# Rahul will have to launch Congress Dhundho Yatra after 4 June: Shah

PoK belongs to India, and we will take it back from Pakistan: Amit Shah

Union Home Minister Amit Shah took a dig at the Congress party and party MP Rahul Gandhi saying that after the ongoing general elections, Wayanad MP has to launch a "Congress Dhundho Yatra" to "find" the party.



Addressing a public rally in Haryana's Hisar on Monday, Shah said, "On one side, there is PM Narendra Modi who gives a befitting reply to Pakistan. On the other side, Congress leaders say that don't ask for Pakistan-occupied Kashmir as it has an atom bomb. PoK belongs to India, and we will take it back from Pakistan."

"Rahul Gandhi started the Lok Sabha elections 2024 with the 'Bharat Jodo Yatra'. After June 4, Rahul Gandhi will have to launch 'Congress Dhundho Yatra'. Congress will not be visible even with binoculars. In the 2024 elections, the lotus of Modiji's development is going to bloom everywhere from Sirsa to Sonapat, Panchkula to Palwal," he added.

Shah further alleged that Congress is trying to win the election based on lies as they are realising their defeat. "Seeing defeat in front of them, the Congress Party wants to win based on lies.

They are saying that if Modiji gets 400 seats then he will abolish reservation. I want to tell you that as long as BJP has even one MP, we will not allow reservation to be abolished. Congress has given reservations to Muslims. If you get us 400 seats, BJP will also do the work of ending this unconstitutional reservation," Amit Shah said.

Earlier in the day, while

addressing an election rally in Haryana's Karnal, Shah slammed the opposition alliance, the INDIA bloc alleging that the latter neither has leaders nor policies.

Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Monday questioned who will be the Prime Minister of the INDIA bloc if they come to power in the 2024 Lok Sabha polls.

"Who will be their Prime Minister if they cross the majority mark? Will it be Sharad Pawar, Mamata Banerjee, Stalin, Arvind Kejriwal, Uddhav Thackeray? Will it be Rahul Gandhi? These people neither have leaders nor policies," Shah said while campaigning at Haryana's Karnal on Monday.

Hitting out at the Congress for allegedly suggesting that the bloc might have Prime Ministers in turns over five years, Shah said that it is not about running a shop but governing a country of 130 crore people.

"When a reporter asked him who will be their Prime Minister he said they will have Prime Minister in turns for one year over a term of five years. Rahul Baba does not understand that this is not some shop but a country of 130 crore people," Shah said.

Pointing out that the Prime Minister has a "special attachment" towards Haryana, Shah said, "The people of Haryana have a right to PM Modi. I have been working with PM Modi for so many years. When he was in Gujarat, he used to worry about Haryana and now when he is here (in Delhi), he keeps talking about Haryana. Modi ji has a special attachment and love for Haryana."

Voting on all 10 seats in Haryana will be held on May 25. The counting of votes will be done on June 4. In 2019, the BJP swept the state by winning all 10 seats.

# AAP & Congress have joined hands to loot people, not for public welfare: Yogi

Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath said on Monday that as the slogans 'Fir Ek Baar Modi Sarkar' and 'Abki Baar, 400 Paar' resonate across the country, the grand-old party Congress is reduced to a position where it cannot even contest 400 seats.

He claimed that not only the country, but the world at large is assured of the NDA's resounding victory on June 4.

Addressing a public meeting in Maloya in support of BJP candidate Sanjay Tandon, the Chief Minister said, "While the dominance of mafia is visible in Punjab, we have eradicated such goons in UP, and today, there is no one left to even mourn at their graves."

He alleged that it seems that AAP and Congress have joined hands to loot the public. Adityanath offered prayers at Maa Bhagwati Chandi Devi and Mata Mansa Devi.

Describing Chandigarh as a remarkable blend of the devotion and power of the gurus, CM Adityanath stated, "The people are chanting 'Jo Ram Ko Laye Hai, Hum Unko Layenge', because those who revere Ram, belong to the nation, and those who do

not, are of no use". He further criticised Congress intellectuals who claimed the Ram Temple should not have been built in India, suggesting sarcastically that Congress should have built it in Italy instead.

The CM also mentioned that leaders of the INDI Alliance used to threaten the court, warning that a decision on the Ram Temple would lead to riots and bloodshed. He responded by asserting that there would be no more riots in UP, and anyone inciting violence would face strict action. "I said that the day a decision is made on the Ram Temple, that will be the most peaceful day in the universe. There are no more riots in UP. Now, namaz is not held on

the streets, and loudspeakers have been removed from mosques. Everyone now wants to live in peace," the Chief Minister added.

Taking a dig at Congress leader Rahul Gandhi, Adityanath remarked that "he is the first to flee from the country whenever the country faces a crisis". The CM also accused the Congress of bringing terrorism, Naxalism, and corruption to India. "During the COVID-19 pandemic, Rahul was nowhere to be seen—neither in Chandigarh nor in UP. At that time, only BJP workers were serving the public. One crore migrants came to UP from various states, and we arranged 14,000 buses to take them to their homes", Adityanath stated.

# 'Agniveers' are defenders of nation's sovereignty: CDS Chauhan

Elaborating on the evolving nature of warfare, the CDS highlighted the complexity and unpredictability of future conflicts to include Cyber Warfare, Artificial Intelligence and Asymmetric Threats which are now an integral part of the battlefield. He also spoke about technology integration and continuous learning and mentioned that in addition to staying abreast with the latest advancements, there is also a need to showcase innovative approaches towards combat.

He exhorted the 'Agniveers' to focus on training for becoming technologically proficient soldiers, ready to meet the challenges of future warfare.

# 'Vote for democracy, not dictatorship'

Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge on Monday called upon the people to vote for democracy and not for "dictatorship", as the voting for the fifth phase of elections gets underway.

The Congress chief also exuded confidence that there will be a new beginning on 4th June, the day results of the general elections would be declared.

In a post on X, "My dear countrymen to protect the democracy and Constitution, you must vote. Before pressing the button on EVM, remember to vote for love and brotherhood, not for hatred."

"We have to vote against unemployment and inflation, not to make a few capitalists richer. We have to vote for the protection of our fundamental rights, not for those who snatch our rights. Vote for justice, not for injustice and

oppression. Vote for democracy, not for dictatorship," he said. Welcoming the first-time voters, the Congress chief said, "A very welcome to my young friends who are voting for the first time. This is their historical responsibility."

Kharge, who is also the Leader of Opposition in Rajya Sabha further said, "The trends of the four phases say that the departure of hukumshah (emperor) is certain. Today is the fifth step towards farewell. A new beginning from 4th June." Former Congress president Rahul Gandhi also took to X and wrote, "Today is the fifth phase of voting. In the first four phases itself, it has become clear that the people stood up to protect the Constitution and democracy and are defeat-

ing the BJP. This country, fed up with the politics of hatred, is now voting on its own issues."

"The people themselves are fighting this election along with INDIA, and a storm of change is blowing across the country. I am appealing to the entire country including Amethi and Rae Bareilly - come out and vote in large numbers for the prosperity of your families, for your own rights, for the progress of India. Voting for the fifth phase of Lok Sabha elections in 49 constituencies spread across eight States and Union Territories (UTs) started at 7 am on Monday and will conclude at 6 pm.

# Lok Sabha elections: SC dismisses a bedridden woman's plea to cast vote through postal ballot

The Supreme Court on Monday dismissed a plea by a 78-year-old bedridden woman seeking direction to the Election Commission of India to permit her to cast her vote through postal ballot in the ongoing Lok Sabha Election. The ailing woman had approached the top court against May 6, Chhattisgarh High Court's order declining

her plea. A vacation bench of Justice Bela M. Trivedi and Justice Pankaj Mishra rejected the plea by the bedridden woman from Chhattisgarh, who had approached the top court against the rejection of her request for the issuance of a postal ballot paper by the Returning Officer on May 1, and the subsequent dismissal of her plea by the High Court. In the first instance the ailing woman - a voter in the

Bilaspur constituency that went to poll on May 7 - had approached the Chhattisgarh High Court to seek direction for the issuance of postal ballot given her age and the ailment, so that she can cast her vote. However, the High Court on April 29, allowed her to make a representation before the Returning Officer concerned and directed the authority to consider her request strictly in accordance with the law.

# Chhattisgarh CM accuses Priyanka Gandhi of misrepresentation, urges caution

Chhattisgarh Chief Minister Vishnu Deo Sai has refuted claims made by Congress leader Priyanka Gandhi regarding the distribution of rice through the state's Public Distribution System (PDS).

The Chief Minister's response comes following statements made by Priyanka Gandhi during an interview where she alleged discrepancies in the quantity of rice provided to beneficiaries under the present BJP government compared to previous years of Congress rule.

Taking to his official social media platform, CM Sai expressed, "The Congress party has unfortunately been

afflicted with a chronic ailment of deceitfulness for over seven decades, and its repercussions cannot be easily eradicated. Priyanka Ji, amidst your endeavours to propagate

falsehoods, I implore you to shed light on the colossal rice scandal amounting to 5000 crores orchestrated by the previous Congress government in Chhattisgarh."

Continuing his discourse, the Chief Minister condemned the Congress for disseminating misinformation, citing a claim made by Congress' Rahul Gandhi regarding the establishment of food parks across every district in Chhattisgarh during the previous state assembly elections. He reiterated that such falsehoods were rejected by the electorate, leading to a significant electoral setback for the Congress.

In a stern admonition, CM Sai advised against hasty statements, urging thorough

research prior to public discourse. He reiterated the commitment of his government towards transparent and equitable distribution of essential commodities, reaffirming the provision of additional rice allocations to eligible households under the PDS framework.

According to Chhattisgarh administration, supplementary rice allocations are provided to cardholders based on specific criteria: 10 kilograms for single-member households, 20 kilograms for households with two members, 35 kilograms for households with three to five members, and 7 kilograms per member for households exceeding five members. These allocations are distributed free of cost.

# Accident claims 19 lives in Chhattisgarh; CM Deo, Shah express grief

Nineteen people died and eight others sustained severe injuries in a road accident in Bahapani village in Kabirdham district of Chhattisgarh on Monday.

The accident took place when a hurtling pickup truck veered off the road and plummeted into a 20-foot deep ravine. The accident resulted in the loss of 19 lives, with over 8 individuals sustaining severe injuries, four of whom are currently undergoing treatment at a specialized facility. Early reports suggest that the villagers boarded the vehicle from Semahara village and were en route to their destination around 2 PM.

Kawardha SP Abhishek Pallav informed the media that the death toll includes 18 women, three of whom were young girls along with a moth-

er and her daughter. Emergency services promptly transported the injured to nearby medical facilities. However, the impact of the accident was so severe that 13 individuals tragically lost their lives at the scene.

Contradicting official accounts, local residents have raised serious concerns, asserting that the pickup truck was overloaded with between 30 to

35 passengers, casting doubts on the veracity of claims regarding brake failure. The villagers are questioning the sincerity of the Regional Transport Office (RTO) and local police.

Expressing condolences, Union Home Minister Amit Shah, in a message shared on the social media platform X, conveyed his sympathies and wished for the speedy recovery of those injured. Chhattisgarh

Deputy Chief Minister Arun Sao stated, "The bus accident in Kawardha is deeply regrettable. My thoughts are with the families who have lost their loved ones in this tragedy. The local authorities are extending every possible assistance to the injured, and we fervently hope for their swift recovery."

Chief Minister Vishnu Deo Sai expressed his profound sorrow, stating, "The news of the accident near Bahapani village in the Kukkur Thana area of Kabir Dham district, resulting in the tragic loss of 18 lives and injuries to 4, is deeply distressing. The district administration has been directed to ensure the provision of the best possible medical care to the injured. My heartfelt condolences go out to the families of the departed souls. We pray for the speedy recovery of the injured."

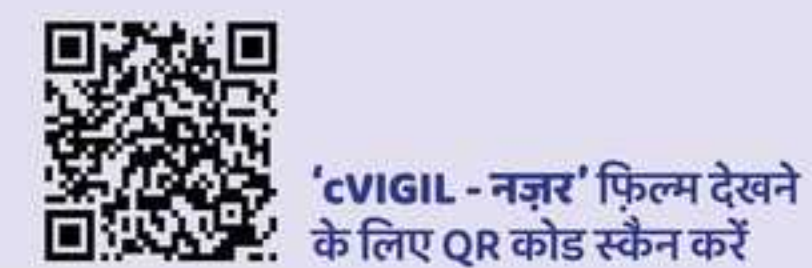

अमन शहीद भगत सिंह इंटर कॉलेज में पढ़ाई करने के लिए बाइक से जा रहा था। वह आठवीं कक्षा का छात्र था। अमन बाइक चला रहा था और नाबालिग साथी आकाश, सुभाष और अर्पित पीछे बैठे थे। छपरीली गांव के पास पीछे से आई सफेद रंग की कार ने बाइक में टक्कर मार दी। हादसे में अमन की मौत हो गई। हादसे की जानकारी मिलने पर अमन के परिजनों और उसके कॉलेज के छात्रों ने सड़क पर जाम लगा दिया और आरोपी चालक के खिलाफ सख्त कार्रवाई करने की मांग करने लगे। उनका आरोप था कि कार चालक ने जानबूझकर छात्रों को कुचला, लेकिन सीसीटीवी फुटेज में अमन समेत बाइक सवार छात्र चालक का पीछा करते दिखे। बाइक सवार के हाथ में क्रिकेट बैट भी था। एसीपी शेखा गोयल ने बताया कि आरोपी चालक टावर में हवा भरने की बात कहकर कार लेकर घर से निकला था। रास्ते में कार बाइक से टक्कर मारी। नाबालिग सवारों का हमला होते देख आरोपी कार समेत भागने लगा, इसी दौरान हादसा हो गया।
