

Row over 'Katha' continues, now RJD also objects to it

Debates over organising Ram Katha by Dharendra Shashtri of Bageshwar Dham continued on Tuesday.

After Congress leader Pramod Krishnan's objection to holding such an event under the hospitality of MPCC president Kamal Nath, former MP of RJD Shivanand Tiwari, too, objected to it. According to Tiwari, Mahagathbandhan has been formed, but those who talk about Hindu Rashtira are being welcomed. Tiwari urged the Congress high command to call Nath and make the party's stand clear. On the other hand, Leader of Opposition Govind Singh said, "It is not good to use religion in politics." According to sources, some leaders of the Congress complained to the party high command about organising a religious event by Shashtri. The Congress leaders are opposed to Shashtri's working for RSS agenda and his support to Hindu Rashtira.

Minister tells transporters 7 check-posts, 6 checking points to be closed

Gujarat model to be adopted by scrapping transport check posts in Madhya Pradesh

Transport minister Govind Singh Rajput as-

sured transporters that seven temporary check-posts and six temporary checking points will be closed with immediate effect in Madhya Pradesh. The vehicle checking system on Gujarat model will be adopted in Madhya Pradesh by scrapping the check-posts by December 14, 2023, said the minister while talking to the transporters who held a Mahapanchayat here on

Tuesday demanding closing of 58 check posts in Madhya Pradesh. The minister had convened a meeting for talks with the transporters on Tuesday. Seven temporary check posts at Prampur, Bilao, Nahar, Samarsa, Karhal, Raniganj, Tilgela and Rajna, while six more checking points will be scrapped immediately, said the minister. Nineteen integrated check posts out of 40 are

being operated under agreement with MP Road Development Corporation Limited (MPRDC) and MP Border Check Post Development Corporation. The minister said that for adopting the Gujarat model, additional manpower with facilities like breath analyzers, speed radar guns, portable weighing machines, body worn cameras, POS machines will be required.

No manual challans

The minister said that the manual challan system will be abolished in a phased manner. Challan will be made through POS machines and the amount will be deposited online in days to come. No challan will be made for unloaded vehicles. Challan will be made only against those vehicles which are operating violating rules and regulations, the minister added. Currently manual checking is being conducted in Maharashtra, Karnataka, West Bengal, Chhattisgarh, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Bihar and Kerala.

One more CLC round granted for admission to UG, PG courses

Haven't got admission to colleges as yet? Don't be afraid. Accepting the demand of students, department of higher education has permitted one more round of college-level counselling for admission to undergraduate and postgraduate courses. This is the fifth CLC round for admission to UG and PG colleges.

The students can register for this round of counselling for UG courses from August 12 to 16 and for PG courses from August 13 to 17. The document verification can be done for UG courses from August 13 to 19 and for PG courses from August 14 to 21. The allotments will be done for UG courses on August 22 and for PG courses on August 23. Students allotted seats will have to pay

fee for confirmation of admission till August 26 for UG and August 27 for PG courses. The DHE has also granted one more round of counselling for BEd and MEd courses. The registration for these courses will be started on Wednesday and continue till August 12. The seat allotment list will be out on August 25. The last date for submitting fee will be August 31.

NTPC REL secures bid for 80 MW floating solar project at Omkareshwar Reservoir

NTPC Renewable Energy Limited is the successful bidder for 80 MW floating solar capacity at Omkareshwar reservoir, Khandwa, Madhya Pradesh. The bidding was conducted on Tuesday by Rewa Ultra Mega Solar Limited (RUMSL), the JV Company of Solar Energy Corporation of India (SECI) and MP Urja Vikas Nigam Ltd. The discovered tariff is 3.80/kWh and the energy generated from the project shall be used by MP state DISCOMs. With completion of this project, the floating solar capacity of NTPC shall be 342 MW. The biggest floating solar project in the country is of 100 MW capacity located at NTPC Ramagundam in Telangana. As on date, NTPC Group has 3.3 GW RE operational capacities,

20 GW RE capacities in pipeline, including 4 GW Energy Storage System and country's first Green Hydrogen based PNG blending project. NTPC is committed to achieve 60 GW of Renewable Energy capacities by 2032 and be a major player in Green Hydrogen Technology and Energy Storage domain.
