

Webinar on PM GATISHAKTI NMP with Central Training Institutes (CTIs) and State Administrative Training Institutes (ATIs)

Logistics Division, Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPITT), Ministry of Commerce and Industry along with Capacity Building Commission (CBC) hosted a webinar yesterday with 27 Central Training Institutes (CTIs) and 34 State Administrative Training Institutes (ATIs) to find ways and means to institutionalize and regularise training and capacity building on PM GatiShakti approach for public servants being trained in all these institutes. In the webinar, along with elaborating the rationale and concept of PM GATI SHAKTI innovative uses were also showcased. The webinar included three sessions. Session I focused on the unravelling of the PM GatiShakti approach through a demonstration of PM GatiShakti National Master Plan by BISAG-N. Session II showcased the practices adopted by Ministries for holistic infrastructure planning using PM GatiShakti, illustrating adoption of PM GATI SHAKTI by the Ministry of Railways. Session III highlighted the need for capacity building for Public servants on PM Gati Shakti principles, envisioning a 'whole of government' approach to Government functioning across sectors and ways and means to integrate PM GATI SHAKTI in Course curriculum of CTIs and ATIs. More than 250 participants with senior most officers from 27 Central Training Institutes (CTIs), about 34 State Administrative Training Institutes (ATIs) across the length and breadth of the country along with BISAG-N, CBC and Network Planning Group Ministries participated in the webinar. Secretary, DPITT, Sh. Rajesh Kumar Singh highlighted the importance of PM GatiShakti National Master Plan embodying the vision of

English rendering of PM's address at laying of foundation stone for redevelopment of 508 railway stations in 27 states and UTs

Namaskar! Railway Minister of the country Shri Ashwani Vaishnavji, other members of the Union Cabinet from every corner of the country, Governors of various states, Chief Ministers, Ministers of State Cabinets, MPs, MLAs, all our dear dignitaries, and my dear brothers and sisters! India is at the beginning of its 'Amrit Kaal' (golden age) as it is moving towards the goal of development. There is new energy, new inspiration, and new determination. In this light, a new chapter is also beginning in the history of Indian Railways today. Approximately 1300 major railway stations in India will now be developed as 'Amrit Bharat Railway Stations' and they will be redeveloped and modernized. Today, the work of redevelopment has commenced for 508 Amrit Bharat stations. An estimated 25,000 crores of rupees will be spent on the construction of these 508 Amrit Bharat stations. You can imagine how significant this campaign is going to be for the country's infrastructure, for the railways, and most importantly, for the common citizens of my country. The benefits of this project will be enjoyed by almost all states in the country. For example, approximately 4,000 crores of rupees will be spent to develop 55 Amrit stations in Uttar Pradesh. Rajasthan will also have 55 railway stations transformed into Amrit Bharat Stations. In Madhya Pradesh, around 1,000 crores of rupees will be spent on the redevelopment of 34 Amrit stations. More than 2,500 crores of rupees will be spent on the development of 44 stations in Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, and Kerala will also see their major stations developed as Amrit Bharat Stations. At the beginning of this historic campaign in the 'Amrit Kaal', I applaud the Ministry of Railways and extend my congratulations to all citizens of the country. Friends, Today, the whole world's attention is on India. India's stature has grown at the global level, and the world's attitude towards India has changed. There are two main reasons for this. Firstly, the country has formed a government with a full majority after nearly three decades, after thirty years, and that is the first reason. Friends, The country has also taken pride in its heritage in the 'Amrit Kaal' of Independence. These Amrit Railway stations will also become symbols of that pride, filling us with a sense of honour. These stations will showcase glimpses of the country's culture and local heritage. For instance, Jaipur Railway Station will exhibit glimpses of Rajasthan's heritage, such as Hawa Mahal and Amer Fort. Jammu Tawi Railway Station in Jammu and Kashmir will be inspired by the famous Raghunath Temple. Dimapur station in Nagaland will display the local traditional art of its 16 tribes. Every Amrit station will serve as a symbol of the city's modern aspirations and ancient heritage. In recent times, the country has introduced the
