# Reservation policy should be followed in hirings via lateral entry: Backward classes body

CLAIMING that the Central government's recruitment via the lateral entry route violates reservation rules, the Gujarat chapter of the National Union of Backward Classes, SCs, STs and Minorities (NUBCSSM) has demanded that the government follow the reservation policy in such hirings too.

Days after the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) issued a notice to recruit 20 officers for joint secretary and director/deputy secretary-level posts, NUBCSSM Gujarat state convener Vipul Makwana sub-

mitted a memorandum, addressed to President Droupadi Murmu, to Surenranagar district collector last month.

In the memorandum, the union has stated that lateral entry recruitment goes against civil services aspirants from SC, ST and OBC communities.

"The government started recruiting private sector persons through a different process than the usual selection process for a civil servant. This also raises concerns of transparency and objectivity in the recruitment process because in reply to an RTI, UPSC mentioned that there was no recruitment rules for lateral recruitment. These appointments raise many con-

cerns in the minds of civil services aspirants and people from the weaker sections such as SC, ST and OBCs," the memorandum states.

In the Central government, 15 per cent posts are reserved for SCs, 7.5 per cent for STs and 27 per cent for OBCs. "However, in reply to an RTI we had filed, the Central government revealed that as of February 1, 2022, out of 443 officers of joint secretary, additional secretary and secretary rank officers in the Central government, only 72 officers were SCs, STs and OBCs. That means, only 16.25 per cent posts were held by officers from SCs, STs and OBC communities against 49.5 per

cent reserved for them," Makwana says. The NUBCSSM convener said that a 1968 memorandum of the Central government mandates that any recruitment by the Central government for 45 days or longer should follow the reservation policy. "However, the Central government is not following the reservation roster while recruiting officers through the lateral entry route by treating vacancies as isolated and not as a group," he said.

# CM Patel: Organ donation will become common if we get rid of misconceptions

ORGAN DONATIONS will become a common practice if we get rid of misconceptions surrounding the same, said Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel in Ahmedabad Sunday. The CM said that efforts are being made to create awareness regarding organ donation through media.

"670 living persons and 203 brain-dead persons donated their organs last year giving life to the needy. The joy of the recipient family in need overcomes the grief of the donor relative. It has become the duty of the government and all of us to stand together for everything related to human life," the Chief Minister said at 'Angdan Mahotsav', a joint initiative of the Gujarat unit of the Indian Medical Association (IMA), State Organ Tissue and Transplant Organisation (SOTTO), and the Gujarat Media Club.

The Chief Minister also appealed to everyone to donate organs after the death of their relatives. "There is no greater donation than organ donation," he added.

An official release from the state government stated that 272

dialysis centres have been operationalised to ensure that patients get the best treatment under the One State One Dialysis programme.

"Under the guidance of the Chief Minister, the health department is doing exemplary work in the field of organ donation. Financial provision has been made in this year's budget to promote organ donation and transplantation," said Health Minister Rushikesh Patel.

The highlighted super speciality hospitals and medical centres are being constructed in Surat, Vadodra, Jamnagar, and Bhavnagar at par with Ahmedabad Civil Medicality to boost medical tourism. "Organ retrieval and transplant centres are being increased at the district level and in government as well as private hospitals to reduce the waiting time for organ transplants," he added.

# Naturalists in Central Gujarat mark National Moth Week

A GROUP of naturalists marked the National Moth Week (NMW), the annual global event dedicated to observing, studying, and recording moth diversity, by observing moths in Central Gujarat.

Led by Venus Joshi, project manager of Community for Conservation of Nature (Cocoon), an initiative of NGO Shivranjani Trust in Halol in the Panchmahal district, naturalists have been observing moths in the Panchmahal district for the last week. "We have organised moth-viewing sessions in urban areas, on the outskirts of town as well as in Jambughoda forests. We are conducting ses-

sions of viewing moths mostly at night as that is the time when these insects are most active." Joshi, who is also a well-known birdwatcher in Gujarat, said.

NMW is a global citizen science initiative launched in 2012 by members of Friends of the East Brunswick Environmental Commission, an NGO in New Jersey dedicated to local environmental education and conservation. This year's initiative concluded on Sunday.

"Moths are very important in the ecosystem as they act as pollinators besides being an important part of the food chain," said Joshi, adding that the team will analyse data they have collected over the last week to ascertain the number of moth species they have observed.
