War chops da into 25 pieces for assets

In a grisly crime reported from Shahdara district, a 22-year-old youth murdered his father after a heated argument over property dispute.

Police said Aman's brother and mother were away in Manali when this fratricide was noticed by his neighbours who saw Aman carrying a blood-soaked bag.

Shahdara. According to Mehna Yadav, the Deputy Commissioner of Police (DCP), Shahdara district, a neighbour spotted Aman and his friend from his balcony keeping the two blood-stained bags and packets in a car.

"Suspecting something strange, the neighbour called Police Control Room (PCR) at number 2077 am following which a police van reached the spot and arrested the accused Aman along with his friend while they were keeping the bags containing chopped body parts in the car," said the DCP.

The incident occurred between 300 metres from the spot and arrested the accused Aman along with his friend while they were keeping the bags containing chopped body parts in the car," said the DCP.

"During initial investigation it was revealed that Aman was pressurising his father to register a property located in the area of Noida. There have been arguments between father and son on several times," said an official tasked with investigation.

"It was also revealed that Aman's elder brother and mother were away in Manali for the past few days, the father and son were alone at home and on May 20 night, they had a heated argument and in a fit of rage Aman first assaulted his father and then stabbed him multiple times," said the police official.

"After killing his father, Aman and his brother went into his home and planned to dispose-off the body and evade police arrest. He called a friend to help him in removing the body from his home. They both chopped the body into 25 pieces and hid them into two bags and some black-coloured polythene packets bought from a chicken shop," said the police official.

A case of murder has been registered and the accused Aman and his brother have been arrested and further investigation is being carried out to recover the weapon of offence, the police official added.

IN GURUGRAM Traffic advisory issued for counting day

The Gurugram police on Wednesday issued an advisory asking citizens to avoid routes going towards Government college for girls located on Mehrauli-Gurugram Road, Sector 14, on May 23.

As part of security arrangements on the counting day, the 2.5-kilometre stretch between MDI Chowk and Mahavir Chowk will be blocked for all kinds of traffic movement between 7 am to 11 pm on Thursday.

Traffic police officials said that all roads leading to the venue will be blocked. The vote counting for the election is to be held at the Government College for Girls in Sector 14 on Thursday. On this occasion, a large number of staff and officials will be discharging their duties. So there will be a high-security level on the roads leading to the venue.

Also, routes connecting to the Mehrauli-Gurugram road will be manned by securing

personnel and the movement of the general public will remain suspended on these routes, starting 7 am till late in the evening," Himanshu Garg, DCP (traffic), said. Roads outside the college will be sanitised and will be under high security during the counting process. Seven police

checkpoints will be kept towards Mehrauli-Gurugram Road and an arterial route between the college and 32nd milestone. Also, around 700 police personnel will be deployed to ensure the security of the area, Garg said. He added that traffic on these routes will resume as

soon as counting is concluded. The police officials further said that the counting staff, counting agents and candidates, who will come to the counting centre from the direction of MDI Chowk will have to park their vehicles at the ITI premises adjoining the girls' college.

On the other hand, those coming from the direction of Mahavir Chowk will have to park their vehicles at Vasant Sadan. Parking at the Government College for Girls will not be allowed.

'Doctor' who stole verification of ration card holders duty of Govt: FPS licensees to HC

Greater Noida Police on Wednesday arrested a man on charges of lifting vehicles of people after befriending them. The accused Kapil Verma, who claims to be a doctor, was among two people arrested in Greater Noida for vehicle thefts.

According to a senior police official, the accused Kapil Verma has been involved in at least three such cases where he has tricked people into lending their cars to him for some time and within days, the vehicles went missing.

Verma is a native of Baghpat district, while his associate Rahul Sharma has been arrested on Wednesday in Greater Noida. The senior police official said that two of the stolen cars, a Maruti Swift and a Maruti Brezza, were seized from them along with a fake number plate on one of them.

Explaining the modus operandi of the accused, West District Superintendent of Police, Greater Noida, said that the accused used to get into touch with people and befriended them. Eventually he would ask for their vehicle for a day or for some time on some or the other pretext. He would then get a duplicate key made for the car and also get a GPS tracker installed in it, said the SP.

Verma's accomplice Rahul Sharma provided him with the duplicate keys and tracked the car using the GPS and would lift it at an opportune time after Verma returned the vehicle to its owner, said the SP. "He claims to be a doctor, a visiting doctor at a private hospital in Greater Noida, but we are verifying his claims. His degree and work profile, whether they are true. At least three such cases have come to light and the matter is being investigated further," said the SP.

A case has been registered against the two at Kasma Police station under Indian Penal Code sections 379 (theft), 420 (cheating) and 489A (receiving stolen property), and related offences, said a police official.

Verification of ration card holders duty of Govt: FPS licensees to HC

Fair price shop (FPS) licensees told the Delhi High Court on Wednesday that they should not be tasked with verification of the addresses of ration card holders in the duty of AAP Government officials.

Justice Vibhu Bakru issued notice to the Delhi Government and asked it to indicate on affidavit who was responsible for carrying out the survey and verification according to the National Food Security Act and in how much time.

The court also asked the government to examine if it was possible to remunerate the FPS licensees for the onerous task of survey and verification of ration card holders.

It, however, asked the FPS licensees to continue with the verification work to the best of their abilities and listed the matter for further hearing on October 1.

The court was hearing a plea by the Delhi Sarkari Ration Dealers' Union (DSRDUs) which has sought quashing of two notifications of 2009 and 2018 which state that FPS licensees have to carry out the survey and verification of ration cards.

The organisation, representing FPS licensees, has said in its petition that ration cards issued after enacting of the Food Security Act have been linked with Aadhaar and they have also been verified food inspectors as well as officials of other Delhi government departments.

It has claimed that officials of other departments who assisted in the verification work were paid Rs 20 per application form, but FPS licensees have been directed to carry out the task without any remuneration. DSRDUs in its plea has said the 2009 notification was never implemented and by the notification of 2018, the government was seeking to revive the earlier directive to FPS licensees.

The petition, filed through advocate Vidhwan Shrivastava, has said that majority of FPS licensees are women, senior citizens and physically challenged persons who shall find it difficult to carry out the survey and verification exercise.

It also contended that none of the officials of the Delhi Special Articles (Regulation of Distribution) Order, Public Distribution System (control) order and the Food Security Act can carry out FPS licensees to carry out door-to-door survey and verification of ration card holders in their notified area.

Identified 1 of 3 gunmen who killed youth with million followers on TikTok: Police

After 28-year-old Mohit Mor, social media celebrity was shot dead by three unidentified gunmen in Delhi's Najafgarh area, the Delhi Police on Thursday claimed to have identified one of the three assailants.

According to Anto Alphonse, the Deputy Commissioner of Police (DCP), Dwarka district, the gunman were captured on CCTV camera, leaving the scene of the crime.

Two of the attackers' faces were concealed with helmets, while one of them could clearly be seen in the CCTV footage. One of the assailants is identified and police have initiated a manhunt to nab the accused," said the DCP.

"Police team is investigating the death will all angles, including personal enmity, but there is no sign of any criminal case. Auto-driver, accomplices stab, rob 34-year-old victim sent to AIIMS, out of danger

In yet another incident of rogue rickshaw drivers stabling passengers with the intention to rob, a man who had hired an auto-rickshaw from Kalindi Kunj area on Tuesday night was stabbed by the driver and his accomplices. The man identified as Abar Alam, a resident of Chhalera village of Noida was stabbed after he resisted an attempt by the three

people to rob him. According to a senior police official, the incident took place on the intervening night of Monday and Tuesday. Alam was stabbed at about 10 pm on Shaheen Bagh. Two more passengers were already sitting in the auto. When the auto reached the Kalindi Kunj red light, its driver turned the auto towards Kalindi Kunj Ghat and stopped the vehicle at a secluded spot," said the senior police official.

"One of the accused - identified as Vikram Singh (33) started thrashing Alam while another accused Trilok Chand (27) took out a knife and pointed it towards the victim's stomach. The duo threatened Alam and asked him to hand over his wallet and mobile. When Alam refused, Chand stabbed him with the knife on his left hand, a senior police officer said.

To escape, the victim pleaded with the auto driver, identified as Alam (34) for help but the auto driver in turn threatened the victim and caught hold of both his hands. Alam was threatened by auto-driver that he would be killed if he refused to hand over his valuables to them," said the senior police official.

"The accused robbed the victim of his money and mobile phone. Meanwhile, on hearing a siren, the victim raised an alarm following which the patrolling team passing by Kalindi Kunj reached the spot. They found an auto-rickshaw parked at an isolated spot," said the senior police official.

"On spotting the police party, the auto driver tried to escape. A case ensued but the auto driver lost balance and the vehicle crashed on the road near Kalindi Kunj Ghat. The auto driver also sustained injuries. The injured auto driver and the victim were separately taken to AIIMS trauma centre and are stated to be out of danger," said the senior police official.

"The other accused tried to run away towards the Yamuna bank but they were chased and overpowered by the police team. A case has been registered based on the statement of the victim," said the senior police official.

"During investigation it was also revealed that the trio were carrying a mobile phone. AM had robbed a mobile phone and ₹900 from a person near a flyover in Sarita Vihar as well," said the senior police official.

SDMC claims 100% waste segregation at household level

As part of its ambitious plan to segregate waste at source, the South Delhi Municipal Corporation (SDMC) on Wednesday claimed to have achieved 100 per cent waste segregation at household level in Janak Puri South.

A senior SDMC official said that there are 10000 houses in 29 colonies under the ward where the waste is being holistically segregated as per the SWM Rules 2016.

"A quantity of 30000 wet waste is being processed daily and 10.5 tonnes of wet waste has been segregated at source on 23rd April and 10th May, he said, adding that the record of 100 per cent segregation was achieved on 11th May 2019.

"The civic body involved 29 Resident Welfare Associations that have been exhorted and guiding the residents in the segregation and processing of wet waste at their places. The residents have developed habit to segregate waste at source and our localities most benefited," he said. This effort that another ward under west zone will be declared model ward in the month of June. With this, the Corporation has saved transportation cost Rs 8000 per day as the segregated waste are being processed at ward level and converted into manure, he said. Earlier, the waste was being dumped to landfill sites which cost the SDMC Rs 29 lakh annually, which will now be saved, he added.

The civic body had also instructed all household, restaurants and all waste generators including bulk generators to take note of this and start segregation at source. All garbage generators will have to pay notified user charges and have to ensure management of MSW finding which notified penalty will be charged," he added.

To facilitate and guide the garbage generators in the process of segregation and management of solid waste at source, SDMC of Municipal Solid Waste Management (MSW) - 2016, SDMC Commissioner Dr Puneet Kumar Goel had instructed all the zonal authorities concerned to initiate a new campaign.

Goel had said that the compliance of the rules is essential to reduce burden on sanitary landfill site and make Delhi green and our localities most benefited, he said. Earlier, the SDMC had announced to make all its wards to adhere to the norms of solid waste management rules in a period of one year. It has also started the process of turning three wards R K Puram, Andrews Ganj and Janakpuri South as model wards within a period of six months. It may be noted that NGT in its order dated January 3, 2019 had directed the body to turn the three wards as model wards for implementation of the SWM Rules 2016 within six months. SR

Married woman given lift, 2 men gangrape her in Maidan Garhi

A 26-year-old married woman has been allegedly gang raped by two men at an isolated spot in South Delhi's Maidan Garhi area on Sunday.

According to the woman, she had gone to Swami Satsang ashram at Fatehpur Beri when the incident occurred. The woman, a native of Alwar in Rajasthan, had come to Delhi three days back and was staying at a relative's house in Rani Bagh. The victim has an eight-year-old daughter and is at present living separately from her husband.

A senior police official said that the woman was standing on the Chattarpur main road, waiting for an auto-rickshaw when a white car stopped and she asked the two occupants of the car to drop her home. However, the men took her into a house and took her to an isolated spot in Maidan Garhi area where they took turns to rape," said the senior police official.

सभी दल करें जनादेश का सम्मान: पासवान

नई दिल्ली, (वार्ता)। लोक जनशक्ति पार्टी के अध्यक्ष एवं केन्द्रीय उपभोक्ता मामले, खाद्य एवं सार्वजनिक वितरण मंत्री राम विलास पासवान ने बुधवार को कहा कि पक्ष और विपक्ष को जनादेश का सम्मान करना चाहिए और चुनाव परिणामों को लेकर खून-खराबे जैसी बात नहीं करनी चाहिए।

उल्लेखनीय है कि राष्ट्रीय लोक समता पार्टी (रालोसपा) के अध्यक्ष उपेन्द्र कुशावाहा ने कहा है कि ईवीएम के जरिए चुनाव को प्रभावित करने की साजिश हुई तो खून-खराबा होगा। लोजपा नेता ने कहा कि चुनाव आयोग संवैधानिक संस्था है और जो लोग ईवीएम का विरोध कर रहे हैं, वे संविधान पर सवाल उठा रहे हैं। ऐसे लोग लोकतंत्र को बूझ कब्जा करने तथा धन-बल और बाहुबल के युग में ले जाना चाहते हैं। विपक्ष एक ओर संविधान बचाने की बात करता है, दूसरी ओर संवैधानिक संस्थाओं पर हमला करता है। श्री पासवान ने कहा कि ईवीएम से चुनाव को लेकर चार बार उच्चतम न्यायालय में मामला दाखिल किया गया और उन पर न्यायालय ने अपना निर्णय दे दिया, इसके बावजूद चुनाव को लेकर सवाल उठाया जाना उचित नहीं लगता। उन्होंने कहा कि पिछले दिनों मध्य प्रदेश, राजस्थान और छत्तीसगढ़ में राजग की पराजय हो गयी थी लेकिन इसके घटक दलों ने कोई सवाल नहीं उठाया था।
