We hereby inform that M/s India Ratings & Research (Ind-Ra) has revised the Long-Term Issuer rating of Can Fin Homes Limited to `IND AA' from `IND AAA'. The outlook is revised to Stable from negative. The instrument-wise rating actions are given below:

Rating Rationale:

As mentioned under Analytical Approach, the credit rating is driven by the standalone credit profile of CFHL since Canara Bank has indicated its intention of selling its stake in the Company as part of mobilising capital in light of government's direction.

Further, the key rating drivers are indicated as `Canara Bank's Capital-Raising Plan includes Company's Stake Sale, proven track record and granular loan book of the Company, moderately diversified resource profile though largely institutional funded, Liquidity Indicator as adequate, Credit cost under control, above average leverage and stable profitability'.
