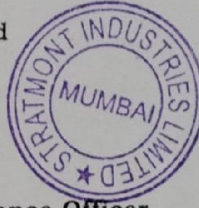

Elgar Parishad case: HC extends temporary bail of Varavara Rao till Oct 28

Pune The Bombay high court on Thursday extended till October 28 the temporary bail granted to post P Varavara Rao, 80, who was among those arrested for alleged inflammatory speeches at the Elgar Parishad conclave in Pune in December 2017. It granted Rao bail for six months on health grounds in February. Rao, who was to return to Mumbai's Taloja jail on September 8, filed a plea for the extension of the bail saying he has developed three new ailments. He cited a lack of proper medical facilities at the jail hospital while seeking the extension. A division bench of justices Nitin Jindal and Sarang Kotwal was unable to hear Rao's application on Thursday due to paucity of time. It said the matter will be taken up for hearing on October 28 before extending the bail. Rao submitted he has complied with all bail conditions and was living in Mumbai with his wife. He added he has been receiving treatment and has undergone medical check-ups. Rao said his reports indicate he has developed asymptomatic Parkinson's disease and neurological ailments. He added an eye ailment is dependent on his pension, the February 22 bail order had modified to allow him to return to his home state of Telangana.

Adhikari urges PM Modi to take urgent steps after pandal attacks in Bangladesh

New Delhi The violent attack on pandals occurred after the alleged desecration of the Quran in the Chittagong Division of Bangladesh, by placing it near the feet of goddess Durga's idol at a puja pandal. Durga Puja pandals and various temples. In a letter to PM Modi, the Opposition leader of the West Bengal Assembly said the notorious vandals are habituated to targeting the 'Sanatani' minority community in Bangladesh. 'This time the religious fanatics took to the streets to vandalise several Durga Puja pandals and various temples also. Presently the condition of Sanatani People living in Bangladesh is very miserable', he wrote, referring to the term often used to describe Hindu movements. The attacks on pandals mainly took place in Noakhali, Chandpur, Cox's Bazar, Chattogram, Chapainawabganj, Patna, Moulvibazar and Kurigram. No disturbance was reported in Dhaka, Brahmanbaria, Jashore and other major cities.

India Will Participate in Russia Talks Involving Taliban on October 20: MEA

level delegation of the Taliban rulers also participated in the meeting being hosted by Russia involving the Taliban next week. The Ministry for External Affairs said on Thursday. A Taliban delegation has already contacted that they will attend the October 20 event in Moscow for the so-called Moscow format talks on Afghanistan, their government will affect security and spark an even bigger exodus of migration from the country. The current Taliban appointed Afghan government, which the former insurgents say is only interim, is comprised solely of Taliban figures, including several blacklisted by the United Nations. The Moscow Format was launched by Russia in Doha on August 31, the Moscow Format will enable the first formal contact with the Taliban was in Doha on August 31, the Moscow Format established in 2017 to address Afghan issues. It currently includes India, USA, Russia, China, Pakistan, Iran and Central Asian states.

47% of people above 60 years in Navi Mumbai yet to get first vaccination against Covid

Mumbai: Even as the Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation (NMMC) has vaccinated 98% of its eligible population over the statistics, around 47% of people above the age of 60 years are yet to get even their first jab. NMMC commissioner, Abhijit Bangar, claimed that a door-to-door survey would be conducted to check how many beneficiaries were remaining while a call centre would be set up to check with families to ensure no senior citizen is left out. Currently, 11.07 lakh population of Navi Mumbai is estimated to be eligible for the vaccination, of which 1.76 lakh is estimated to be above the age of 60 years. Till now, only 92,894 people above the age group of 60 years have received their first jab, which is 53% of the total estimated population of this age group. Around 34,445 people under the category of Health Care Workers were also jabbed with the first dose.



"Currently, we do not differentiate the beneficiaries as per the health care workers and front line workers, and each person is reported under their respective age group. Hence, when the vaccination had started for the health care workers, many medical professionals who were above 60 years got their vaccination under that category," a medical officer from the corporation said. Meanwhile, Bangar said that the data of estimated target is notional and not the exact number. Hence, it is important to get the exact

numbers of the people above the age group of 60 in the city to conclude if there is anyone remaining. "Even when there was low supply of vaccination, we have always had at least one slot for the first dose of 60 years plus. So, this age group was never neglected and was always given priority. There is no reason why anyone from 60 years and above would be left out. There was never any reluctance from this age group and they were always eager to get the vaccination done. Accessibility, too, is not the reason as the drive for them was always available. In fact the queue for the first dose is declining slowly and even after we reach 100% target, the first dose drive will continue for those with no proof of being a resident of Navi Mumbai," Bangar said. He said that the target statistics is a notional figure and to get the exact figure, a door-to-door survey would be done, and simultaneously will have call centres verifying the exact number of 60 years and above existing in the city. "Through various drives and initiatives, we have collected the data of the families in Navi Mumbai and their family members. The call centre staff will be asked to call up the families and check if the senior citizens at their residences have been vaccinated. Besides, we also have around 3,500 housing societies registered with us who are also connected via WhatsApp. The housing societies, too, would be asked to provide the information." In many cases, the elderly were shifted to their hometowns when the pandemic started and while some might have still not come back, some others might have returned after getting their vaccination done, due to which their record is not registered with the NMMC.

Closure of Some Mines, Inundation Due to Monsoon Led to Coal Crisis: Joshi

New Delhi: Coal Minister Pralhad Joshi on Thursday said closure of some mines and inundation of a few others due to monsoon led to the crisis but there is no need to panic as the situation is improving. Visiting the Ashoka mine of the Central Coalfields Ltd (CCL) at Pipariya in Chhattisgarh district of Jharkhand, Joshi said the power plants in the country will continue to receive the required amount of coal. "We are witnessing an improvement now," he said, asked about the current situation. The minister held discussions with officials of

OCL and Eastern Coalfields Ltd (ECL) on the prevailing situation. "We can produce two million tonnes of coal per day," he said, asserting the need for producing more coal. Closure of some coal mines and inundation of a few others due to monsoon led to the hindrance in coal supply to power plants, Joshi told reporters. The minister also discussed the issue related to the availability of land for mining at the meeting. A solution will be found with the cooperation of all, including the district administration, he said.

Anti-drone Technology Developed, Transferred to Industries: DRDO Chief

New Delhi: DRDO has developed counter-drone technology and transferred it to industries, which have taken orders from the armed forces and security forces of the country, a senior official of the organisation said on Thursday. "DRDO has developed anti-drone technology. It has all the necessary elements required to counter drones, whether it is detection, tracking or surveillance and even a process called software and hardware," Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) chief G Satheesh Reddy said. He was speaking to reporters on the sidelines of the foundation stone-laying ceremony of the

DRDO-sponsored Kalam Centre for Science and Technology (KCST) at the Central University of Jammu in Samba. Reddy said the technology forces have been transferred to multiple industries, which have taken orders from the armed forces and security forces of the country. "We are providing it to them. They will be delivering it to them (security and armed forces) to tackle the drones that are coming in from across the border," he added. Reddy said the capability of the anti-drone system has been demonstrated multiple times, adding, "It was deployed on the Independence Day and the Republic Day also."
