New Delhi: The government has notified Copyright (Amendment) Rules, 2021 and a new provision that eliminates the requirement of publication in the Official Gazette. To encourage accountability and transparency, new provisions have been introduced to disclose with the details of royalty amounts and use of official electronic and traceable payment methods for collection and distribution of royalties. The compliance requirements for registration of software works have been reduced and the applicant can file the first 100 and last 10 pages of source code, or the entire source code if less than 200 pages. NEW DELHI: The Income tax department has started issuing notices of reassessment of tax liability for 2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16. NHA to Propose a More Rewarding Highways Plan

Plan review to consider changes in infra and traffic dynamics: Chairman

New Delhi: The National Highways Authority of India (NHA) will propose a rolling plan for the highway development of secondary highways to be reviewed every two to three years to assess the changing traffic dynamics and the authority says the maximum value of building a new road, Chairman Sukhbir Singh Sandhu has said.

The idea is to have a highway building plan that moves on real-time developments, and in tandem with decisions, whether it be airports, or industrial parks, he said.

"We are proposing a national plan, which will be rolling, and is reviewed every two to three years on the basis of changing traffic dynamics and other developments," Sandhu said.

"We will soon be approaching the ministry of road transport and highways for the bid," he added.

Reconstruction of highway building was mentioned by finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman in her budget speech for FY20.

"The government will carry out a comprehensive restructuring of the National Highway programme to ensure that the National Highway Grid of desirable length and capacity is created using a fundable model," Sitharaman had said.

help the authority during the maximum value in terms of toll collection while building a new road.

BOT & ASSET MONETISATION: Sandhu said that the Build-Operate-Transfer (BOT) model has had a success after changes in the model concession agreement for such projects, and bids for at least two more BOT projects will be invited soon. In January, NHA, which is under the ministry of road transport and highways, had unveiled a revised model concession agreement for BOT projects. In a bid to draw larger participation from investors, in BOT projects, private sector developers build a road using their own funds, operate it and then transfer it to the government after a specified period.



"We have tested the new model concession agreement and it's a success, the highest bidder is offering us 1% revenue share," Sandhu said. "We will put out at least two more projects immediately on BOT mode," he added.

Sandhu said that so far as the asset monetisation exercise of the authority is concerned, it will go for toll-operate-transfer, infrastructure investment trust (IIT), and toll facilitation through SPV for monetising its assets.

"We filed (IITF) application on 2nd March with S&I and we hope to get approvals in three weeks, and by mid-July we should have the money with us," Sandhu said.

He added that more assets worth 4,000-4,500 crore will be added to the IITF in FY22.

Pre-Pack Insolvency Plan for MSMEs to Save Jobs: MCA Secy

servation aspect of prepack frameworks for small firms has worked very well.

The government last Sunday promulgated an ordinance to amend the Insolvency & Bankruptcy code to provide for pre-packs for MSMEs.

MSMEs, a pre-pack got resolution allows a company to propose a plan in cooperation with creditors during insolvency proceedings, reducing the time and cost involved in the process. The new framework applies to defaults occurring during the pandemic and is based on the 'debtor in possession' model, with the involvement of a resolution professional only to monitor the process.

NEW DELHI: The government expects the rollout of the pre-packaged insolvency resolution framework for micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs) with an aim to preserve jobs, said Rajesh Verma, secretary to the corporate affairs ministry.

While the ordinance necessary to the treasury law covers only corporate MSMEs, they account for over 60% of all active Indian corporates, Verma said. "The employment potential of MSMEs is very large, so job preservation is one of the objectives of this pre-pack framework," said Verma. "In the right jurisdictions like the Netherlands, UK and elsewhere, the job pres-

NEW DELHI: The threshold default for initiating the pre-packaged insolvency resolution process will be set at ₹10 lakh and above for MSMEs, said MS Sahoo, chairman of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India. The IIPs fees for the pre-packaged resolution will be decided by the CAC, Sahoo said.—Our Bureau

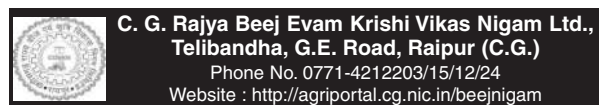
