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Gram panchayat elections likely by year-end

THE State Election Commission is likely to conduct Gram Panchayat elections in Karnataka by December. It will be done as per the new guidelines issued by the Election Commission of India and by taking all precautionary measures.

In Karnataka, there are 6,025 gram panchayats and their tenure ended in June/July.

In May this year, SEC announced postponement of the panchayat polls citing the Covid-19 pandemic as an "exceptional circumstance". Meanwhile, a PIL was filed before the Karnataka High Court questioning the postponement. Recently, the SEC had informed the High Court that the reservation list for the Panchayat elections was ready in 21 districts and that the remaining nine districts had sought time.

Speaking to The New Indian Express, B Basavaraju, State Election Commissioner, said they are keen on conducting the elections but due to the pandemic, there is no clarity. "The Election Commission issued guidelines for conducting elections during Covid-19. Based on this, we will frame Standard Operating Procedures (SoP). We will follow all the safety aspects," he said.

'Party leaders decide who will lead, no confusion'

Completing a year as state BJP president, Kateel lists party and govt achievements, says BSY presented an excellent budget



He has grown up in the RSS and knows how to build the party, and has toured the length and breadth of the state many times. Our party has seen success in many elections under his leadership

OUR party is different, our leaders grow organically, declared BJP State President Nalin Kumar Kateel. "Chief Minister B S Yediyurappa is our leader in Karnataka, and Prime Minister Narendra Modi is our leader nationally. The party leadership decides on who will lead when the occasion arises, so there is no confusion," Kateel said, when asked who was being groomed to succeed CM Yediyurappa to lead the party in the State.

Kateel, who completed one year in his post, neatly sidestepped any talk of his ambitions.

Elaborating on the leader-

ship issue, he queried, "Who knew Yogi Adityanath in Uttar Pradesh, and Devendra Fadnis in Maharashtra? About 20 years ago, the BJP would have had to look for a candidate for the post of chief minister. When Yediyurappa became deputy CM in 2006, he offered excellent programmes as finance minister. When power was not transferred to the BJP, we went before the people with a mass campaign, and the people gave us a mandate. When Narendra Modi was projected as PM, then CM Siddaramaiah had asked who knows Modi

outside Gujarat, but today, Modi is known across the world. So also Amit Shah, who became party president."

Asked about Old Mysuru repeatedly giving BJP the cold shoulder, and lack of traction in over 50 constituencies, Kateel said the party is slowly making progress, and held up

Mandya and Chikkaballapur as examples. "We are looking at the profile of constituencies where we haven't won even once, or have won once, or by a negligible margin, and are holding deliberations to see who can take charge of these segments and work out packages

to help grow the party's presence. I am confident that we will win over 150 seats in the next assembly elections."

Kateel is also confident of doing well in the upcoming BBMP elections, putting the number of winning seats at 115-120 out of 198 seats, and all four Legislative Council seats. He said the party and government worked together in the recent by-elections to 15 seats, giving the party a 12+1 win. "Our teams are ready, from the booth level to the Rajya Sabha," he stated.

"To encourage the youth, we have restricted the Yuva BJP to a maximum of 30 years and district leadership to 50 years. We promoted Ashok Gasti and Eranna Kadadi as Rajya Sabha

MPs, Shantaram Siddi and Prathap Simha Nayak as MLCs, as a reward for their work," Kateel said.

On the challenges facing the government, he said that CM Yediyurappa handled the twin problems of drought and floods earlier, and is battling Covid and floods this year. Initially, he worked alone, and got a team only after the cabinet expansion, he said.

Listing the government's achievements, he said that Yediyurappa had presented an excellent budget, and after the Covid pandemic set in, he took the number of labs from a mere four to around 100, besides getting 30,000 ventilators and beds in small centres.



'K'tala set to present GST case effectively'

BOMMAI, however, added that whether the Union Government can provide sovereign guarantee for State Government loans is still a question mark since it is unprecedented.

Pointing out that the GST compensation for the January-March quarter helped the state in April and June, Bommai said it was all the more important that the Centre comes to the state's help.

"Karnataka is all set to present its case effectively and strongly in this crucial meeting. Chief Minister B S Yediyurappa too has spoken to Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Wednesday as a prelude to the GST council meeting and impressed upon her the need of the hour," Bommai added.

Karnataka's estimated GST compensation as per Budget 2020-2021 is Rs 16,000 crore, of which the state is yet to receive any compensation.

The Union Government, however, released pending GST compensation of 2019-2020 in two instalments in April and June 2020.

Postponement of JEE/NEET not in interest of students

"THEY (the opposition) have no concern for the students or for the system. They are trying to politicise the issue. Life is getting back to normal and we have to live with the virus. They are trying to create confusion among people and spoil the academic year," he said.

"The JEE/NEET examinations are important to prevent irregularities in seat allocation, besides ensuring that merit prevails," Dr Ashwath Narayan added.

The JEE (mains) examinations for engineering seat aspirants is scheduled from September 1 to 6, while the NEET for medical seat aspirants is scheduled on Sep-

tember 13. The exams, normally scheduled for April and May, respectively, were postponed twice due to the pandemic.

"They have already been postponed and further postponement is not in the interest of the students," Narayan said, echoing the views of academics who have said any further delays in holding the examinations could disrupt the academic calendar besides affecting the future of students.

Apart from the SSLC and PUC examinations, the state has already conducted Karnataka Common Entrance Test for more than 1.94 lakh students aspiring to join engineering colleges.
