“<b>Suit</b>”).</p> <p>The Trial Court, on June 27, 2022, granted an ex-parte interim injunction against BCPL restraining it from infringing the Plaintiff’s registered trademarks. BCPL preferred an appeal (Miscellaneous First Appeal (MFA No. 4733 of 2022)) before the Karnataka High Court against the above order of the Trial Court. The Karnataka High Court ruled in favour of BCPL and set aside the order of the Trial Court and also directed the Trial Court to dispose of the injunction application on merits.</p> <p>The Trial Court vide its order dated 10 August 2022, allowed the injunction application restraining BCPL from using the mark ‘Blinkit’ until disposal of the case (“<b>Impugned Order</b>”), against which BCPL once again preferred an appeal (Miscellaneous First Appeal (MFA No. 5756 of 2022)) in the Karnataka High Court.</p> <p>The Karnataka High Court allowed the appeal filed by BCPL against the Impugned Order recording that <i>‘the Impugned Order is wholly erroneous, arbitrary, contrary to the material on record as well as settled principles of law governing grant of injunction in relation to trademarks</i> (“<b>High Court Order</b>”).</p> <p>The Plaintiffs have filed a Special Leave Petition (C) NO. 14547/ 2023 in the Supreme Court of India against the High Court Order which is pending admission.</p>
Expected financial implications, if any, due to compensation, penalty etc.	There has been no material impact on the business operations of BCPL since the commencement of the Suit. Based on advice from external legal advisors, Zomato Limited believes that BCPL has a good case on merits and therefore, does not expect any material financial implications.
