India Gives ₹45 cr to Sri Lanka to Fund its Digital Identity Project

Colombo: India has handed over ₹45 crore in advance to Sri Lanka for its unique digital identity project, the most crucial step in the island nation's digitalisation programme. The funding was announced through the Indian grant assistance. Sri Lanka's President Ranil Wickremesinghe's office here said that the fund from India was given on Friday. During a meeting at the Presidential Secretariat, project stakeholders, including Presidential Senior Adviser on National Security and Chief Presidential Staff, Sagala Rathnayaka, State Minister of Technology Kanaka Herath, Indian High Commissioner, Govind Rajy and First Secretary of the Indian High Commission, Eldos Mawath and others engaged in extensive discussions on the project and the funding.

The project aims to collect biographic and biometric information, including facial, iris, and fingerprint data, which will be stored in a centralised system.

Sharif is looking towards a mandate allowing him to continue with the bailout program with the International Monetary Fund that he revived in late June on the backdrop of record inflation and interest rates.

Ukraine Starts New Diplomatic Push to Weaken Russia in Jeddah

Diplomats from 40 governments invited for talks in Saudi Arabia

Kyiv: Ukraine will make a renewed push this weekend at a gathering in Saudi Arabia to win support of dozens of countries that have remained on the sidelines of the war - the start of a broader campaign in the months ahead to build the diplomatic muscle to isolate and weaken Russia. Ukraine and Saudi Arabia invited diplomats from some 40 governments in the Middle East to Jeddah. Notable among them were China, India, Brazil, South Africa and some of the Arab Gulf nations, which have tried to maintain good relations with both Ukraine and Russia throughout the war, which began in February 2022. The Saudis invited governments from the Arab world to choose sides, framing the war as a contest between global powers that they want no part in, and even with the event fast approaching. It was unclear how many would attend.

Thai Ex-PM Thaksin Shinawatra Postpones Return from Self-exile

Bangkok: Thai former Prime Minister Thaksin Shinawatra said on Saturday that he is postponing his return from self-exile as Thailand struggles to overcome a political deadlock after the general election in May was won by opponents of military-backed parties. Thaksin, a former telecom tycoon who became prime minister in 2001 and ousted by the military in 2006, has vowed to return to Thailand's politics despite having lived in self-imposed exile since 2008 to avoid graft convictions which he said were politically motivated after his government was ousted in a 2006 coup.

Thaksin-backed Pheu Thai Party came second in the May election after the progressive Move Forward Party. The two election winning parties have been trying to form a government with six like-minded partners but have been blocked by the Senate, dominated by military appointees, and conservative opponents. Earlier this week, Pheu Thai took the lead in trying to form a government without Move Forward, whose own attempts to form a government met with relentless opposition from the pro-military conservatives alarmed by its reform agenda. The constitution, drafted during military rule, restricts a joint sitting of the elected Lower House and the appointed Senate to vote for a prime minister. Reuters

Do You Feel Relocation of African cheetah to India is a good idea?

Yes / or No / Neither. In India, cheetahs are both the same species. Now that India has addressed all the causes that led to the extinction of cheetah in India, has sufficient protected areas in the historical range of the cheetah, the economic stability political and scientific ability, reintroduction of lost species is the best way to rewrite the planet and restore ecosystems.

Do you feel a detailed scientific study was conducted before the relocation, as suggested by the Supreme Court?

Yes / or No / Neither. Causes for failure pointed out by critics have been proven wrong. Cheetahs will have difficulty in killing deer - (fact) In African cheetahs successfully hunted a variety of Indian prey (chital, blackbuck, mourning, nilgai, sambar, hare and chousing, leopards), cheetahs will be killed by leopards - there has not been a single death or injury caused by leopards to any of the free-ranging cheetahs, cheetahs will be killed by poachers, wildlife warden said. "If it happens, cheetahs will come into severe conflict with locals by killing livestock - cheetahs were observed to mostly only prey even when observed at national parks and only one cheetah was killed that was promptly committed. There has been no conflict with communities."

You were at the forefront of the pro-relocation movement and even accompanied the first batch of cheetahs from Africa to India. Why were you not made part of the government's Cheetah Task Force. Why do you feel the government is not doing enough? Only senior government officials can answer that question. I believe I did everything by the book that was required for a successful translocation and the establishment of cheetahs in India as was seen in the action plan.

Bangkok: Thai former Prime Minister Thaksin Shinawatra said on Saturday he was postponing his return from self-exile as Thailand struggles to overcome a political deadlock after the general election in May was won by opponents of military-backed parties.



Thaksin, a former telecom tycoon who became prime minister in 2001 and ousted by the military in 2006, has towered over Thailand's politics despite having lived in self-imposed exile since 2008 to avoid graft convictions which he said were politically motivated after his government were ousted in a 2006 coup.

On Saturday, Thaksin said in a post on X, the social media platform formerly known as Twitter, that he needed a medical check up and would delay his return, originally planned for Aug. 10, by "a couple of weeks". Thaksin-backed Pheu Thai Party came second in the May election after the progressive Move Forward Party.

The two election winning parties have been trying to form a government with six like-minded partners but have been blocked by the Senate, dominated by military appointees, and conservative opponents.

Earlier this week, Pheu Thai took the lead in trying to form a government without Move Forward, whose own attempts to form a government met with relentless opposition from the pro-military conservatives alarmed by its reform agenda. The constitution, drafted during military rule, requires a joint sitting of the elected Lower House and the appointed Senate to vote for a prime minister. Reuters

Galande claimed that Kochhar threatened Dhoot "to ruin his life by asking his wife to declare loans as NPAs if Dhoot did not transfer the said flat to his family trust for Rs 11 lakh". Dhoot, as per the chargesheet citing the accountant, objected to this, saying that if the flat was transferred in such a way, it would cause trouble to Chanda Kochhar one day and that she would end up "sharing a room with Indrani Mukherjee (who is accused in the Shena Bora murder case)".

The South Mumbai flat and the loan of Rs 64 crore are two instances of bribery in CBI's case of corruption against the Kochhars and Dhoot.

The CBI also affixed the findings by the ministry of corporate affairs (MCA) whose probe found that the loan of Rs 64 crore, which was given by Videocon Industries to Supreme Energy and subsequently went to Deepak Kochhar's NuPower Renewables, was a case of a related-party transaction by Dhoot and that he did not get it ratified by the board or seek approval from the audit committee. Dhoot also failed to take previous permission from the central government on the loan as mandated under the Companies Act, it said.

Both the MCA and CBI have concluded that the Rs 64 crore loan was from a Rs 300 crore loan that a Videocon Group company had received from ICICI Bank.

Yes. All the causes for failure pointed out by critics have been proven wrong. Cheetahs will have difficulty in killing deer—(fact is) all African cheetahs successfully hunted a variety of Indian prey (chital, blackbuck, chausingha, nilgai, sambar hare and monitor lizards); cheetahs will

be killed by leopards — there has not been a single death or injury caused by leopards to any of the free-ranging cheetahs; cheetahs will be killed by poachers, village dogs — not happened; cheetahs will come into severe conflict with locals by killing livestock — cheetahs were observed to kill mostly wild prey even when outside of the national park and only one calf was killed that was promptly compensated. There has been no conflict with communities.

You were at the forefront of the project for almost a decade and even accompanied the first batch of cheetahs from Namibia. But you were not made part of the government's Cheetah Task Force. Why do you feel the government did that? Only senior government officials can answer that question. I believe I did everything by the book that was required for a successful translocation and the establishment of cheetahs in India as can be seen in the action plan.

"Chinese companies could particularly face the heat as after banning Chinese apps, the government wants to crack down on hardware firms who threaten India's security," the expert said.

Two key product categories accounted for most of these imports in FY23 at \$7.9 billion. The first included PCs, laptops and tablets, while the second comprised Wi-Fi dongles, smart card readers and Android TV.

Imports of such items may surge as companies build stock before the curbs take effect. The measure is expected to increase local production, but that may take time, experts said.

According to the India Cellular and Electronics Association (ICEA) lobby group, local production stood at \$3.4 billion in 2022. "We expect a surge in imports of these two categories in the next few months, even from passengers coming from abroad," said the official.
