## 60% of CSE 2022 toppers are women

### 40% Are From Humanities Stream, 25% Hail From UP

New Delhi: An analysis of 20 all-India toppers in Civil Services Examination 2022 (CSE 2022) shows that 60% of them are women, 45% engineers and 40% from the humanities stream with one-fourth hail from Uttar Pradesh.

Sharing these statistics during a meeting with the 20 top rankers in CSE 2022 here on Tuesday, minister of state for personnel and PMO Jitendra Singh said the fact that the first four rank-holders and 60% of the top 20 are women "is a great reflection of demographic changes happening in the last nine years of the Modi government, where India is moving from women's participation to women's leader-

ship". Three women — Ishita Kishore, Garima Lohia, Uma Harathi N — were the top three scorers in CSE 2022, repeating the trend from last year. "I hope for a hat-trick in the Civil Services Examination 2023," Singh said while felicitating the 20 toppers at his North Block office here. He described the 2022 batch of civil servants as the "Batch of Change Leaders", saying that

Sharing the educational profile of the 20 CSE toppers this year, the minister said they comprise nine engineers and one medical professional, while eight have a humanities degree and two from science. He welcomed this change, describing it democratisation of services through optimum use of technology. There were 10 engineers and two medicos among the top 20 in CSE-2021 while 11 engineers and three medicos dominated the top 20 slots in CSE 2020.

Singh also took note of the demographic change happening over the last few years and said the top 20 candidates this year represent a pan-India coverage, with five hailing from UP; three each from Bihar and Delhi; two each from Harvana and Jammu and Kashmir; and one each from Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Telangana and Assam. As per CSE 2021 results,

the top 20 candidates hailed from Bihar, UP, Punjab, Delhi, Haryana, Maharashtra, Kerala. Madhva Pradesh. Rajasthan and Telangana. The top 20 scorers in CSE 2020 were from Bihar, Chandigarh, Delhi, Gujarat, Haryana, Jharkhand, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Telangana and UP.

The minister underlined that even candidates who did their schooling from Kendriya Vidyalaya, Navodaya School and other government schools are cracking the exam, unlike earlier when it was largely the preserve of 'elite' schools.

While seven of the 20 all-India toppers cleared CSE 2022 in their third attempt, five passed in the fourth attempt, four in the first attempt and one in the fifth attempt. Half of the top 20 scorers are in the age group of 25 to 27 years, while five each are aged 21-24 years and 28-29 years.

### **Modi to launch** mass connect drive with Ajmer rally today

ampaign in-charge Tarun Chugh told reporters that launch the mass connect programme with a rally in Rajasthan's Ajmer on Wednesday. The drive, which began on Tuesday, will continue till June 30.

Chugh said senior party leaders will address 51 rallies across the country. Modi may address more such public meetings, besides Union ministers Amit Shah, Rajnath Singh, Nitin Gadkari and BJP chief JP Nadda among others.

The BJP national general secretary claimed it will be the biggest such mass connect programme. A total of 500 public meetings will be held at the Lok Sabha-level and party members will connect with over 5 lakh eminent families - around 1,000 in every Lok Sabha constituency — across the country, Chugh said. The party has divided the 543 Lok Sabha seats into 144 clusters, each having three to four constituencies.

Two senior party leaders, including ministers, will spend eight days in every cluster and hold various public connect programmes with different segments of society, including beneficiaries of government schemes, and present the government's report card on good governance and welfare of the

poor, he said. With Congress running a campaign claiming that the government's nine years have been marked by incompetence and failures, Chugh hit back, saying the UPA's 10-year term was mired in scams and scandals while the Modigovernment was known for its "zero tolerance" for corruption.

The BJP also launched a mobile number (9090902024) for people to show their support to the party by giving a missed call. One of the campaigns during the period will be 'Vikas Tirth' (pilgrimage to development), Chugh said, adding that party workers will visit visible marks of development such as new roads, institutes and other resources built by the Centre in every Lok Sabha constituency. Chugh said the party has identified over 16 lakh members for carrying out the exercise, which will touch every booth.

# ALH Dhruv being cleared for urgent ops; no routine sorties

**NEW DELHI:** The military has started clearing the advanced light helicopter Dhruv (ALH) for urgent flying missions in batches after comprehensive safety checks to keep itself operationally ready, but routine sorties are still no-go after the indigenous multi-mission chopper was grounded following three incidents in less than two months earlier this year, officials aware of the matter said on Tuesday. Most ALHs operated by the

armed forces were grounded for checks after the recent incidents -including the crash-landing of an army helicopter in Jammu & Kashmir's Kishtwar on May 4 in which a soldier was killed, and two pilots were injured -- raised serious safety concerns. The pilots reported a technical fault to air traffic control before the incident. The directorate general of military operations on May 22 wrote to different command headquarters about the restoration of flying of the ALH Dhruv, Rudra (the armed version of ALH) and the light com-

bat helicopter (LCH). The Indian Air Force's latest LCHs were also grounded earlier as they inherit several features of the ALH.

"ALH and LCH hepters are op endorsed to be cleared for op emer flg (operational emergency flying)," the letter stated. "Op endorsed" here refers to helicopters that have been cleared in servicing and certified fit to fly, one of the officials cited above explained. To be sure, it is not uncommon for an aircraft fleet to be grounded for inspection after an unexplained crash or incident. The DGMO letter accessed by Hindustan Times lays down two pre-conditions for restoring emergency flying.

It says such resumption of flights will follow the prescribed "satisfactory conduct of independent maintenance flight safety audit" of critical items and systems, and compliance with safety-related "special technical instructions and alert notices" issued by the technical authorities. The two directives were issued after the May 4 crash, said a second official, who asked not to be named.

The DGMO instructions only

talk about the resumption of critical operational missions. "This operational flying includes air maintenance (cargo transport to forward areas), casualty evacuation and other missions to support forward deployments. Training sorties are, currently, not on," one official said.

HT reported on May 10 that a design review of a "safety-critical system" on the ALH may be in order, according to a top government regulatory body responsible for the certification of the airworthiness of military aircraft. The Bengaluru-based Centre for Military Airworthiness and Certification (CEMILAC) wrote to the three services and the coast guard about this on April 23. It has ordered the design review of booster control rods to improve ALH's airworthiness. The call for the design review follows the ALH's troubling safety record. In the past five years, it has been involved in 12 accidents.

The design review is critical as the Indian armed forces operate more than 330 twin-engine ALHs, designed and developed by state-run aircraft maker Hindustan Aeronautics Limited. HAL began delivering these helicopters in the early 2000s.

CEMILAC, which functions under the Defence Research and Development Organisation, reached the conclusion that the design review of the booster control rods is mandatory after an expert committee, formed in the backdrop of a navy ALH ditching (emergency landing in water) into Arabian Sea on March 8, explored possible failures that led to the incident. These rods allow pilots to control helicopter's motion, and any failure can severely affect power input to the rotor blades and cause accidents. The committee, constituted by the CEMILAC chief executive (airworthiness), found that the most probable cause of the navy ALH incident on March 8 was a technical failure - an error in the assembly of serrated washers in the booster control rods. It recommended short and long-term measures to enhance the safety of the ALH.

"Though the helicopters are matured from the design point of view, having been exploited for more than 3 lakh hours, still there is scope to review the design/lifting aspects of the safety-critical system by an expert committee as a long-term measure," said the letter, written by CEMILAC director (helicopters and missiles) DM Isack.

"It is critical to fix the flaws on ALH as there are flight safety implications. It plays an important operational role and India operates large number of ALHs. Also, there are many potential foreign customers who are watching the helicopter closely,' Air Marshal Anil Chopra (retd), director general, Centre for Air Power Studies, said while commenting on CEMILAC findings.

## Military exports grew 23 times in 9 yrs, says govt

**NEW DELHI:** Military exports have risen sharply and imports have declined on the back of policy initiatives and reforms during the past nine years, the Union government said on Tuesday.

Exports grew 23 times between 2013-14 and 2022-23 financial years while the spending on sourcing weapons and systems from foreign countries dropped from 46% of the total expenditure in 2018-19 to 36.7% in December 2022, it said in a statement.

The defence report card came at a time when the central government is showcasing its achievements in different areas on its ninth anniversary.

"India's defence exports have reached an all-time high, surging from ₹686 crore in FY 2013-14 to nearly ₹16,000 crore in FY 2022-23. This remarkable 23-fold increase reflects India's progress in the global defence manufacturing sector," the statement said.

India had on May 19 announced that the value of defence production in the country crossed ₹1 lakh crore for the first time on the back of key reforms to spur growth in the sector.

The figure stood at ₹1,06,800 crore in 2022-23 compared to ₹95,000 crore in 2021-22 and ₹54,951 crore five years ago.

India produces a raft of weapons and systems including the Tejas light combat aircraft (LCA), different types of helicopters, warships, tanks, artillery guns, warships, missiles, rockets and a variety of military vehicles.

The country has sharpened its focus on defence manufacturing in the past five years and taken several measures to achieve self-reliance.

These include banning the import of a range of weapons. systems and parts, creating a separate budget for buying locally made military hardware, increasing foreign direct investment from 49% to 74% in defence production and improving ease of doing busi-

India is eyeing a turnover of ₹1,75,000 lakh crore in defence manufacturing by 2024-25. The country's focus is not

only on cutting dependence on imports, but also on boosting exports.

India is exporting military hardware to around 85 countries, with around 100 firms involved in outbound ship-It includes missiles, artillery

guns, rockets, armoured vehicles, offshore patrol vessels, personal protective gear, a variety of radars, surveillance systems and ammunition.

India has set a defence export target of ₹35,000 crore by 2024-25.

"To give a push to defence exports, the government has taken a number of policy initiatives and brought reforms over the last nine years," the central government statement said.

"Export procedures have been simplified and made industry-friendly, with end-toend online export authorisation curtailing delays and bringing ease of doing business," the statement said.

### A DAY AFTER CONG MEET, CM GEHLOT ASKS WORKERS TO EXERCISE 'PATIENCE'

JAIPUR: A day after Rajasthan chief minister Ashok Gehlot and his former deputy Sachin Pilot agreed to a joint fight against the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) in assembly elections later this year, Gehlot on Tuesday called upon party workers to exercise "patience" and wait for their opportunity to serve.

On Monday, the two leaders held a four-hour meeting with the Congress leadership to iron out differences that have roiled the state unit for four years. The contours of the agreement weren't immediately clear, but a senior Congress leader who asked not to be named said "core issues have not yet been resolved completely".

Talking to reporters before leaving for Jaipur, the CM said: "I remember the words of Sonia Gandhi who at the Congress convention had asked party workers to have patience and they would get to serve the party in some way. I keep this in my heart and tell partymen to have patience. They would get the opportunity to serve the party in some way. So I call for patience, patience, patience."

Asked if he expected Pilot to work with him now, the CM said: "If he (Sachin Pilot) is in the party then why won't he do this." "It is for the high command to decide what role one plays."

The conflict between Gehlot and Pilot dates back to December 2018 when both lobbied for the CM's post after the Congress returned to power in Rajasthan. The repeated sniping between the two leaders came to a head again earlier this month, when Pilot launched a march to protest apparent inaction against corruption by the Congress government.

## MiG-21s begin flying again after Rajasthan crash

**NEW DELHI:** The Indian Air Force's MiG-21 fighter jets have begun flying again after they were grounded for safety checks three weeks ago following a crash in Rajasthan on May 8 that proved fatal for three civilians on the ground, officials familiar with the matter said on Tuesday.

The air force operates more than 50 MiG-21 Bison aircraft, the latest and last variant of the MiG-21. The crash in Hanumangarh in which three women were killed put the spotlight on the troubling safety record of India's longest-serving fighter plane again and forced the air force to ground the entire fleet. It is not uncommon for an aircraft fleet to be grounded for inspection after an unexplained crash or incident. The air force operates three squadrons of the MiG-21 Bison. The squadrons have resumed flying, with the fighter jets being cleared for operations in batches, said one of the officials.

The IAF is set to retire these squadrons by 2025. The MiG-21

### 'Go First lessors' plea has no standing in HC'

RIGHT FORUM. NCLAT has directed lessors to approach either the Supreme Court or NCLT, says airline's IRP

Forum Gandh New Delhi

The Interim Resolution Professional (IRP) of Go First has said that the NCLAT has directed lessors to approach either the Supreme Court or NCLT. According to senior advocate Harish Salve, appearing on behalf of the IRP, parallel proceedings cannot go on at the Delhi High Court. A writ court is not empowered to pass order on the resolution process, he added.

On Tuesday, the Delhi High Court heard writ petitions filed by the six lessors of Go First against the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA). Senior advocate Harish Salve argued that the lessors' approach to the High Court was an attempt to disrupt the insolvency

Salve pointed out that the

NCLAT had directed the lessors to appeal to the Supreme Court if they wanted to challenge its decision, and the rest of the matter was directed to be taken up before the NCLT.

Salve expressed concerns about the potential consequences of the Delhi High Court's order, which directed the DGCA to release the aircraft to the lessors. He argued that such an order will undermine the insolvency process and result in a permanent halt to the company's operations, leading to significant job losses.

He emphasised the interconnectedness of the ongoing insolvency proceedings and the proceedings before the Delhi High Court, stating that any order issued by the High Court will directly impact the insolvency process.

Sandeep Sethi, another senior advocate representing the IRP, echoed Salve's arguments and highlighted the Supreme Court's consistent stance on minimal interference in insolvency proceedings. The case has been adjourned until May 31, and the DGCA is expected to present its side to the court.

### DEREGISTRATION

Previously, aircraft lessors had contended that the denial of deregistration by the DGCA was illegitimate, as they had requested deregistration based on the Irrevocable De-registration and Export Request Authorisations (IDERA).

The DGCA informed the court that the application by the lessors to repossess their aircraft was not officially rejected, but put on hold due to the ongoing moratorium.

Meanwhile, sources in the know said the DGCA is of the opinion that until the moratorium is lifted by any court, it cannot deregister an aircraft. The person said the aviation watchdog is not taking sides with an airline or



### ASCI asks educational institutes, edtechs not to send negative message through ads

Educational institutions or edtech platforms cannot create a false sense of urgency that could accentuate anxieties among school students or parents through advertisements. Such ads also cannot project average or poor scorers as unsuccessful.

These are part of the revised guidelines released by the Advertising Standards Council of India (ASCI) for educational institutions, programmes and platforms on Tuesday.

"An advertisement may not show school students compromising on sleep or meals to study as this normalises unhealthy habits that are detrimental to student health," it added

The revised guidelines also stated that while an ad may feature students of any gender, it must not suggest that certain subjects are associated with particular genders

"Advertisements must also not suggest that students with high scores are always associated with stereotypical characteristics such as wearing thick glasses. "This does not prevent ad-

vertisements from depicting such students so long as they do not suggest that only these students are successful," the guidelines added.

Manisha Kapoor, CEO and Secretary General, ASCI, told businessline that existing edu-

cation ad guidelines were largely focussed on checking on misleading claims by educational institutions.

"The updated guidelines will ensure that such ads refrain from messaging that can cause mental and physical harm, especially of school students," she said. Kapoor added that the guidelines will also ensure that ads by institutions and edtech platforms refrain from harping on stereotypes focussing on unhealthy competition and accentuating anxieties.

#### REVISED GUIDELINES

The guidelines were revised after a public consultation by ASCI. This comes at a time when the education sector has been among the top violators of advertising norms for the past few years.

In ASCI's annual complaints report 2022-23, claseducation ranked second among the top violative categories, accounting for 13.8 per cent of ads that flouted ASCI's guidelines

Curator Bhattacharya said: "Soham has shown promise. He knows how to use colours. We have given him a space and opportunity because we see in him new

said his mother. "There is stigma associated with special needs. As a mother I have faced ostracisation, too. Today, I feel reward

ed," said Singha Das.

ti had told me I should not put my son under any formal training because it would spoil his natural talent," said Singha Das.

### More time to find VC

Calcutta: The education department has extended the period within which a vice-chancellor has to be appointed after the term of the incumbent ends from six months to 12 months

The West Bengal University Laws (Amendment) Ordinance, promulgated a few days

ago, spells out the change. The extension was formalised days before the tenure of several interim VCs was going

A senior official of the state

education department said that 24 VCs are serving their three-month extension period that will end this month or early in June.

The 24 VCs, whose earlier extension had been questioned by then governor Jagdeep Dhankhar, had submitted their resignation to his successor C.V. Ananda Bose in February and got a fresh threemonth extension.

It would be difficult to appoint full-term VCs through the newly-constituted five-member search committee within six months.

The official said they had

extended the search period so that the committee created through the ordinance gets time to recommend a panel of names to fill up the posts.

This would enable those who are already officiating to continue for some more time, allowing the search process to be completed, he said.


