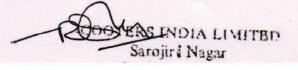

INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REVIEW OF INTERIM FINANCIAL RESULTS

TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS SCOOTERS INDIA LIMITED

1. We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited financial results of Scooters India Limited ('the Company') for the quarter and Half Year ended 30th September, 2019 ("the statement") attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing obligation and Disclosure Requirement) Regulation 2015 read with SEBI Circular No. CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated 5th July, 2016. This statement is the responsibility of the Company's Management and has been approved by the Board of Directors. Our responsibility is to issue a report on these financial statements based on our review.

We conducted our review in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagement (SRE) 2410, Review of Interim Financial Results Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement. A review is limited primarily to inquiries of company personnel and analytical procedures applied to financial data and thus provide less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Based on our review conducted as above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying statement of unaudited financial results prepared in accordance with applicable accounting standards and other recognized accounting practices and policies has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.

2. Emphasis of Matter

- a) Attention is invited to the point No. 4 of the foot note to the unaudited financial results, where the company has not provided for the arrears to the employees who were on the pay roll of the company as on 01-04-2013, as the approval is awaited from GOI and pending outcome of the proceeding before the Central Government Industrial Tribunal, Lucknow.
- b) We have reviewed the financial results and other information for the quarter and half year ended 30th September, 2019 which is solely based on the financial information compiled by the management and that the Financial Statements give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error subject to **Annexure-1** enclosed with this report.

Audit Observations for Review and Half Yearly Audit of Scooters India Limited FY 2019-20

TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS SCOOTERS INDIA LIMITED

1. Observation related to Sales

i) During the course of audit, it has been observed by us that the invoice for the sale of 3-Wheeler Vehicles has been raised by the company but the vehicles has not been despatched on the date of invoice. The detail of invoices is mentioned below:

As per Ind AS 18 (Revenue Recognition), Revenue from the sale of goods shall be recognized when the entity has transferred to the buyer the significant risks and rewards of ownership of the good. But, in above case Invoice No.: 19-20/ 3W00723 the risks and rewards of the ownership had not been transferred to the buyer till 04th October 2019 thus the amount of this invoice cannot be shown in the head of sales.

2. Other Observations

- i) Research & Development (60927): During the course of Audit, it has been observed by us that the expenditure amounting to ₹7,92,454.77 incurred on Research & Development is related to development of Electronic Vehicle (EV), which is not launched by the company so far. In context to the same, we are of the opinion that the same should not appear in the head of R&D and be treated as Deferred Revenue Expenditure.
- ii) During the course of Audit, it has been observed by us that the provision in respect of certain service expenses are not made on the reasonable basis rather the same are being made on adhoc basis. The detail of the same is given below:

Policy Related to Free-Service Coupon has not been provided to us during the course of our Audit and it
has been informed by the management that there exists a practice of providing ₹ 100.00 per vehicles to
the dealers as Free Service Charges for 30 years.

- 2) During the course of audit, following discrepancies related to Pre-Sale Services has been observed by us:
- i) As per the policy provided to us for Pre-Sales Services (including Pre-Dispatch Inspection) an amount of ₹ 100.00 for each vehicle is required to be given to the dealer as an inspection charges on the basis of Inspection Report submitted by the dealer. In pursuance to the same, we observed that the policy formed for pre-sales service has not been followed by Scooters India office and provision has been made without considering the policy norms.
- ii) While verifying the Credit Note issued for Pre-Sale Services, it has been observed that the dates on the "Settlement of PDI Claims" has been manually altered. The detail of the same is given below:
 - Credit Note issued to M/s Vishal Agencies on 30th September for ₹ 7,300.00
 - Credit Note issued to M/s Arvind Motors on 30th September for ₹ 3,100.00
 - Credit Note issued to M/s Shree Balaji Motors on 30th September for ₹ 7,100.00
- iii)During the course of audit, it was observed that following material relating to Financial Year 2018-19 are still under inspection:

It is advised to the management to either complete the inspection of such items or return them in case the material is defective.

- iv)During the course of Audit, it was found that Stock material is measured/valued by the SIL at cost. However, as per Para 9 of IND AS 2- Inventories, "Inventories shall be measured at the lower of cost and net realizable value", but the company is not following the above IND AS by valuing stock at cost.
 - i) The Closing Inventory of Other Stock includes:
- a. Petrol costing ₹ 14,182.78 since 2009-10. As per the discussion with the management team, we were informed that such oil is not usable as it got mixed with other oils and there is a possibility that the amount of such oil could be Nil and hence is not saleable. We were also informed that management 99% of the petrol is evaporated. Hence, provision for 99% is made by management.

As per the provisions of Ind AS-2, Valuation of Inventories, Inventory or Consumable should be valued at its cost or Net Realisable value, whichever is lower. We are of the opinion that if the value of the oil is Nil, then it should be valued at Nil rate and hence should be written off from the books. Further, we have physically verified the petrol but no such stock was found by us.

b. The valuation of Uniform was done at cost of ₹ 1,07,915.45 since 2015-16. However, while doing physical verification of the Uniform kept in the Store Room, we came to the conclusion that value which is shown in the books of accounts i.e. ₹ 1,07,915.45 is not appropriate as the condition of the uniforms was not up to mark. Further, the condition of stationery stock amounting to ₹6,02,765.38 in books of the company was inappropriate as we were unable to verify the same physically.

Further, as per the discussion with the management in the last Quarter (Q1), the provision @ 90% has been made in respect of the uniform lying in the closing stock but we are of the opinion that the same should be written off as not in the usable condition.

- v) Current liabilities include Provision for Payment of Bonus to employees amounting to ₹ 6,97,531.95 for the FY 2017-18, 2016-17 & 2014-15 in line with Payment of Bonus Act. However, during the course of audit, we observed that the said bonus is not paid till date and therefore contravenes with the provision of Section 19 of the said Act.
- vi) During the course of audit, it was observed that no Budget is being prepared by the company to predict its probable income, expenses and expected target. This may result in excess expenditure as compared to the incomes of the company.

It is advised to the company to prepare budget on annual basis and compare it with the actual performance periodically to achieve the desired outcome.

vii)It has been observed that Penalty was imposed by BSE ₹ 47,51,860.00 till 30.10.2019 for which no provision has been made.
