MoF Sees G-sec Yields on Downhill Trek

Yields on short-term instruments like T-bills also likely to ease; inflation expected to moderate

New Delhi: The finance ministry expects the yield on government securities which dropped below the 7% mark for the 10-year paper in intraday trade on Thursday for the first time in about 13 months — to moderate further over the course of the fiscal year, says official sources.

The yields on short-term instruments like treasury bills, too, will likely ease, he added. The yield moves in the opposite direction of a bond's price.

"In addition to the global factors (including the rise in oil prices and a possible pause in rates by the US Federal Reserve), the feeling among bond market participants that government securities won't blow up in market till FY24 is finally in. Domestic inflows, too, is likely to moderate," said the official.

This will ease pressure on private borrowing at a time when capital spending by the private sector is expected to further traction, he added.

New Delhi: Commerce and industry minister Piyush Goyal on Thursday said he wants to see a greater presence of American aircraft and aerospace major Boeing in India as it has recently received a large order of planes from the Tata group of companies.

At the annual general meeting of the American Chamber of Commerce in India (ACCIM) in New Delhi, he also said that the US-China bilateral trade is increasing at a healthy rate and both sides are looking to expand the trade four-fold.



"Touch \$50 billion target by 2030". In February, Air India announced its plan to buy 470 planes from Airbus and Boeing, one of the largest orders in aviation history, without any subsidies.

"Boeing has expressed a very large order from the Tata and I am given to understand that similar interest exists now in the pipeline."

At 7.5%, the 10-year benchmark G-secs yield is now down by over 100 basis points since hitting a nearly four-month high on February 27. The cut-off point in day-to-day trading is around 7.35%, which is down from 7.49% to 7.7% on Wednesday, but it has remained around these levels since mid-April.

The Centre has flagged its gross market borrowing limit at ₹1.3 lakh crore, which analysts had expected before the budget announcement. It has proposed to borrow 37.5% of the full-year target in the first half of the fiscal year.

SOVEREIGN GREEN BONDS

The finance ministry expects greater foreign interest for the sovereign green bonds in FY24, which could also be the "greenest", or most sustainable, year in the country's history. The size of the PV green bond issue will be announced along with the government's borrowing plan for the second half of this fiscal year. Karnataka polls important; BJP will get a full majority'

Allegations that the BJP promotes only Hindi are politically motivated, says Home Minister; the party, he says, will win an absolute majority in Karnataka on the back of the work done by the Narendra Modi government at the Centre and the State government; while alleging that the Congress practises appeasement politics, the Minister defends scrapping of reservation for Muslims in Karnataka

It's the BJP's effort to make sure that party workers are present in every booth, and it's working for that in Tamil Nadu and Kerala as well; the party may not be far ahead as it is in Karnataka and Telangana in these States, but efforts are on. Home Minister Amit Shah says about the BJP's southern push. In Kerala, the BJP is trying to reach out to the Christian community because the BJP reaches out to every Indian, and Christians in Kerala are part of that effort, he says. With the BJP's reach increasing, the party will be able to crack down on corruption in the southern States, especially in Telangana, he adds. Edited excerpts:

Karnataka is the only southern State where the BJP is in power. How important are these polls for you in terms of a footprint in the South and what are the party's prospects?

This is an important election for the BJP, and we will form the government with

a full majority in Karnataka. This will be on the back of the work done by both Prime Minister Modi's government and the State government. The basis for my optimism is the support of the beneficiaries of the 4.1 lakh houses constructed under the Pradhān Mantri Awas Yojana, of 43 lakh tap water connections under Jal Jeevan Mission, four crore people benefiting under the Anna Yojana, 54 lakh houses being given over ₹15 crore under the Pradhān Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi. As for its effect on the rest of the South, I believe the BJP is well placed in Telangana as well. I also firmly believe that along with BJP's reach increasing in the South, the party will be able to crack down on corruption in the southern States, especially in Telangana.

You mention Karnataka and Telangana as places where the BJP will win polls, what about the efforts being made in Tamil Nadu and Kerala?

It's our effort to make sure that BJP workers are present in every booth, and we are working for that in Tamil Nadu and Kerala as well; maybe we are not as far ahead as we are in Karnataka and Telangana in these States, but efforts are on.

In Kerala, the BJP is trying to reach out to the Christian community, particularly...

BJP reaches out to every Indian, and Christians in Kerala are also part of that effort.

Was the removal of Mr. Yediyurappa in 2021 a misstep, looking at the chain of events like rebellion by Jagadish Shettar and Laxman Savadi?

Yediyurappa himself took the decision that he should give way to another Chief Minister. In our party, we have an age criterion, and he had said that whenever the party wants to operationalise that criteria, it could. He stood down eight months after that conversation. It's a part of a natural generational change. As for Jagadish Shettar, he was not a rebellion, but a rebellion by Laxman Savadi, so it's not a rebellion. Let me declare right now that Shettar's margin of loss will be more than his margin of victory ever was, since the people of Hubballi have voted for the Lotus, not an individual "moh" [attachment] to getting tickets. There was a clear logic of the party behind denial of tickets to both of them. In the case of Jagadish Shettar, he had made it clear that he would not serve as Minister under Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai, so we felt why should he continue as a mere MLA then, would that have been acceptable to

There is talk that the reservation policy cleared by the Bommai government is not being defended adequately in court.

The case is over scrapping of reservation for Muslims, and as far as that is concerned,

free foodgrains which help fight malnutrition, all these are not freebies, these are benefits to the people to improve long-term quality of life and health. What is a freebie? If you promise to send ₹3,000 per month to the account of every woman, such kind of cash transfer is a revadi.

But under PM Kisan Samman Nidhi, the government is distributing income support.

It is not a freebie. For a long time, there was a trend that various political parties would promise loan write-offs to small and marginal farmers, basically those with less than a hectare of land. We got a study done on how much loan was required for such a farmer to raise two crops on his holding, that figure for the average land holding of 2.5 acres, for seeds, irrigation and fertilizer plus pesticide would come to ₹6,000. So we decided that this amount should be given to farmers as a measure to make him/her self-sufficient, *atmanirbhar*, so that he doesn't have to take loans for the short-term. This is not revadi. Government has, under a scientific approach, devised this programme to save small farmers from indebtedness and the banking system from

dealing with fiscal indiscipline.

What was the basis for offering a National Register of Citizens for Karnataka?

The NRC is not the correct word here. What's been promised is a kind of survey, every State government has the right to conduct a social survey. The right to maintain the National Register of Citizens is only with the Centre.

Kannada, Tamil or Malayalam... including in engineering and medicine studies. This is also a part of the New Education Policy, and the Congress in Karnataka is opposing this, thereby also opposing studies in Kannada.

The Congress has spoken of banning the Bajrang Dal in its manifesto. As Home Minister, what is your reaction?

This is part of the Congress' appeasement policy. For many years, out of fear of disunity, they had locked up the Ram Temple, and now they are taking of banning the Bajrang Dal. The Popular Front of India (PFI) ban and banning Bajrang Dal cannot be compared. The PFI was banned for anti-national and terror-related activities, after gathering primary stage evidence of the same. And the board that is constituted to consider reviewing the Unlawful Activities Prevention Act (UAPA), under a High Court judge, consulted 12 State governments and declared that the ban on PFI was justified. The Congress cannot talk of lifting the ban on PFI as they are drawing a false equivalence between the PFI and the Bajrang Dal, as part of its appeasement policy.

What do you think of the allegation that the BJP is a largely Hindi party and pushing that agenda.

This issue of Hindi imposition is a political allegation often made against the BJP whereas the party is working to strengthen all local languages.

Most of the Central services exams now can be taken in local languages. Earlier, someone who has studied, say, in Kannada medium would have found it difficult to take many of these exams. We made it so that most of these exams can be taken in several languages. NEET can be taken in several Indian languages, so also exams for recruitment of constables, with SSC as the basic qualification. So our work is to encourage local languages,

Families flee homes, take shelter in relief camps after violence in Manipur

Many families in Manipur's capital Imphal and nearby districts have been forced to take refuge in shelter camps, after mounting violence in the State over the issue of Scheduled Tribe status for the Meitei community.

Golan Naulak, 36, said he fled his home in eastern Imphal with four family members on Thursday. "It is a complete failure of the state machinery. Mobs are roaming around freely. We have lost our home, my car, documents and all our belongings. We are currently taking shelter at the compound of Manipur Rifles in the city," he told *The Hindu* over phone.

Clashes between the Scheduled Tribe communities opposing ST status for the Meitei people and those belonging to the Meitei community have left panic and confusion in their wake. Some families, whose homes were set on fire, escaped to neighbours' homes or found refuge in the compound of Manipur University. Others moved to the relief camps that were set up in the city.

Several residents who spoke to *The Hindu* over the phone said there were attacks by mobs comprising Meitei people.

While it was announced by the government that mobile Internet would not be available in a few districts as a precaution, broadband facilities were also disrupted in some places. "Around 2 p.m. on Thursday, we lost our home Wi-Fi. In about an hour, a mob of around 300 people stormed our neighbourhood and started vandalising homes, Mr. Naulak said.

A 25-year-old schoolteacher, who belongs to a Scheduled Tribe, said, "We have been told that more than a dozen churches have been vandalised in and around Imphal. We also saw a hospital run by the Kuki Christian Church being burnt down."

When she spoke on the phone, she was trying to make it to a relief camp with 11 other family members, including two in-

fants, a disabled aunt and elderly grandparents.

Even as Adivasi residents in and around Imphal and Churachandpur say their homes and villages were being raided by mobs of Meitei people, members of the Meitei Tribe Union have blamed "illegal migrants from Burma" for fuelling the violence.

Manhar Moirangthem Kongpal, adviser to the Meitei Tribe Union, claimed that the entire Meitei community in areas like Churachandpur and Moreh was facing violence at the hands of "such miscreants". He insisted that the violence was purportedly started by those associated with Kuki associations. There were reports that some Meitei homes had also been attacked and these families too were fleeing to safety.

Meitei issue: HAC chief tones down opposition

Dinganglung Gangmei, chairperson of the Hills Area Committee of the Manipur Assembly, on Thursday dialled down the opposition to the demand for Scheduled Tribe status for the Meitei community in the State, after the violent clashes between groups against the demand for inclusion and those in favour.

This comes a day after

the Manipur High Court issued a notice to Mr. Gangmei and the president of the All Tribal Students' Union, Manipur, on a contempt petition filed by members of the Meitei community for passing resolutions opposing a court order.

A Bench of the Acting Chief Justice M.V. Murudialam, also issued notice to the State's Director General of Police to ensure presence on May 8 in court.

BJP's politics of hate has made fissures in Manipur: Congress

Manipur's rapidly deteriorating law and order situation. "The Prime Minister must focus on restoring peace and normalcy. I urge the people of Manipur to stay calm," Mr. Gandhi said.

Congress general secretary (communication) Jairam Ramesh said the people's mandate in Manipur had been betrayed and all sections of the State were unhappy.

For the full year of FY23, the company reported a net profit of ₹1,701.1 crore, marginally down compared to ₹1,739.2 crore on account of operating

high inflation and downgrading by consumers. Having said that silver lining for the year has been the performance of the new age channels and some green shoots which are emerging in the rural markets, towards the end of the quarter, indicating early signs of revival in demand," he added.

The company said it partially mitigated high inflation by price increases to the tune of 6 per cent during the year.

"Consumer promotions offered were softer to the impact of price hikes in consumption, which resulted in flatish

volumes for both the fourth quarter and the year," it added.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE

"The food and beverage portfolio, which is in the range of roughly ₹1,700 crore, should grow to ₹4,000-5,000 crore in next 5-6 years," Malhotra said. During the year, the company's F&B business grew 30 per cent.

The company added that its oral care business penetration has now increased to 50.8 per cent and that it has become the Number 2 player in the segment with a 15.8 per cent market share.
