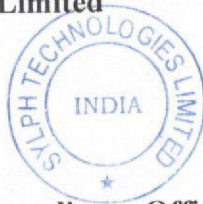

Bid to rejuvenate Kanh river Now, MPPCB and IMC dry downstream Narwar nullah

This was to ensure no industrial waste is mixed in the Kanh Polluted water is being diverted to STP by a 100-metre line

Board (MPPCB) and Indore Municipal Corporation (IMC) have diverted the polluted water released by the industries of sector F of the Sanwer Road industrial area to the sewage treatment plant (STP).

The polluted water has been diverted with the help of a 100-metre-long pipeline which was connected to the STP of 245 MLD to get the water treated. IMC has also constructed a wall to stop



the overflow of the nullah and dried its downstream to ensure that no water mixes with the Kanh. Sanjay Jain, scientist and in-charge of the Sanwer Road industrial area of the MPPCB said they had written to IMC to lay the

'SEWAGE WATER MIXING WITH KANH' During inspection of the area, it was found that the water released from the industries into the Narwar nullah was diverted to the CETP by creating a wall on it. Sewage water of various colonies, such as Ekta Nagar, Avantika Nagar, Pushpa Nagar, Nandbag Colony, Rakhi Nagar, Gareeb Nawaz Nagar and Chhota Bangarda was also being released into the same nullah and the overflowing water was mixing with the Kanh'

pipeline for diverting the water to the STP by connecting it with the STP line. "After connecting the line, no industrial waste water is being mixed with the river and the downstream is also being dried out," he added. IMC and the MPPCB is monitoring the water quality of the Kanh and work on rejuvenation of the river is going on as it will also be an important part of the next Swachhata Survekshan.

Blind murder solved by the Mhow Police

On January 18, complainant Gopal came to the police station and reported that his younger brother, Anoop Solanki, was lying in the drain in front of his house and blood was oozing out of his head and mouth. He was immediately shifted to the Central India Hospital, where the doctors declared Anoop dead. During investigations, CCTV footage of the surroundings were monitored. The statements of witnesses were recorded and the post mortem examination report of the deceased was observed. Two persons were seen with Anoop on the footage with a stick in their hand. After all the evidences were collected, it was found that the deceased was murdered by Rishabh, alias Monty, and Piyush. A case was registered against both the accused at the Mhow police station. Informers were made to trace the accused and their hiding places were raided by the police in the night. On the night of February 22, two persons were found hiding in a tunnel under the Kishanganj bridge. They were arrested. Upon interrogation, it was revealed that, on February 17, around 11.30 pm, they had an altercation with Anoop, alias Rana, for asking for matches to smoke cigarettes and the fight started.
