Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 110 and all other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 (the Act) read with the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (the Rules), including any statutory amendment(s), modification(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof for the time being in force, that the Resolution appended below is proposed to be passed as a Special Resolution by way of Postal Ballot including electronic voting (e-voting). The Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102 of the Act, pertaining to the appended Special Resolution setting out the material facts concerning the item and the reasons thereof is annexed hereto along with a Postal Ballot Form for your consideration.

The Board of Directors of the Company (the Board) in accordance with Rule 22(5) of the Rules has appointed Mr. Himanshu S. Kamdar (Membership No. FCS 5171), Practicing Company Secretary, Partner of M/s. Rathi & Associates, Mumbai, as the scrutinizer for conducting the Postal Ballot process in a fair and transparent manner.

In compliance with Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 and provisions of sections 108 and 110 of the Act read with the Rules framed thereunder, the Company is pleased to provide e-voting facility as an alternate, to all its Members, to enable them to cast their votes electronically instead of dispatching the physical Postal Ballot Form by post. The Company has engaged the services of Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL) to provide e-voting facility to its Members. It may be noted that e-voting is optional. In case a Member has voted through e-voting facility, he/she is not required to send the physical Postal Ballot Form. EXPLANATORY STATEMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 102(1) OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2013

CHANGE IN THE NAME OF THE COMPANY FROM "JYOTHY LABORATORIES LIMITED" TO "JYOTHY LABS LIMITED"

As the members are aware, the Company is commonly referred to as "Jyothy Labs". The Board of Directors of the Company are of the view that the name "Jyothy Labs" would resonate more with the Members because of the high recall value it carries and therefore, would be advantageous for the Company to use the word "Jyothy Labs" as compared to "Jyothy Laboratories". Further, in order to showcase Company's new ideology, the Company introduced its new Logo in the name of "Jyothy Labs". Accordingly, in view of the changed Logo it was also considered appropriate to change the name of the Company and bring it in-line with the newly introduced Logo. Hence, the Directors by way of Circular Resolution on May 14, 2019 have decided to change name of the Company from "Jyothy Laboratories Limited" to "Jyothy Labs Limited".

Consequent upon change of name of the Company, the name "Jyothy Laboratories Limited" as appearing in the Name Clause of the Memorandum of Association of the Company and wherever appearing in the Articles of Association of the Company and other documents and places would have to be substituted with the new name i.e. "**Jyothy Labs Limited**".

Further, the Company on May 21, 2019 has also received approval letter from the Central Registration Centre, Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India, stating that there is no objection in the availability of the proposed changed name i.e. "Jyothy Labs Limited".

Pursuant to the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and rules made thereunder, for effecting the change in name of the Company and consequential alteration in the Memorandum and the Articles of Association of the Company, it is necessary to obtain approval of the shareholders by way of passing a Special Resolution. Therefore, the Board recommends the resolution as set out in the Notice dated May 22, 2019 for approval of shareholders as Special Resolution. However, the said change in the name of the Company will be effective post receipt of approval from the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Stock Exchanges and/or other regulatory authority(ies) and upon receipt of fresh Certificate of Incorporation in the new name of the Company i.e. "Jyothy Labs Limited".

It is proposed to authorise the Board of Directors or Key Managerial Personnel(s) of the Company to complete all the regulatory formalities as prescribed by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI), Stock Exchanges and/or any other regulatory or statutory authority(ies) in connection with the change in name of the Company.

- 13. There will be only one Postal Ballot Form for every folio irrespective of the number of Joint Members. A Member need not use all his/her votes nor does he/she need to cast his/her votes in the same way.
- 14. Voting rights shall be reckoned on the paid up value of the shares registered in the name of the Member on the relevant date i.e. Friday, May 17, 2019.
- 15. The Scrutinizer's decision on the validity of the Postal Ballot Form shall be final.
- 16. Only a Member entitled to vote is entitled to fill in the Postal Ballot Form and send it to the Scrutinizer and any recipient of the Notice who has no voting right should treat the Notice as an intimation only.
- 17. The Results of the Postal Ballot will be declared on or before Friday, June 28, 2019 as specified in the Notice.
