Govt extends telecom PLI scheme to 42 companies

MAKE-IN-INDIA PUSH. 17 firms apply for additional 1 per cent incentive

The government on Monday said it has approved 42 companies, including 28 micro, medium and small enterprises (MSMEs) under production-linked incentive (PLI) scheme for telecom and networking products, which have committed investment of ₹4,115 crore.

Of the 42 companies, 17 have applied for additional incentives of 1 per cent under design-led manufacturing criteria, the Department of Communications said in a statement, adding that this is expected to generate additional sales of ₹2.45-lakh crore and create 44,000 more jobs over the scheme period.

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Some of the companies approved under the scheme include Nokia Solutions and Networks India, Samsung India, Electronics, Flextronics Technologies (India), Dixon Electro Appliances, HFCL,

ITI, Tejas Networks, Vihaan Networks, Alphon India, Coral Telecom, Frog Cellsat, VVDN Technologies and Rising Stars Hi-Tech.

DESIGN-LED SCHEME

"The existing companies under PLI scheme for telecom

and networking products were allowed to add more products and apply under design-led PLI scheme.

"They were also given the benefit of shifting their five-year PLI scheme period by one year."

"Twenty-two companies availed this opportunity of shifting their first year which includes 13 companies who have applied as fresh applicants," the DoT statement said.

To create a robust domestic value chain, the FY23 Budget announced design-led PLI scheme for telecom and networking products. It provided additional incentive of one per cent over and above the existing incentives for products that are designed and manufactured in India.

Spandana to focus on expanding customer base

Spandana Sphoorty Financial acquired 1.23 lakh customers during the second quarter ended September 30, 2022, marking a growth of 16 per cent over the same period last year, and plans to continue its focus on new customer acquisition, going forward.

"Our growth story will be led by customer acquisition and, hence, we are building the blocks both culturally and identifying pockets of growth to further our plans," said Shalabh Saxena, Managing Director and CEO of Spandana Sphoorty Financial.

REFRESHING PORTFOLIO

The Hyderabad-based MFI believes that a new set of customers entering its books is a good way to refresh its portfolio. "They are obviously in geographies where their liabilities are less plus they are more current in terms of the way the Joint Lending Groups (JLG) works," said Saxena, while responding to questions in the Q2 earnings call.

Spandana wants to churn the existing customer base a little bit and identified about 4 to 5 lakh customers who are likely to exit from existing relationship with the company at some stage, going forward.

"A new set of customers entering your books is always a good way to refresh your portfolio. So, this is part of a conscious strategy, and that is why 46 of the 100 customers that we have disbursed in the last quarter are new customers to Spandana," he said. Spandana has a disbursement target of about ₹8,100 crore for the current fiscal, and its book now stands at ₹5,782 crore. Of this, ₹4,730 crore has a net collection efficiency of 97.5 per cent. "This is slated to improve over the next couple of quarters," said the CEO.

Sundaram Home Finance has revised interest rates upwards on deposits effective from November 1.

Wimbledon Win was Confidence Boost in Tough Year: Djokovic

Novak Djokovic said his Wimbledon triumph gave him much-needed boost of confidence during a tough year. "I had the best form for a long time in 2021," Djokovic said after he was deported from Australia in the lead-up to the year's first Grand Slam in January for being vaccinated against COVID-19. The Serb then struggled to hit form and only began showing glimpses of his best at the end of the clay season. The 35-year-old then beat Australian Nick Kyrgios in the Wimbleton final to bag his 21st Grand Slam crown before winning trophies in Tel Aviv and Astana and arriving in France primed to defend his Paris Masters title this week. "The first part of the year with everything that happened, I think it's all changed, very much changed mentally off the court and it was affecting my game," Djokovic said. "I was finding my way to that desired level and that happened towards the end of the clay season. Wimbleton always comes at the right time in my career. When I need that huge confidence boost and big title, Wimbleton is always there."

Privacy Breached

Kohli fumes after his hotel room's video surfaces, says 'paranoid about privacy'

Virat Kohli said on Monday that he was "paranoid" about his privacy after a stranger appeared to have filmed inside his hotel room in Perth.

The 35-year-old Kohli took to social media to share the actions of the invader, who took video footage of the batsman's belongings at the Crown Perth as India prepared for the T20 World Cup in Australia earlier this month.

"I understand that fans get very happy and excited seeing their favourite players and get excited to meet them and I've always appreciated that," Kohli wrote to his 23 million followers on Instagram.

"But this video here is appalling and I'm extremely very paranoid about my privacy."

The invader had it launched as an investigation, and a charge for that had been "stood down".

"If I cannot have privacy in my own hotel room, then we can't really expect any personal space at all?" said Kohli, who NOTCOW with the lead in India's semi-final and absolute domination of Virat. "Please respect people's privacy and not treat them as a commodity for entertainment."

Crown Resorts apologised for the invasion and said immediate action had been taken.

"We sincerely apologise to the guest involved and will continue to take the necessary steps to ensure this never happens again."

"We bring the same standards for this invader, and it falls well below the standards we set for our team members and contractors."

Crown Resorts immediate steps to rectify the issue include launching an investigation standing down the individuals involved.

Aaron Finch made another scratchy start but the shackles in his half-century last Saturday night were off as Australia cruised to a 53-run win over Ireland on Monday in a crucial Group 1 match for the defending champions at the Twenty20 World Cup.

Finch has been critical of his own form and took a while to get going. He rose past 50 from 44 balls as Australia accelerated from 120-7 to 173-7 and reached the target in 17 overs.

The Irish did not go down without a fight, with skipper Andy Balbirnie and vice-captain Paul Stirling each taking a six in the first two overs before the Australian bowlers struck back ruthlessly with five wickets in 13-deliv-
