HRD Seeks ₹60,900 Cr for Giving Laptops to College Students

ON THE CARDS Mid-day meal scheme for pre-primary and breakfast for junior classes to be introduced soon

New Delhi: The Union Human Resource Development ministry is preparing to extend the flagship mid-day meal scheme to pre-primary classes and to introduce breakfast for junior classes. It also plans to launch a ₹60,900 crore scheme to provide laptops/devices to over 4 crore college students over the next five years, to bridge the digital divide.

The plan for laptops comes at a time when the education system is faced with the challenge of running nearly an entire academic session in online mode due to Covid-19 and grappling with the reality of a huge chunk of students being left out due to the lack of access to computers and internet.

ET has learnt that both proposals were put forward by the HRD ministry at a meeting of the 15th Finance Commission on Monday which was chaired by chairman NK Singh and attended by the union HRD minister Ramesh Pokhriyal Nishank.

Congress Launches Nationwide Campaign for Fuel Price Rollback

New Delhi: The Congress on Monday launched anation-wide "speak-up" campaign, demanding that the government immediately roll back the recent sharp hikes in the prices of petrol and diesel.

Top Congress leaders, led by the Gandhis, released video messages across social media and some of them, along with party workers, have also carried out symbolic cycle rides, attacking the government for adding to the hardship of ordinary people by hiking fuel prices, despite the all-time low international crude price. The campaign will run till July 4—from the PCC to block levels.

In his message, Rahul Gandhi said while the coronavirus, economic crisis and unemployment "have hit all Indians, both rich and poor, like a 'tsunami', the farmers, workers and middle class have been the worst victims. Accusing the government of not only rejecting the Congress' demand for direct transfer of cash

nance Committee followed by the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs to "extend the mid-day meal facility to preparatory classes and introduce breakfast from preparatory to elementary classes", ET has learnt.

It also apprised the 15th Finance Com-

mission of the same and sought ₹1,53,922 crore from the 15th Finance Commission towards the mid day meal scheme for "including pre-primary children and energising breakfast for children" for a period of five years. For locations where it may be difficult to provide a hot

cooked meal, a simple but nutritious meal, e.g., consisting of groundnuts/ chana mixed with jaggery and/or local fruits may be provided. To ensure the quality of food served and its nutritional content, the ministry has proposed that expenditure on meals will be linked to food costs and inflation.

RETURN OF TABLETS/PCS

The higher education department has proposed to launch from 2021-22 a scheme for 'Making Devices Available' to 40% of students in higher education, estimated to be 4.06 crore in five years. The ministry proposes to start with distributing laptops/tablets of about ₹15,000 each to 1.5 crore students in 2021-22 at a cost of ₹22,500 crore. Of this, ₹13,500 crore is expected to be borne by the Centre and the remaining ₹9,000 crore would be the states' share.

The devices are part of the larger governmental plan towards digital learning. It has already moved to increase the permissible online component in conventional, open and distance modes of education from 20% to 40% and allowed eligible high-ranking universities to offer full-fledged online programmes automatically.

AMID CONGRESS PROTEST

Petrol, Diesel Price Hike Didn't Hit Common Man: Oil Minister Pradhan

New Delhi: Union petroleum minister Dharmendra Pradhan defended the increases in fuel prices in recent weeks amid a nationwide protest by the Congress over the issue on Monday.

Pradhan said the national as well as global economy was going through a challenging time and that it had impacted the demand and supply of fuel across the world.

"Due to lockdown there was 70 per cent reduction in demand for petrol and diesel in April and May. With resumed economic activity, demand is coming back towards normal," said Pradhan. "In such a scenario, the recent increase in petrol and diesel prices has not impacted the common man. When a problem comes in a family, the person carefully manages the finances to meet the future challenges. The hike in fuel price should be seen

like this." Pradhan said the extra money collected through taxes on fuel was being spent on health, employment and ensuring economic security of the people of the country.

"Under the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Scheme, we have provided ₹1,70,000 crore under several schemes for poor and farmers.

We are depositing cash in their bank accounts, giving six months free ration and free LPG cylinder for three months," said Pradhan.

"Sonia Gandhi and Congress cannot digest the welfare of poor people," he said, slanting the opposition party and its president.

UP Scales up Testing, Over 7L Tests Conducted in June

UP is fifth state to conduct more than seven lakh tests after TN, Maharashtra, Andhra and Rajasthan

New Delhi: Uttar Pradesh has stepped up testing in June and has crossed a total of seven lakh tests on Monday, more than doubling the testing numbers as recorded on May 31. It has also been keeping the number of deaths and active cases low—a fact praised by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

UP is now the fifth state to do more than seven lakh tests after Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh and Rajasthan. UP conducted 22,378 tests on Sunday, UP's principal secretary (health) Amit Mohan Prasad said. Only 8,011 samples were tested daily as on June 1, the state's health bulletins show. Against 7.07 lakh tests as on June 1, UP had tested only 2.97 lakh people as on June 1. So the total testing number has risen by over four lakh in about four weeks in UP.

"We are almost at 3,000 tests per million population now and aim to reach the national average of over 4,000 tests per million by mid-July. The daily testing capacity is being increased further to reach 30,000 tests in July and we have 42 testing labs operational now," a senior UP government official told ET.

Both RT-PCR and antigen tests are being done along with the widespread use of TrueNat machines. The Yogi Adityanath government has drawn much criticism for the low testing rate per million population with the opposition questioning the same. UP's overall test positivity rate has remained constant at around 3% (3.2% presently), well below the national average of 6.5%.

UP is also devising a special strategy for the Meerut division, comprising the worst-affected Meerut, Gautambudh Nagar (Noida) and Ghaziabad districts, to step up testing levels and surveillance here. Yogi Adityanath has ordered a special drive in the entire division from July 1 to 7 under which medical screening of every household would be done at the gram panchayat and ward level by officials equipped with infrared thermometer and Pulse Oximeters. The CM has ordered that rapid antigen tests of those who they suspect to have contracted the virus should be done and those infected should be admitted to Covid hospitals.

These three districts have so far seen nearly 4,800 cases and around 160 deaths. These three districts have nearly 2,000 active cases of the total 22,828 cases, 672 deaths and 6,650 active cases in UP. The CM has also ordered capacity enhancement at Covid hospitals of all districts in Meerut division. Senior officials have been deputed from Lucknow to every division in UP to oversee testing and admissions.
