Wipro elevates 31 staff to senior roles

LEVERAGING ITS BENCH strength, Wipro appointed 25 VPs (vice presidents) and six SVPs (senior vice-presidents) on Tuesday as part of measures to continue transformation within the company, CEO and MD Thierry Delaporte told employees in an internal mail.

A Wipro spokesperson said, "Wipro congratulates all our leaders who have been promoted to senior vice president and vice president positions. These promotions are part of Wipro's ongoing commitment to developing strong internal leaders, who are critical in driving our strategy forward."

Bigger rival Infosys also recently boasted of its deep bench strength to analysts amid a slew of top-level exits in the company.

Of more than 90 senior vice presidents and executive vice presidents that Infosys has, about 50% have been with the firm for more than 20 years, said Nomura in a note recently.

The most recent top management personnel to exit was Ravi Kiran Kuchibhotla, who resigned from the services as per the BSE filing of the company last week.

Other key notable exits from the company in the last couple of months include its

CFO Nilanjan Roy, SVP and group head of procurement at Infosys Binny Mathews, former HR head and EVP at Infosys

Richard Lobo and others.

Nomura in a note said Infosys has a deep bench of senior leadership in the com-

pany. "Of the 90+ SVP and EVPs in the company, about 50% have been with Infosys for more than 20 years and 30% for more than 25 years. All the roles of the recent senior leadership departures have been filled internally (Jayesh Sanghrajka replaced Nilanjan Roy as CFO, Dennis Gada replaced Mohit Joshi as BFSI head, and Ravi Kumar's role of Deputy COO was filled by two internal candidates of 30 years (of experience))."

It added that client relationships are not hurt as there has been no client loss and business relationships have strengthened further with many of the existing clients, as

evident in the large deals won in the recent past.

However, analysts at CLSA have a different take on top management churn at Infosys and the impact on its business. They said, "Top management churn is leading to loss of deals and slippage in delivery execution."

Not just Infosys, but even other large players like Wipro, Tech Mahindra and LTIMindtree are seeing high-level resignations amid slowdown in global tech spends. LTIMindtree saw around 18 top-level exits in the last one year, including several CXOs like CTO, CFO, CBO, CMO and others.

Bajaj earmarks ₹5,000 crore for CSR initiatives

Over 60% brands widely use 'MarTech', says report

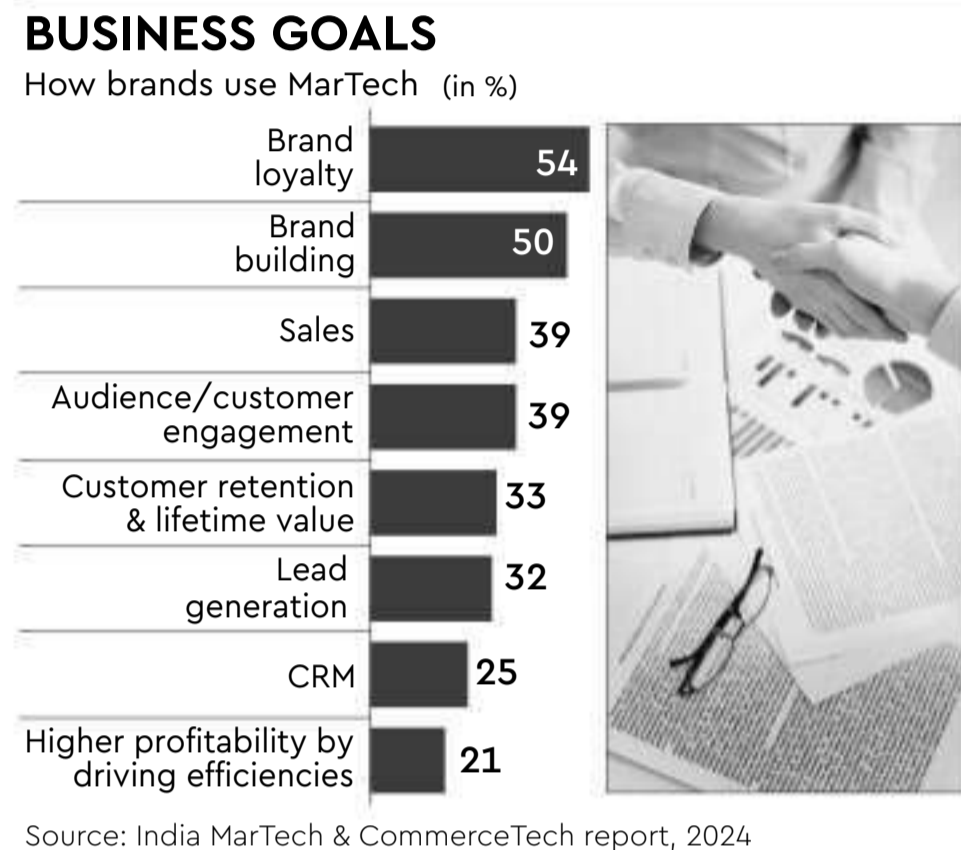

OVER 60% OF brands now extensively use marketing technology (MarTech) tools in their organisations, and a staggering 95% plan to increase their spending on the same, says a report released by Mirium India and VPL, part of the WPP group.

The report, which was titled 'India MarTech and CommerceTech Report 2024', noted that since the pandemic in 2020, "the industry has made significant strides amidst a world in transition".

"With 65%+ respondents spending over 16% of their marketing budgets on MarTech, as against 18% respondents doing the same in 2023, a strategic prioritisation of MarTech seems to have happened across organisations and industries."

"A clear indication that



MarTech is no longer just a novelty - it's gone mainstream," the report said.

It observed the evolving role of technologies such as generative AI (GenAI) driving

brands' marketing strategies, with over 70% organisations noting that their marketing strategy is driven by an equal mix of technology and creativity (up from 50% last year).

Accenture's guidance cut dashes hopes of IT firms

A REVENUE GUIDANCE cut by the global information technology (IT) giant Accenture has cast a shadow over Indian IT companies. Analysts now worry that the next financial year, 2024-25, will also be gloomy for these companies, dashing hopes of a much-anticipated recovery eyed later this calendar year.

Accenture slashed its revenue forecast for fiscal year 2024 to 1-3% from 2-5% earlier, citing macroeconomic uncertainties that are restraining clients from spending on consulting services and increasing pressure in the volume of smaller deals.

Earnings of Accenture, the world's largest IT services provider, are often seen as a projection of how its Indian peers will perform. As a result, the news of the revenue fore-



cast cut sent the shares of Indian IT majors, Infosys, Tata Consultancy Services, Wipro, HCL Technologies, Tech Mahindra, and LTIMindtree lower by 1.5-4% intraday on Friday.

"Stock prices had started to move up in anticipation of an improvement in discretionary spending, but Accenture's

guidance cut has reaffirmed our cautiousness in near-term demand," said Sumit Pokharna, vice president of research at Kotak Securities. He further highlighted that cuts in short-cycle discretionary projects will be negative for Infosys, Wipro, Mphasis, and LTIMindtree.

Brokerage firm Jefferies said in a note that as the demand outlook for the IT sector seems to be worsening with no recovery in sight, the Nifty IT valuations "seem rich", with IT stocks trading 26 times their earnings. "We believe discretionary demand is unlikely to recover meaningfully in 1H FY25 for Indian IT, and maintain our cautious stance," brokerage Nomura said in a note.

On similar lines, Motilal Oswal Financial Services said in a research note, "Cautious spending environment in the near term should drag down FY24 operational performance."

Air India fined for violating duty time rules

THE DIRECTORATE GENERAL (DGCA) of civil aviation (DGCA) on Friday slapped a ₹80 lakh fine on Tata Group-backed Air India for violating Flight Duty Time Limitations (FDTL) norms for flight crew.

The airline was also fined on account of violating regulations pertaining to the fatigue management system (FMS) of flight crew.

"As a proactive step towards ensuring a high level of safety in aviation, DGCA conducted a spot audit of M/s Air India Limited in the month of January this year for verifying the regulatory compliance by the operator in respect of FDTL and FMS regulations," the DGCA said in a statement on Friday. "During the audit, the evidences were collected and fleet-wise random reports were analysed."

According to the regulator, the analysis of reports and evidence revealed that Air India operated flights with both flight crew members aged above 60 flying together in a few instances, which is a violation.

"The operator was also found deficient in providing adequate weekly rest, adequate rest before and after ultra-long range (ULR) flights and adequate rest on layover to flight crew, which violates the extant provisions of the Civil Aviation Requirements pertaining to FDTL."
