- We are actively scouting for opportunities in Maharastra i.e. Mumbai, Pune etc among other locaitons




- Largest city in central India and is also known as "Orange City"
- Second capital of Maharashtra & the regional headquarters for Vidarbha Region
- 14th largest city in India by population and according to an Oxford's Economics report, Nagpur is projected to be the fifth fastest growing city in the world from 2019 to 2035 with an average growth of 8.41%.
- Proposed as one of the Smart Cities in Maharashtra and in the latest rankings of 100 developing smart cities given by the Union Ministry of Urban Development, Nagpur stood first in Maharashtra state and second in India.
- Located at the center of the country and is one of the most important hubs of the IT industry in the country. As per the KPMG NASSCOM survey, Nagpur is one of the top four tier II cities that have a huge potential for information technology and IT-enabled services.
- Nagpur is an important city for the Indian armed forces too. The maintenance Command of the Indian Air Force has its current headquarters at Nagpur.
- Nagpur holds a strategic position in international aviation routes. Its unique location at the crossing of the air route between Europe and South-East Asia as well as between South Africa and North-East Asia makes it a logical and ideal location for a passenger and cargo hub.
- The Hingna industrial estate has major manufacturing units of Mahindra & Mahindra, Bajaj Auto, Candico, Dinshaw's, Haldiram's, Vicco and Baidnath.
- The Butibori industrial area (30KM from Nagpur) is the largest in all of Asia in terms of area.
- The proposed Mumbai-Nagpur Highway is another awaited infrastructure project which will be a game changer for investments made in Nagpur.
- Zero Mile of India is located at Nagpur and incidentally Kingsway Hospital is located at the Zero Mile crossroads.

Nagpur Population over the years




- Nagpur is very well connected to all major cities around it


KINGSWAY HOSPITALS
