Four cops arrested by ACB in ₹30.50L extortion case

The Accused Surrender Before A Court And ACB Sleuths

Surat: Sleuths of anti-corruption bureau (ACB) on Monday arrested the four absconding cops, who are accused in Rs30.50 lakh extortion case registered at Sarthana police station. The cops, on the run since April 5, surrendered before a local court and ACB sleuths, who will now produce them in court on Tuesday. The accused had extorted money for shielding a garage owner, who was running a racket of changing registration and chassis numbers of vehicles.

N D Chaudhary, police inspector; H M Chauhan, police sub-inspector; Gopal Bharwad, constable, and Bhagu Bharwad, constable, were earlier booked for extortion and under the provisions of Prevention of Corruption Act. Of them, Chauhan surrendered before the court while the other accused before the

ACB sleuths.

They extorted money from garage owner Irshad Pathan to shield him. Pathan used to allegedly change registration and chassis number of buses to evade taxes. He later sold the buses to private bus operators. Police had recovered 300 registration certificates of buses during investigation. Instead of exposing the statewide racket, the accused cops had shielded Pathan and accepted money from

him, an inquiry revealed.

On July 23, Supreme Court rejected anticipatory bail application of Chaudhary and ordered him to surrender before court within two weeks. His bail application was earlier rejected by high court. The ACB court in city had rejected the anticipatory bail applications of all the four accused.

Earlier in March, Suresh and Jayesh Jivani, residents of Varachha, approached Sarthana police station and

informed cops that Pathan was running a racket to change chassis number of buses. Pathan had purchased a bus from a finance company, earlier owned by Jivani, but was seized over non-payment of loan.

Sarthana police detained Pathan, his aide and also seized the bus, chassis number of which was changed. Pathan was later freed by them without registering any offence after which Jivani approached senior police officials. An inquiry against the four cops who were posted at Sarthana police station revealed that they had taken Rs30.50 lakh from Pathan.

Later city police registered two FIRs at Sarthana police station in connection with the case. Pathan, 39, was booked on March 31 for forgery, cheating and tampering with evidence. The four cops were booked in the second FIR. Both the cases were later transferred to ACB.

SDA president's statement irks jobless diamond workers

Surat: Surat Diamond Association (SDA) president Babu Gujarati's statement that 'despite slowdown, diamond workers wanting to work are getting jobs' has sparked off a controversy here on Monday.

Babu Gujarati had stated the industry is getting back on track and that the diamond workers are getting jobs at a press conference on Saturday.

Diamond worker Hitesh Nari's telephonic conversation with Babu Gujarati went viral on Monday. In the audio, the jobless diamond worker took Gujarati to task for his statement and demanded job for himself. Gujarati accepted it was his mistake and that he was sorry for hurting the sentiments of worker community.

Later in the day, Gujarat Diamond Workers' Union (GDWU) called upon him and submitted details of 4,200 jobless diamond workers. They urged him to find decent jobs for them. Sensing trouble, Gujarati tendered his apology and promised to work for the betterment of worker community.

GDWU president Ranmal Jilariya told TOI, "About four

diamond workers have committed suicide and 4,200 are jobless. Still, the SDA president maintains that everything is going on well in the diamond industry. His statement has irked the worker community. We met the SDA president and he accepted his mistake and showed willingness to work for the betterment of workers. The SDA will raise the workers' issue with the government as well."

When contacted, Babu Gujarati said, "Being president of SDA, it is my duty to protect the image of the industry. However, if the workers are hurt, I tender my apology to them."

Rain floods Auranga river

Valsad District Issues Alert

Surat: Heavy rains in Kaprada and Dharampur talukas of Valsad district have resulted in Auranga river flowing just above its danger mark near Valsad town. Low lying areas of Valsad like Lilapur bridge, Dariyawad, Bandar road, Smashan Bhoomi are getting flooded and first alert warning has been issued by the district administration.

As yet, the water has not overflowed the Lilapur bridge, and as a result no announcement of migration has been made. However, district collector C R Kharsan has asked people to stay alert and be ready if the need for shifting arises by late night following heavy rains.

Authorities at Madhuban Dam over Damanganga river near Vapi has opened up eight gates four metre wide to release 1.26 lakh cusecs of water against the inflow of 1.12 lakh cusecs of water. This inflow of water is due to heavy rains in the last 12 hours in Kaprada taluka of Valsad district. The level at Madhuban dam is at 73.55 metres against the danger level of 82.42 metres.

Kharsan said, "We have an ultra violet camera fitted at Bhairvi bridge at Dharampur some 50 km of Valsad. When the level of inflowing water crosses at a 4.20 metres, we sound an alert in low lying areas of Valsad. At present, the level is 4.29 metres and is steady at the same point and so we hope it won't rise above that. Still we are ready if we have to shift people. We are ready with shelter places."

Meanwhile after clouded skies throughout the morning, many talukas including Surat city recorded good rains up to 110 mm and 103 mm in Mangrol and Umrapada. Surat city recorded 34 mm of rains up to 6.00 pm since 6.00am on Monday.

Surat city witnessed three incidents of tree uprooting at Amroli-Chapra Bhatia road, Bhatarnear Rupali canal, near Varachha zone office at Vikramnagar and at Falsawadi near Delhi gate circle. One incident of electric short circuit was reported at Magob near BRTS station. Waterlogging was witnessed at several places in the city.

In Dang district heavy rainfall was reported in the past 12 hours in three talukas including Saputara (105 mm), Waghai (92mm) and Ahwa (90 mm).

Signal failure at Surat station delays five trains

Surat: Passengers going toward Ahmedabad and Mumbai were stranded here after a few trains got held up due to a technical fault in Up and Down signal at Surat railway station on Monday.

Sources said the Up and Down signal network at the railway station got disrupted due to heavy rain on Monday. Five trains could not get clearance for arrival and departure from the station.

The trains going toward Ahmedabad, including Paschim Express, was late by 30 minutes; Suryanagri Express by 20 minutes and Bandra-Hisar Express by 20 minutes. The trains going toward Mumbai, including Rajkot-Secunderabad, was late by 20 minutes and Okha-Ernakulam by 10 minutes, respectively.

A senior station officer said, "The trains were running late by 10 minutes to 30 minutes due to a fault in the train signalling system. Train movement was normalised after the fault was rectified."

Surat: Amid slowdown in the world's largest diamond cutting and polishing centre in Surat, industry stakeholders have come on a single platform to organize the biggest-ever 'loose diamond' exhibition named 'Carats' in the first week of August.

The Carats exhibition, being organized by Surat Diamond Association (SDA), is expected to spur demand of polished diamonds ahead of Diwali and Christmas festivals. About 80 per cent of exhibitors there are a total of 70 exhibitors are small and medium firms.

According to industry experts, small and medium players in the industry will get a big platform as more than 1,500 buyers from across the country and abroad, including the United States, Hong Kong, Israel, Dubai, Antwerp and London will be visiting the three-day exhibition starting from August 3 at a club on Surat-Dumas Road.

SDA president Babu Gujarati said, "This three-day long loose diamond exhibition will be a game-changer for the industry, which is facing a slowdown. Unlike other exhibitions in the world, Carats is an exclusive exhibition of polished diamonds."

According to Gujarati, the prices of polished diamonds have fallen by almost 12 per cent in the last few months. However, there are small sizes like Stars and Melee where the demand is excellent.

Polished diamond export from the country between April-June 2019 fell 18% to \$5.2 billion compared to \$6.2 billion during the same period in previous year. The export of polished diamonds in June 2019 fell 20% to \$1.6 billion.
