# Over Rs 421 cr recovered in Maha ahead of LS polls: ECI

Mumbai, April 17 (UND) : According to the Election Commission, various departments of the central and state governments have confiscated a total of Rs 421.41 crore. The amounts accounts for cash, liquor, drugs, freebies, precious metals, and other items, according to State Chief Election Officer and Principal Secretary S Chokkalingam.

## Govt agrees to extend financial benefits to widow of Major Anuj Sood

Mumbai, April 17 (UND) : In a significant development, the Maharashtra government on Wednesday told the Bombay high court that it is ready to grant financial benefits to Aakriti Singh-Sood, widow of late Major Anuj Sood, who was martyred in May 2020 in Jammu and Kashmir. The State stated this during the hearing of a petition filed by Anuj Sood's widow, seeking benefits of ex-servicemen under two government resolutions of 2019 and 2020. Major Sood lost his life on May 20, 2020, while rescuing civilian hostages from terrorist hideouts in Jammu and Kashmir, and was awarded the Shaurya Chakra posthumously.

The state government rejected her application seeking benefits to kin of martyrs, saying that only those who were born in Maharashtra or have lived in the state continuously for 15 years were eligible for monetary benefit and allowance.

During the hearing today, State Advocate General Birendra Saraf told a bench of Justices Gishik Kulkarni and Firdosh Poonwalla that the government resolution was issued on April 15, under which it has decided to grant financial benefits to Aakriti Sood and Chandrakant Sood, Anuj Sood's father.

According to the GR, the state has considered the case of the Aakriti Sood as a "special case" and in the "light of the observations made by the high court" [on earlier occasions], it has decided to grant financial benefits to her and her father-in-law, Chandrakant Sood.

he stated that as per the pre-poll action implemented in the state by the commission implementing the model code of conduct, Bharati teams, the Static Survey Team (SST), the Video Survey Team (VST), and the Video Inspection Team (VIV), have been appointed at the state and district levels.

The teams have seized Rs 39.10 crore in cash,

33,56,323 litres of liquor worth Rs 27.18 crore; 11,42,498 grams of Amla worth Rs 212.82 crore between March 1 and April 11.

Contraband substances like drugs, besides 290.61kg of precious metals worth Rs 63.82 crore; 51,272 freebies worth Rs 47 lakh, and other items worth Rs 78.02 crore have been seized with a total value of Rs 421.41 crore, said Chokkalingam.

Kolhapur, April 17 (UND) : In a shocking incident, a mother was arrested along with two others for selling her one-year-old daughter to a couple in Goa for one lakh rupees.

According to Laxmipuri police, the woman was identified as Punam Deeping Dhenge has been living with her mother at Pattankodoli in Hatkanangale tehsil of this district for the past one year after being separated from her husband Deepil Vilas Dhenge. It was the husband who informed the police after he came to know that his daughter was put for adoption without informing him. Deepil rushed to the police and registered a complaint against wife Punam. During investigation, Punam confessed that she sold their daughter to a couple in Goa for a lakh with the help of her friend and a mediator.

# Maharashtra tops GST collection, cross 3L crore mark: Official

Mumbai, April 17 (UND) : Maharashtra's GST collection in the financial year 2023-24 has crossed the Rs 3 lakh crore mark for the first time since the implementation of the Goods and Service Tax system.

According to the Deputy Commissioner of Taxation, Mumbai, in a statement on Wednesday, the state's Goods and Services Tax (SGST) collection this year reached Rs 3.2 lakh crore. Compared to last year, it has recorded a sharp increase of 18 per cent. The SGST collection in the state of Maharashtra (Rs. 20.2 lakh crore) in the gross goods and services tax collection of the country has been recorded at 16 per cent, and compared to last year (15 per cent), there is an increase of about 1 per cent. Also, the state's growth rate in GST collection (18 per cent) is higher than the national average (12 per cent).

Looking at the net revenue of the state, it received highest revenue of Rs 1,41,700 crore from GST, of which Rs 93,400 crore was from state SGST and Rs 48,300 crore from the state's share of integrated tax. The state has recorded an increase of 20.2 per cent in state goods and services tax revenue compared to the previous year, and the state's share in the integrated tax has also seen an increase of 24 per cent (excluding ad hoc in the previous year). The

revenue from VAT on petrol and liquor products is Rs 53,200 crore.

The overall revenue growth rate of GST, value-added tax, and business tax in the state is 11 per cent, which is higher than the growth rate of the estimated gross state product (10 per cent) in the financial year 2023-24. The overall revenue collection is more than the budgeted estimate of Rs 1.95 lakh crore for 2023-24.

# ICG apprehends Indian boat with unauthorised cash off Maharashtra coast

New Delhi, April 17 (UND) : The Indian Coast Guard (ICG) has apprehended an Indian fishing boat, carrying unauthorised cash, reported to be involved in the smuggling of diesel, 83 nm northwest off Mumbai.

Based on a tip off from Customs, the ICG Regional Headquarters (West) launched an operation, involving a sustained search during challenging night conditions amidst considerable fishing and merchant traffic covering an area of 200 square miles including offshore development areas off the Maharashtra coast, an official statement said on Wednesday.

In a coordinated operation comprising a search by two ICG Fast Patrol Vessels and one Interceptor Boat, the suspected boat was located and boarded on the night of April 15.

Preliminary investigation revealed that the boat, with five crew, departed from Mandwa port on April 14, to effect rendezvous with suspected Indian Offshore Supply Vessels (OSV) with an intent to smuggle diesel. It was found that the boat was operating with modified holds to store fuel up to 20,000 litres and operating with false/multiple identities. Correlation with available data on the

suspected boat indicated multiple discrepancies in vessel registration. The operation also revealed a carriage of Rs 11.46 lakh which was meant to be given to some Indian Offshore Supply operating from offshore areas in return of smuggled diesel.

The vessel was brought to the Mumbai anchorage in the early hours of today.

A joint investigation with Directorate of Revenue Intelligence, Customs, and State Police is being carried out to trace the linkages and further legal actions by respective agencies.

# Complaint lodged about fake letter of BJP's candidature in Palghar

Mumbai, April 17 (UND) : The BJP in Maharashtra has lodged a complaint with city police against circulating a fake letter issued by the BJP central office on social media, giving nomination to Shiv Sena's Prakash Krishna Nikam for the Palghar Lok Sabha constituency in an attempt to create a rift between two allies of Maharashtra.

Briefing about this in a press conference here on Wednesday, BJP state president (code of conduct and Law department) Advocate Akhilesh Choubey claimed that this letter which was circulated on fake letterhead of BJP,

is a conspiracy to create a rift between the two parties. He said that after learning about the fake letterhead of BJP nominating Prakash Nikam of Shiv Sena for the Palghar constituency being circulated on social media, he lodged a complaint at the Marine Drive police station against unidentified persons. This is an attempt to create a rift between BJP and Shiv Sena by spreading a deliberately fake letter, while the Maharashtra's candidate for the Palghar seat has yet to be decided. The complaint has been filed against unknown persons under sections 420, 467, 468 and 417 of Indian Penal Code, added Choubey.

# EC to issue notification for 4th phase of LS elections on April 18

Mumbai, April 17 (UND) : The Election Commission will issue a notification for fourth phase of the Lok Sabha elections in Maharashtra on Thursday.

Candidates can start filling the nomination forms from April 18 to 25. Scrutiny of nomination forms will be done on April 26 and the last date for withdrawal of nominations will be on April 29.

The 11 constituencies that will go to polls in fourth phase on May 13 include Aurangabad, Beed, Jalna in Maharashtra region, Pune, Shirdi, Maval, Ahmednagar, Shirdi in Western Maharashtra region, Nandurbar, Raner and Jalgaon in North Maharashtra region.
