Subject: Consolidated Scrutinizer's Report on remote e-voting pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 (Act) read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 and amendments thereto and voting through Ballot Papers at the AGM venue pursuant to Section 109 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 21 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 at the 50th Annual General Meeting of M/s. Binny Limited held on Thursday, September 26th, 2019 at 11:00 A.M at Kasturi Srinivasan Hall (Mini Hall), The Music Academy, New No.168, T.T.K Road, Royapettah, Chennai-600014.

I, V Suresh, Practising Company Secretary, have been appointed by the Board of Directors of M/s. Binny Limited (the Company) as a Scrutinizer for the purpose of scrutinizing the remote e-voting/voting through Ballot Papers at the Annual General Meeting (AGM) venue and ascertaining the requisite majority, on the resolutions contained in the notice to the 50th Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the members of the Company, held on Thursday, September 26, 2019 at 11.00 A.M. at Kasturi Srinivasan Hall (Mini Hall), The Music Academy, New No.168, T.T.K Road, Royapettah, Chennai-600014.

The Notice dated 10th August 2019 along with statement setting out material facts under Section 102 of the Act were sent to the Shareholders in respect of the below mentioned resolutions passed at the Annual General Meeting of the Company.

The Public Advertisement with respect to dispatch of notices and conducting of voting through electronic means was published in an English newspaper "Business Standard" all editions and in a vernacular newspaper "Makkal Kural" edition on 29th August, 2019.



The management of the Company is responsible to ensure the compliance with the requirements of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Rules relating to voting through electronic means on the resolutions contained in the Notice of 50th Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the members of the Company. My responsibility as a Scrutinizer for the e-voting process is restricted to presenting a Scrutinizer's Report on the votes cast "in favour" or "against" or "abstained", in respect of the resolutions stated below, based on the reports generated from the e-voting system provided by M/s. Central Depository Services (India) Limited, the authorized agency to provide e-voting facilities, engaged by the Company.

The Company had also provided for voting through Ballot Papers at the AGM venue at the 50th Annual General Meeting, to the shareholders who had not cast their vote earlier through remote e-voting facility.

The members of the Company as on the "cut-off" date i.e. September 18, 2019 were entitled to vote on the resolutions (items no. 1 to 5 as set out in the notice of the 50th AGM of the Company.)

Further to the above, I submit my report as under:-

Remote E-voting:

- The e-voting period remained open from Monday, September 23, 2019 (9.00 a.m. IST) to Wednesday, September 25, 2019 (5.00 p.m. IST) (both days inclusive).
- The votes cast under remote e-voting facility were thereafter unblocked in presence of two witnesses who were not in employment of the Company.
- The Corporate members who had participated in the remote e-voting had provided scanned copy of the resolution passed at their Board of Directors Meeting for authorization to exercise their votes through e-voting.

Voting through Ballot Papers at the AGM venue:

- The Company had provided the facility for voting through Ballot Papers at the AGM and members, who have not cast their vote by remote e-voting, were allowed to exercise their right to vote at the meeting.
- ii. The polling papers in Form MGT-12 as per Section 109(5) of the Act and rule 21(1)(c) of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 were distributed to the shareholders present. The shareholders cast their votes in the ballot box kept at convenient places in the venue.
- iii. The locked ballot box was subsequently opened before me, in presence of two witnesses who were not in employment of the Company and Ballot papers were diligently scrutinized. The Ballot papers were reconciled with the records maintained by the Company and the authorizations/proxies lodged with the Company.



Thereafter, the results containing, inter alia, list of Equity Shareholders, who voted "for", "against" or "abstained", in respect of the each of the resolutions that were put to vote, were generated from the e-voting website of M/s. Central Depository Services (India) Limited, (i.e.) www.evotingindia.com and voting through Ballot Papers at the AGM venue, was prepared.
