RAIN LASHES STATE'S SOUTH, NORTH AND WEST

Connectivity to Ch'garh, AP cut off

POINT NEWS NETWORK

Malkangiri, August 16: Amid heavy rains, several parts of Malkangiri and other areas in Malkangiri district are flooded under flood. Communication has been disrupted from Malkangiri to Chhatisgarh and from Malkangiri to Andhra Pradesh for three days. Floodwater as deep as four feet is flowing over Kalyansu bridge leading to scores of vehicles being stranded on both sides of the bridge.

As water level is rising in Polavaram, water in Silera and Schari flows fast to drain-out. The severe water from Polavaram project has allegedly created flood situation in certain pocket.

Bridge across Jonk river collapses Nagapada, Balasore: While heavy rain has been lashing most parts of Odisha for the last few days, triggered a depression in Bay of Bengal,

a bridge over Jonk river in Nagapada district collapsed. It has disrupted vehicular communication between Odisha and Chhatisgarh. Besides, communication to over 30 villages in

the district remained cut off. Meanwhile, two gates of the Jonk irrigation dam were opened. Rainwater as deep as three feet is flowing over Jonk bridge at Sarabang. After the collapse of the bridges of Malkangiri, Malkangiri and Motunapada panchayats has remained cut off from the rest of the world. Locals alleged that the bridge caved in due to sub-standard construction work.

In yet another case, a portion of a bridge across Coast canal near Kalamatia Pahi under Remuna block in Balasore district caved in owing to the torrential rains. The bridge provides connectivity to Balasore and Mayurbhanj districts. Officials have visited the spot.

Locals alleged that contractor had botched up its construction. Communication in different areas has been badly affected. House caves by one dies Koraput: Following heavy rains, a house in Koraput district caved in killing an elderly person. The deceased was identified as Chandra Muduli (60).

He was asleep when the house collapsed. Later, his body was recovered. Sarpanch Hiramani Gadaba reached the village and demanded compensation for the bereaved family.

Owing to heavy rain, as many as 134 houses were damaged in the district, according to sources in the district emergency department.

Work on crucial outer ring road in Sambalpur to start next year

The length of the proposed outer ring road which will be constructed under the Bharatmala project of the Union government is 37.82 km

Sambalpur, August 16: Work on the much-awaited outer ring road, which will help resolve the traffic problem of Sambalpur city is expected to commence in March next year, an official said.

Heavy vehicles coming from the NH40, Cuttack-Sambalpur NH55 and the Biju Expressway will not have to enter Sambalpur city after the outer ring road is constructed. Implementation of the project will also pave way for the expansion of the city.

A total of 250 hectares, including 170 hectares of private land, will be required for the implementation of the project, Rao said.

"We have planned a joint survey in September and drafting of a tender for the construction in October," he said, adding that the work on the project would start in March and a detailed draft project report had been prepared.

The length of the proposed outer ring road, which will be constructed under the Bharatmala programme of the Union government, is 37.82 km. It will originate from National Highway 53 at Goshala in Dhankawda area and connect the Sambalpur-Bourkela Biju Expressway at Barikuda in Bisan on the outskirts of the city.

2 held for torturing inmate at de-addiction centre

Baripada: Police arrested two persons on charges of torturing a differently-abled inmate at a de-addiction centre in Baripada. Shockingly, the inmate was made to lick the feet of two people. The inmate had to suffer such inhuman treatment in July 2021 and a video of the incident was made viral, according to police sources. In the video, the owner was seen whipping the inmate with a plastic rope and forcing him to lick his feet. The two accused were identified as owner of the de-addiction centre Abani Pati (42) and his aide Pitabas Roula (40). A complaint was lodged by Arun Kumar Behera, the director of Dibyang Sangh in this regard. Police registered a case and started an investigation into the matter. SDO K Hariprasad said that the licence of the de-addiction centre will be scrapped and the Collector will be intimated about it. It may be noted here that the licence of the de-addiction centre had been cancelled in 2017.
