# US seeks no political favours from India: Official

The US help to India to meet the Covid-19 surge is unconditional and does not expect political favours in return, State Department Spokesperson Ned Price has declared.

"We have a Global Comprehensive Strategic Partnership with India. But the Secretary (of State Anthony Blinken) has been clear: This is not about shots in arms in return for political favours, in return for any sort of transactionalism. This is about America's humanitarian leadership, the commitment that this administration has, to help those most in need," Price said on Monday when a reporter asked at his briefing about prioritising Covid-19 help to India.

He said that as long as the virus is circulating "unfettered anywhere," it is a threat to Americans.

"So we are doing what is in our national interest, but we're also doing what's in the collective interest. And it just so happens when it comes to global health, oftentimes what's in our national interest is also in the collective interest," he added.

When a reporter asked if the US was acting to help India after a delay because of "Chinese criticism," Price said, "I would take issue with the premise that it has taken us a long time." While conceding, "I would note that, of course, we have talked about our stepped-up assistance to India in recent hours," he emphasised, "We've always said as we assess we're in a position to do more, we will do more, and you have heard us make good on that pledge."

"From the start, we have provided much-needed assistance to India, just as India came to our aid when we were enduring the worst of the pandemic here in this country," he said. "The US has provided nearly \$19 million in total assistance, and that includes nearly \$11 million in health assistance," he stated. The \$19 million aid includes \$2 million to supporting micro and small and medium enterprises in areas hardest hit, he said.

### S Asian FMs meet on C-19 is open to India, says China

China, which is hosting a meeting of Foreign Ministers of some South Asian countries to deal with the virus situation, said on Tuesday that the virtual conference is open to all countries in the region, including India.

Pakistan, Afghanistan, Nepal, Sri Lanka and Bangladesh are invited to the virtual Ministerial level meeting being hosted on Tuesday by Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi. India, Maldives and Bhutan are conspicuously absent from the meeting.

Asked why India has not been invited to the meeting, Foreign Ministry spokesman Wang Wenbin said that "China follows the spirit of openness and inclusiveness. This meeting is open to South Asian countries, including India. We welcome the participation of all countries."

### 'India's C-19 tests unreliable'

Premier of the Western Australia state Mark McGowan on Tuesday alleged that Covid tests conducted in India for returning travellers were either inaccurate or unreliable which are impinging on the integrity of the system and causing some issues here.

McGowan's remarks came after authorities in Western Australia said that 4 people in hotel quarantine in Perth tested

positive following their return from India. Western Australian health authorities are concerned that the majority of returning travellers were from India where the infection has been rising alarmingly. McGowan told a local TV channel: "I have just been told that 78 of the 79 passengers on this flight had been in India recently." "Our expectation is the number of positive cases from this group of people will grow and potentially grow significantly."

# Imran asks Muslims to use trade boycotts against blasphemy

Pakistan's Prime Minister Imran Khan has boasted that his plan for Muslim-majority countries to unite and force Western governments to criminalise insulting the Prophet Mohammed will work.

The 68-year-old leader said lobbying Western nations, the EU and UN to adopt blasphemy laws with a warning of a trade boycott if they do not do so will be 'effective' in achieving their goal.

He said leaders of Muslim-majority countries should call on the West to 'stop hurting the feelings' of Muslims across the world with their current freedom of speech laws, reports Pakistani newspaper Dawn. Khan said insulting Islam's Prophet should be treated in the same way as questioning the Holocaust, which is a crime in some European countries.

My way is to take heads of all Muslim countries into confidence, Khan said in an address on Monday. "Together we should ask Europe, the European Union and United Nations to stop hurting the feelings of 1.25 billion Muslims like they do not do in [the] case of Jews." "I want the Muslim countries to devise a joint line of action over the issue with a warning of trade boycott of countries where such incidents will happen. This will be the most effective way to achieve the goal," he added.

"That is a pretty foolish decision. It is not countries that insult the Prophet Mohammed, it's individual citizens. However distasteful that might be, as in Pakistan it is the law of the UK or any other country to determine whether they are allowed to do that or not," Britain's former foreign secretary Sir Malcolm said.

# SL Cabinet approves bid to ban face coverings

COLOMBO: Sri Lanka's Cabinet on Tuesday approved a controversial proposal to ban all forms of face coverings in public places, citing a threat to national security.

The move came weeks after Minister of Public Security Sarath Weerasekera signed a note in March, seeking the approval of the Cabinet to ban burqas, outer garments worn by Muslim women.

The Cabinet has decided to ban all forms of face coverings in public places, Cabinet spokesperson and information minister Keheliya Rambukwella told reporters, without specifying burqas.

He said the decision was taken two years after a wave of coordinated terror attacks on hotels and churches on Easter Sunday. "All forms of face covers are a threat to national security," he said. However, wearing face masks to combat Covid-19 is allowed. The covering of the full face will automatically include burqa and niqab. The proposal now must be approved by Parliament to become a law.

# Iran nuclear talks resume in Vienna

World powers resumed high-level talks in Vienna on Tuesday focussed on bringing the United States back into the nuclear deal with Iran, in their first session since comments surfaced from the Iranian foreign minister alleging that Russia once tried to scupper the pact.

The Russian Foreign Ministry has not responded to requests for comment on the remarks from Foreign Minister Mohammad Javad Zarif, made in a 7-hour interview with a think tank associated with the Iranian presidency that leaked over the weekend.

Ahead of the main talks, Russia's top representative Mikhail Ulyanov said he'd met on the side together with officials from Iran and

China, but did not mention anything about Zarif's comments.

"We compared notes and exchanged views on the way ahead towards full restoration of the nuclear deal," he tweeted. "It was a very fruitful meeting."

JCOA - Ulyanov tweeted that they were "guided by the unity of purpose." "Which is full restoration of the nuclear deal in its original form," he wrote. "It was decided to expedite the process."

# Myanmar guerrillas capture gov't base; airstrikes follow

Ethnic Karen guerrillas said they captured a Myanmar army base Tuesday near the border with Thailand, representing a morale-boosting action for those opposing the military's takeover of the country's civilian government in February.

Myanmar's military staged airstrikes several hours later on villages in territory controlled by the Karen forces, said a guerrilla spokesman, a senior Thai official and a relief worker.

A spokesman for the Karen National Union, the minority's main political group seeking greater autonomy from Myanmar's central government, said its armed wing attacked the base at 5 a.m. and burned it down just

after dawn. Casualty figures were not yet known, the KNU's head of foreign affairs, Padoh Saw Taw Nee, said. There was no immediate comment from Myanmar's military government.

The KNU, which controls

territory in eastern Myanmar near the Thai border, is a close ally of the resistance movement against the military takeover that ousted the elected government of Aung San Suu Kyi. Its armed wing is called the Karen National Liberation Army.
