IIT Madras, VIT join hands with London varsity to develop system to contain airborne diseases

New Delhi, Aug 15: Researchers from IIT Madras, Vellore Institute of Technology, Chennai and London's Queen Mary University have joined hands to develop a revolutionary air sanitisation system aimed at preventing the spread of the coronavirus and TB bacterium.

The Royal Academy of Engineering (RAENG), UK will be the chief sponsor for the project and air sanitisation solution provider Magneto CleanTech will be the sole industry partner.

According to officials from the top educational institutions, the aim of this joint research is to develop a robust low-cost bio-aerosol protection system to contain airborne diseases in indoor environments for the Indian subcontinent, a geography known for its high population and heavy urban pollution.

Employing Ultraviolet-C radiation, the project is envisaged to develop an experimental proof-of-concept of a revolutionary air filtration system. This system has a strong potential to increase the effectiveness of eliminating viruses and other airborne pathogens while also reducing maintenance cost as compared to the available filters, an important proposition for developing countries such as India, they claimed.

"Various UVC

solutions are present in the market but they lack the technical design rigour needed to ensure appropriate airborne disinfection and inactivation. This has led to consumer confusion and mistrust. The projects' goal is to develop a solution that is extensively verified and tested from both theoretical and practical perspectives, and finally the safety made visible in a consumer-friendly manner ensures live performance of the system," said Abdus Samad, Professor at IIT Madras.

With the involvement of Magneto CleanTech, testing and implementation of this system will be done with real-time applications in various Indian environments. It is expected that this project, when successfully implemented, will benefit nearly 10 crore people in the Indian subcontinent.

"We are delighted and indeed honoured to be a part of this elite global research team. Given our longstanding focus on air quality engineering and air sanitization technologies, this was just the right platform for us to contribute where we are looking at development of a revolutionary product that has potential of ensuring health and safety of global populations, benefitting the world," said Himanshu Agarwal, CEO of Magneto

CleanTech.

The consortium will also be supported by Professor Clive Beggs of Leeds Beckett University as the project consultant.

"Designing any practical system needs a multidisciplinary team. Eventually we got experts from electronic and electrical system designers, microbiologists, fluid system designers. Sars-Cov-2 spreads quickly and new variants are evolving as we have seen in delta and other variants. We need to proceed with the right technology to contain, disinfect it. Our solution will work, in general, for air disinfectants for indoor conditions," said Eldad Avital from Queen Mary University of London.

Nithya Venkatesan, Professor at VIT Chennai, said, "One very important aspect is that we will seek to establish guidelines for how to use this air cleaning device in concert with other policies of cleaning, ventilation and social distancing. We will account for the features found in high density population centres in India and similar developing countries. This will be achieved through advanced fluid dynamics modelling, risk analysis and co-operation with national and local stakeholders. "

Graded opening of schools in Karnataka

Bengaluru, Aug 15:

Karnataka Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai on Saturday chose to remain cautious by deciding not to reopen schools in districts where the Covid-19 positivity rate is over two per cent.

Bengaluru will be kept on a leash. The city will face stringent curbs if and when the positivity rate touches two per cent. It is currently 0.66 per cent. This was discussed in a meeting Chief

Dists with positivity below 2% to begin 9 to 12 classes

Minister Basavaraj Bommai chaired with experts and officials to chart out the next steps to deal with the pandemic, especially in Bengaluru and districts bordering Kerala and Maharashtra.

The positivity rate is more than 2% in five districts - Dakshina Kannada (3.98%), Chikmagalur (3.24%), Kodagu (2.71%), Udupi

(2.42%) and Hassan (2.23%), according to the government.

The Government had plans to reopen Classes 9-12 from August 23. "In the districts where the positivity rate is more than two per cent, the schools will not reopen for now," Bommai said.

Schools that are set to reopen will have to see that parents, teachers

and non-teaching staff are vaccinated. "In case a particular district sees an increase in positivity rate beyond two per cent after the schools reopen, the schools will have to shut for one week and be sanitised," Bommai said.

The government will ramp up testing and vaccination in districts bordering Kerala and Maharashtra. Specifically, the government will prioritize vaccination in villages situated in a 10 km radius from the Kerala and Maharashtra border.

Bommai said the government's focus was to ensure that the second wave of Covid-19 was completely gone.

"Experts have said the second wave hasn't gone still. We're still in the second wave.

There are still about 1,800 cases being reported daily, unlike the first wave where we saw only 200-300 cases towards the end," Bommai explained.

Since the cases vary in each district, there will henceforth be 'no one rule that fits all' for the entire state, Bommai said. "The state government will come up with a district-wise plan to curb cases," he said.

The government will regulate all border districts where the positivity rate is high. These include Mysuru, Hassan, Chikmagalur, Udupi, Bengaluru Rural, Shivamogga, Dakshina Kannada, Kodagu and Chamarajanagar. Testing and vaccination will be increased in these Districts.

Taliban gets foothold near capital, Kandahar under strict Islamic laws

Kabul, Aug 15: The Taliban seized a province just south of Afghanistan's capital and launched a multi-pronged assault on Mazar-e-Sharif, a major city in the north defended by powerful former warlords, Afghan officials said.

Homa Ahmadi, a lawmaker from Logar, says the Taliban control the entire province, including its capital, and reached a district in the neighbouring Kabul province on Saturday. That puts the insurgents less than 80 km (50 miles) south of the nation's capital.

The Taliban have also captured much of northern, western and

southern Afghanistan less than three weeks before the United States is set to withdraw its last troops. The Taliban meanwhile released a video in which an unnamed insurgent announced the takeover of the main radio station in the southern city of Kandahar, which fell to the insurgents earlier this week.

The station has been renamed the Voice of Sharia, or Islamic law. It was not clear if the Taliban had purged the previous employees or allowed them to return to work. Most

residents of Kandahar sport the traditional dress favored by the Taliban. The man in the video congratulated the people of Kandahar on the Taliban's victory.

The Taliban have operated mobile radio stations over the years, but have not operated a station inside a major city since they ruled the country from 1996-2001. At that time, they also ran a station called Voice of Sharia out of Kandahar, the birthplace of the militant group. Music was banned.

Home Ministry notifies Aug 14 as Partition Horrors Remembrance Day

New Delhi, Aug 15: The Union Home Ministry on Saturday issued a notification declaring that August 14 will be observed as Partition Horrors Remembrance Day to salute those who sacrificed their lives

during the country's partition, hours after Prime Minister Narendra Modi made the announcement to this effect.

The prime minister has said that August 14 will be observed as Partition Horrors

Remembrance Day in the memory of the struggles and sacrifices of people, saying the pain of partition can never be forgotten.

Union Home Minister Amit Shah has welcomed Prime Minister Modi's decision to observe August 14 as Partition Horrors Remembrance Day.

"The wound of the partition of the country and the grief of losing loved ones cannot be described in words. I am sure that Partition

Horrors Remembrance Day will strengthen peace, love and unity by eliminating the ill-will of discrimination and malice from society," he said in a tweet in Hindi.

In a notification, the Home Ministry said the people of India, while celebrating Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, will salute those sons and daughters of the country who had to sacrifice their lives during the partition of India.

Sainik schools open for girls too

New Delhi, Aug 15: Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Sunday announced that all Sainik Schools in the country will now be open for girls also.

At present, 33 Sainik schools are operating in the country.

During his Independence Day speech Sunday, the Prime Minister said that two-and-a-half years ago, the maiden experiment of admitting girls in Sainik schools was carried out in Mizoram.

"Now, the government has decided that all the Sainik schools in the country will also be open for the daughters of the country," he said.

Sainik schools are run by the Sainik Schools Society which is under the administrative control of the Ministry of Defence.

The aim of establishing Sainik schools was to prepare the students from an early age for their entry into the Indian armed forces.
