COVID COUNT

633 NEW INFECTIONS, NO DEATHS

Gujarat Monday reported 633 fresh Covid-19 cases, raising its overall tally to 12,49,117, while no new death linked to the infection was registered in the state, the health department said. The cumulative count rose to 12,32,544. Ahmedabad reported 216 new cases, the highest in the state.

Sardar Sarovar dam 63.32 per cent full, water level rises to 126.89 m

THE WATER level in the Sardar Sarovar Dam in Narmada district reached 126.89 metres Monday evening, increasing nearly five metres since July 21, following heavy rainfall in the catchment and water release from Madhya Pradesh.

At present, the Sardar Sarovar dam has gross storage of 5,990.52 million cubic metres and is 63.32 per cent full.

Sardar Sarovar Narmada Nigam Limited (SSNNL) officials, however, said it was decided to balance the rising levels in the dam by generating hydropower through the 1,200-MW Riverbed Powerhouse (RBP) instead of opening the radial gates.

Sardar Sarovar, which stood at 121.71 metres on July 20, has been receiving an inflow of close to 1.8 lakh cusecs from upstream in Madhya Pradesh. However, according to SSNNL officials, the rainfall has now decreased in MP, thus necessitating that the filling up of the dam must be balanced by operating the six Francis-type reversible turbine generators of RBP with a capacity of 1,200 MW.

SSNNL chief engineer RG Kanungo told The Indian Express, "The operation of the dam is a dynamic process... The SSNNL follows the recommendation of the Sardar Sarovar Reservoir Regulation Committee of the Narmada Control Authority (NCA). As of now, they have asked us to continue operating the powerhouses to re-

lease water to ensure a safe filling up... We have two more months of the monsoon left... Therefore, we are positive about having the dam rise to its Full Reservoir Level (FRL of 138.68 metres)."

According to Kanungo, the powerhouses are generating over 20 Million Units of electricity per day since mid-July. "The power generated per day is worth Rs 5 crore... it is beneficial to all and ensures that the dam level is maintained. There is no decision on opening the radial gates right now because the rainfall in the catchment areas and upstream dams in MP are on a downward trend... It might change and we need to watch the levels and release from Indirasagar, said to be the mother dam of Sardar Sarovar."

The upstream dams in MP like Tawa, Hoshangabad, Indirasagar and Omkareshwar are receiving heavy rainfall since July 15. As per the hydrology data of NCA of 36 rain gauge stations upstream Sardar Sarovar, until July 22, Tawa received 1072.6 mm of rainfall while Pachmarhi recorded 1001.2 mm, Indirasagar and Omkareshwar recorded 410 mm and 444 mm, respectively, while Sardar Sarovar itself recorded 539 mm of rain. Molgi, the catchment area immediately preceding Sardar Sarovar, recorded the highest rainfall in the basin with 1090.9 mm until July 22.

The RBPH is releasing 43,084 cusecs of water while the canal head powerhouse (CHPH) is releasing 2,878 cusecs of water downstream.

Cong to conduct survey of flood-hit areas

AS HEAVY rains continue to batter parts of Gujarat, the Congress announced that it will conduct a survey of the affected population.

The party also accused the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) of having failed to make advance arrangements to provide relief to those affected by the floods. Instead, the BJP and local administrations were busy in party propaganda, said Congress's chief whip CJ Chavda.

"The state government has once again failed to make advance arrangements for the monsoon sea-

son which began from June 15 this year. Repairing of roads and adequate health and fooding facilities are aspects on which the state government should have worked in advance; however, they had other priorities. There is an existing manual to help flood-affected people in Gujarat; however, they exist only on paper and there are no policies for its implementation," said Chavda at a press conference held at Rajiv Gandhi Bhawan in Paldi of Ahmedabad.

He said Congress leaders have been visiting the flood-hit areas where there has been massive loss to people, including loss of homes. "The state government makes announcements but it doesn't con-

duct surveys to find an estimate of loss. It issues circulars but there is no implementation. The administration has been unable to reach flood-hit areas where maximum assistance is required; instead, it is busy in propaganda of the state government," Chavda said.

Announcing a survey of the flood-affected regions, Chavda said, "We have released four types of forms which can be filled by people both offline and online. The forms are for those whose vehicles and homes have been submerged due to rains, for small businesses that have been affected by rains, for dairy and animal husbandry owners and

farmers who have been most affected by the rains. We will demand compensation for the people affected by rains after the survey is completed."

The Congress also accused the state government of fudging data on vaccination of animals in the backdrop of the lumpy skin disease—a viral infection—that has spread among cattle and water buffaloes in 14 districts of the state. "We believe the state government is fudging data regarding lumpy infection among cattle like it did during Covid times. The vaccination of animals is only on paper," said Pal Ambalia, head of Gujarat Congress Kisan Cell.
