in Pandharpur tehsil around 4.15 pm, a police official said. While six passengers in the SUV were killed, another two women, who were seriously injured, were undergoing treatment at a hospital, the official added.

13 NCP Parbhani corporators quit

The corporators have accused NCP legislator Baba Jani Durrani of acting independently, by filing a nomination for a rank outsider to fill the vacancy caused by the death of corporator Vishnu Navale

Fed up of being pushed around by the Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) legislator Baba Jani Durrani, 13 corporators of the party have tendered their resignations from the Parbhani Municipal Corporation. The corporators have accused Durrani of acting independently by

filing a nomination for a rank outsider to fill the vacancy caused by the death of corporator Vishnu Navale. This is considered a setback to the NCP, as Lok Sabha election is round the cor-

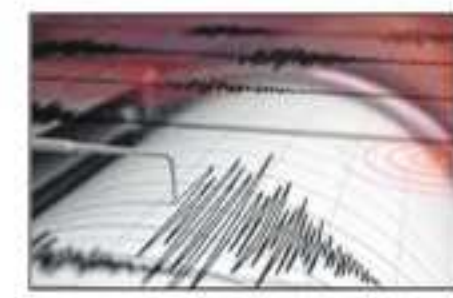
ner. There were 18 NCP corporators in Parbhani municipal corporation, of which only five remain. After the death of Navale, an NCP corporator, the party leadership had decided to

give the seat to his wife. However, Durrani, on his own, decided to bring in a rank outsider, Atiq Inamdar, which angered the corporators. Thirteen of them handed over their resignations to the city collector, Swaraj Parihar. Durrani is accused of interfering in the affairs of city even though he was the rural district collector. Corporators have ques-

tioned the leadership for allowing Durrani to have a free hand in running the party and taking decisions. Moreover, they said, Durrani takes decisions without consulting the other party corporators. They have asked the Parbhani civic chief to cancel the nomination of Inamdar. The corporators are likely to approach NCP leader Ajit Pawar to resolve the crisis.

Hit by tremors, two talukas in Palghar put on high alert

Amid rising sense of fear among residents of many villages in Palghar district of Maharashtra due to recent spate of tremors, the administration has put two talukas on high alert and roped in the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) for relief work. According to officials, the administration has started reaching out to residents of Dahanu and Talasari talukas to assuage their fears and setting up make-shift camps for them. The region has been experiencing low-intensity tremors since November. On Friday alone, it witnessed at least half a dozen tremors ranging

between 3 and 4.1 on the Richter scale, which caused immense panic among the residents. Talking to PTI on Saturday, Palghar District Collector Prashant Narnavre said, "The administration has put Dahanu and Talasari talukas on high alert. An NDRF team has reached there to educate the villagers." "The sub-divisional officer has been holding meetings with gram sevaks and village sarpanchs about the dos and

don'ts that the villagers need to follow when tremors occur," he said. According to Narnavre, 42 locations have been identified across two talukas where tents are being set up. "We have instructed the villagers to take shelter in these tents at night and not in their houses," he added. The official said, the administration has released Rs 10 lakh from the district funds for the relief measures. "The Public Works Department (PWD) and other agencies have also been directed to remain alert. The district administration and the police department have been maintaining round-the-clock vigil in these villages," he said.

Four peddlers nabbed in Dahisar, Mazgaon

Anti-Narcotics Cell (ANC) of Kandivali and Mazgaon units arrested peddlers and seized 70 kgs of cannabis and pharmaceutical drugs worth ₹28 lakh in Dahisar and Mazgaon on Friday. ANC Kandivali unit arrested three accused, identified as Laxmi Bhaskar Volandas (40), Sampurna Gandhi Mistry (40) and Bharat Vijay Shah (36) from Pushpavihar Colony slums near SV road Dahisar (East). The accused operated the supply of drugs from the Sudhir Phadke fly-over in Dahisar. In another raid, the ANC Worli unit arrested a peddler, Nagesh Prakash Thakur, (34) and seized drugs, including Alprazolam, 1,260 strips of tablets and Rexo Chlorpheniramine Malate, syrup Codeine Phosphate (100 ml) 46 bottles costing ₹9,200. The to-

tal seizure of drugs cost ₹2,61,200. The accused conducted their business from EPT Colony, Mazgaon. A case was registered under relevant sections of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act.

70 kgs of cannabis and pharmaceutical drugs to the tune of ₹28 lakh were seized from the four peddlers in separate raids in Mumbai's Dahisar and Mazgaon localities

Techie murder: Accused vows to shun HRS activities

MUMBAI: Dhananjay Desai, an accused in the Mohsin Shaikh murder case, has given an undertaking to the High Court while obtaining bail that he would not take part in the activities of Hindu Rashtra Sena, his organisation, till the trial is over. Shaikh, an IT professional, was killed in Pune in 2014 fol-

lowing an alleged provocative speech made by Desai. He got bail from the Bombay High Court on January 17. As per the bail order which was made available a few days ago, the court took an undertaking from Desai that he would not "run the Hindu Rashtra Sena", or be a part of it or give speeches on

behalf of the organisation till the trial is over. Desai also undertook to apply to another HC bench for vacation of a stay to the trial. The stay had been granted on Desai's application in 2017. Desai's bail plea was rejected eight times by the sessions court and once by HC's another bench. —Agencies

2 held for raping girl in Wadala

MUMBAI: Wadala Police arrested two men for sexually assaulting a 13-year-old girl, who resided in their neighbourhood on January 30. The two accused, identified as Sunil Mhatre, 51, and Suresh Sarang, 53, have been booked under the relevant IPC and the POCSO Act sections. Sources said the duo had been repeatedly raping the girl for a year, by forcing her to accompany them to various areas. On January 30, when Sarang entered a public toilet in Sewri along with the girl, people found it suspicious. They called police, who nabbed the accused. —Staff Reporter

MBMC to procure 68-metre tall ladder for fire brigade

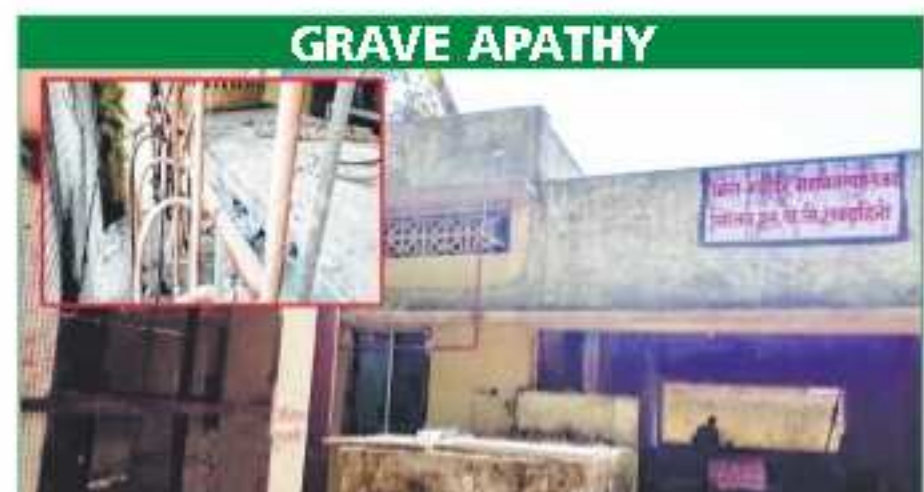
For those opting to live in high-rises above 14 floors in Mira Road, god's mercy seems to be the only solace in case of a fire. Reason: while the fire brigade has ladders that reach only up to 38 metres, the Mira Bhayandar Municipal Corporation (MBMC) continues clearing proposals for buildings up to a height of 70 metres (25 floors).

More than five years after standing instructions issued by the Directorate of Maharashtra Fire Services, the MBMC has finally set the ball rolling to procure its tallest ladder for the fire and emergency service wing. After extended round of delays, a Germany-based manufacturer was finally short-listed to provide a state-of-the-

art, 68-metre tall Turn Table Ladder (TTL) which can reach as high as 24 floors. However, the procurement will take at least 16 months after the issuance of work order, even as several buildings are on the verge of completion, some even occupied. With an estimated price tag of around 14,00,850 Euros (approx. Rs 11.46 crore), the multi-faceted equipment will have a host of specified features to match the international standards. MBMC's LPG-fuelled pyres crying for repairs

Maintenance of the LPG-fuelled pyres at crematoriums is not a priority in the work agenda of the Mira Bhayandar Municipal Corporation (MBMC), it seems. Despite increasing awareness and acceptability for the green cremation system to dispose mortal remains, the pathetic state of the lone LPG crematorium in Bhayandar (west) exposes the indifferent attitude of the civic administration towards environment friendly measures, this despite spending lakhs on such much needed initiatives. Apart from broken rollers and cracked stands, leaking gas lines are a cause of serious concern as it could lead to major mishap. After looking at the sorry

state of the LPG-fuelled pyre, eco-conscious family members who voluntarily opt for an environment friendly funeral for the departed soul are left with no other alternative, but to hurriedly make arrangements to conduct the final rites on the traditional wood-based open air pyre. "Repeated pleas have gone to the deaf ears of our high-

er-ups," revealed an on-duty personnel. "The crematorium is under annual maintenance contract and the concerned agency will be asked to the needful at the earliest," assured a MBMC officer. After an extremely slow start owing to traditional beliefs, the use of the LPG crematorium has been gradually increasing in the twin-city.

LGBTQs hold pride march in SoBo

MUMBAI: Over 250 members of the LGBTQ community Saturday held a "pride march" from August Kranti Maidan to Opera House and back, in south Mumbai, to highlight issues facing them. Such pride marches have been held by the Lesbian-Gay-Bisexual-Trans-Queer community in different

parts of the country since 2005, organisers said. While the earlier demand was the decriminalisation of section 377 of the IPC, current demands include inclusion in workplace, education, marriage, adoption rights, protection against abuse and discrimination, they said. —Agencies

AROUND THE STATE

Addl collector, clerk held for bribery

BEED: The additional collector of Beed district was on Saturday arrested for allegedly demanding and accepting a bribe of ₹5 lakh, a senior state Anti-Corruption Bureau official said. Additional Collector B M Kamble was heading an inquiry into foodgrain warehouses in the district and he allegedly demanded a bribe of ₹10 lakh from a person who was being probed in this connection, the official said. The complainant negotiated with Kamble and the two agreed on a bribe amount of ₹5 lakh, the ACB official said. "The complainant then approached the ACB on January 31. We laid a trap and caught Kamble and his middleman, senior clerk Mahadev Mahakude of the Public Distribution Scheme department, when they accepted ₹5 lakh at Kamble's residence here on Saturday," he said. A case has been registered with the Shivaji Nagar police station in the district and ACB teams are carrying out searches here as well as in Aurangabad and Nanded districts as part of the probe, he said.

Two Africans arrested with cocaine

BHAYANDAR: Sleuths of the Thane (rural) police apprehended two African nationals who were found to be in possession of cocaine worth around ₹1.80 lakh in Kashmiria during the early morning hours on Friday. Acting on a tip-off, a team led by Senior Inspector Vaibhav Shivhare under the supervision of Deputy SP Shantaram Valli rounded up the suspected drug peddlers of Nigerian origin from the Hatkesh industrial area. Upon frisking, the accused were found to be carrying 18 grams of cocaine powder. Those arrested have been identified as Ochiopong Emmanuel (37) and Obol Christopher (20), both natives of Ghana. A case under the relevant sections of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 has been registered against the accused who have been remanded to custody. —Suresh Golani

Naxals kill two villagers in Gadchiroli

NAGPUR: Suspected naxals on Saturday killed two villagers in Gadchiroli district, apparently on suspicion they are police informers. The incident occurred in the wee hours when some ultras dragged Girma Kadyami and Samru Kosni, both residents of Markegaon village in Dhanora taluka, out of their houses and shot them dead, said Gadchiroli SP Shailesh Balkawde. On January 21, Maoists had killed three villagers in Kasnasur area, around 140 kms from here, on suspicion their tip-off to police led to killing of 40 ultras in a massive operation in the region in 2018. The SP said naxals are killing innocent villagers out of "frustration". —Agencies

मुंबईकरांचे टेन्शन वाढणार

मुंबई, रविवार - मागील वर्षाच्या तुलनेत तलावांत अडीच लाख दशलक्ष लिटर कमी जलसाठा आहे. त्यामुळे १५ नोव्हेंबरपासून मुंबईत १० टक्के पाणीकपात लागू करण्यात आली आहे. पाण्याची गळती, चोरी आणि बाष्पीभवनमुळे तलावांत ३१ जानेवारीपर्यंत ७ लाख १४ हजार दशलक्ष लिटर जलसाठा शिल्लक राहिला. परिणामी ऐन उन्हाळ्यात मुंबईकरांना पाणीटंचाईचा सामना करावा लागणार आहे.

पत्तीच्या पावसाने दगा दिल्याने तलावांत १५ टक्के जलसाठा कमी जमा झाला. पालिकेने १५ नोव्हेंबर रोजी तलावांतील जलसाठ्याचा आढावा घेऊन सरसकट १० टक्के पाणीकपात लागू केली आहे. या पाणीकपातीची कळी असून अनेक विभागांना बसली असून याचे तीव्र पडसाद स्थायी समिती, महापालिकेची महासभा, प्रभाग समित्यांच्या बैठकीत उमटले. विभागात पाणी मिळत नसल्याने रस्त्यावरून चालणे मुश्कील झाल्याची तक्रार सर्वपक्षीय नगरसेवक करत आहेत, परंतु हिवाळ्यात पाण्याचा वापर कमी होत असल्याने त्याचा दिलासा मुंबईकरांना मिळेल, अशी आशा व्यक्त होत होती.

दरम्यान, ३१ जानेवारी रोजी घेतलेल्या आढाव्यात प्रमुख तलावांत ७ लाख १४ हजार दशलक्ष लिटर जलसाठा उपलब्ध आहे. गेल्या वर्षी याच तारखेला नऊ लाख दशलक्ष लिटर जलसाठा उपलब्ध होता. या वर्षी अडीच लाख दशलक्ष लिटर जलसाठ्याची तफावत आढळली आहे. एप्रिल, मे महिन्यात पाची पळून मुंबईकरांना बसणार असल्याने, पाण्याच्या नियोजनासाठी पाणीकपातीत वाढ होण्याची शक्यता आहे. पाणी कपात झाल्यास मुंबईकरांचे उन्हाळ्यात होणार आहेत.

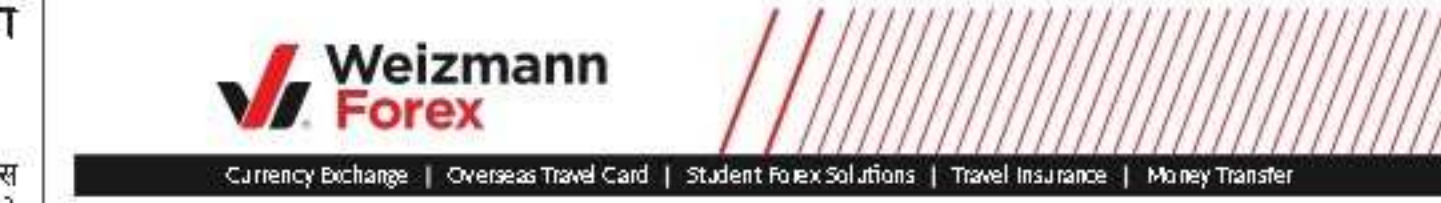
