Depriving states of GST compensation attempt to undermine federalism: Mamata to PM

West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee on Wednesday wrote to Prime Minister Narendra Modi that depriving states of GST compensation is an "attempt to undermine federalism" and urged him not to belie the trust between the states and the Centre on the issue.

"On behalf of Bengal and other states, I sincerely urge you not to belie the trust between the States and the Centre on matters of GST which has been hailed globally as the finest example of cooperative federalism," Banerjee said.

Banerjee asked Modi not to allow "an insufferable blow to the federalist polity of the nation" by depriving the states of the GST compensation. "I am deeply anguished by the Goods and Services Tax (GST) imbroglio which tantamounts to a betrayal of the trust and moral responsibility of the Government of India towards the states, violating the very premise of federalism.

Stop printing calendars, diaries, go digital: Govt depts told

NEW DELHI: Amid ever-increasing cases of coronavirus in the country and the economy going through an unprecedented recession, the Centre has come up with an interesting directive as it has told all ministries and departments to halt the printing of calendars, diaries, schedulers and other printed materials and asked them to publish them online in digital format.

Dave to CJ: A 'game plan' for not letting him speak

Dave said after the court's proceedings, the Attorney General was requested to speak and he heard him fully including his disappointment on the punishment for Prashant Bhushan. "When he ended, I thought that I will be requested to speak, instead Jadhav (president Supreme Court Advocate on Record Association) was requested knowing full well I was present. For some unknown reasons, I was being disconnected again and again but I persisted and re-joined each time", said the letter.

Supreme Court Bar Association (SCBA) president Dushyant Dave has written to Chief Justice S.A. Bobde expressing disappointment for not being asked to speak at the farewell of Justice Arun Mishra. Dave in the letter said: "I must confess, the Supreme Court has come to such levels where the judges are afraid of the Bar. Please do remember, Judges come and go but we the Bar remain constant. We are the real strength of this great Institution because we are permanent."

Dave said after the Chief Justice spoke, which he saw and heard, Justice Mishra was invited to speak. "At that stage realising the game plan, I exited in the larger interests of the dignity of the Bar and myself", added Dave. The senior lawyer in the letter said: "The entire episode leaves much to be desired on the part of this great Institution. The whole attempt was to prevent me from addressing on behalf of the SCBA and its EC, after having invited and invitation having been accepted. This was clearly an affront to the Bar and to me personally."

Nearly 1,000 kg of gutka seized from a house

CHENNAI: Nearly 1000 kg of gutka, a banned tobacco product, was seized here on Wednesday, police said. Following a tip-off, a police team raided a house and found 970 kg of gutka stored there, the police said.

ITBP team scales Himalayan peak in first expedition during Covid-19

An ITBP expedition team has scaled an over-22,000-foot tall mountain peak in Himachal Pradesh, the first such mission undertaken during the COVID-19 pandemic, officials said on Wednesday. The 16-member team of the mountain warfare-trained border-guarding force climbed the Leo Pargil peak on August 31 and September 1 in two batches, an ITBP spokesman said. The 22,222-foot tall peak is located in the remote Lahaul and Spiti district of Himachal Pradesh, close to the Tibet border. "Leo Pargil in the Himalayan ranges is considered one of the most tough and technical peaks in India to climb. "Mountaineers face problems of low oxygen, extreme

cold and high-altitude sickness during this expedition," the ITBP spokesperson said. The team, drawn from the ITBP sector headquarters in Shimla, was led by Deputy Commandant Kuldeep Singh and also had Head Constable Pradeep Negi, who climbed the peak for the second time. It was flagged off from Shimla on August 20 with the expedition being code-named "Yodha" or fighter.

Congress leader and former Union Finance Minister P Chidambaram on Wednesday slammed the Central government for not revealing the names of the donors of PM CARES FUND and questioned "Why are the trustees afraid" to do so. "The auditors of PM CARES FUND have confirmed that the Fund received Rs 3,076 crore in just 5 days between March 26 and 31, 2020," he said in a tweet.

CARES FUND exempt from this obligation? The donee is known. The trustees of the donee are known. Why are the trustees afraid to reveal the names of the donors?," the Congress leader said in another tweet. Prime Minister is the ex-officio Chairman of the PM CARES Fund and Minister of Defence, Minister of Home Affairs and Minister of Finance, Government of India are ex-officio Trustees of the Fund.

"But the names of these generous donors will not be revealed. Why? Every other NGO or Trust is obliged to reveal the names of donors contributing more than a threshold amount. Why is the PM

They said Jain has been arrested under sections of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA) and will be produced before a court here.

The agency has also found out about the regular modus operandi of "generations of fake invoices for bogus import and exports" of the accused in the case, with Jain allegedly being the key player.

I met his family today and offered them an assistance of Rs 1 crore. I hope that the family will get some help with this amount."
