**Maruti Suzuki sales in August 2020**

**New Delhi, September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020:** Maruti Suzuki India Limited posted total sales of 124,624 units in August 2020. This is a growth of 15.3% over July 2020 and a 17.1% over August 2019.

Total sales include domestic sales of 115,325 units and 1,379 units for other OEMs. In addition, the Company exported 7,920 units in August 2020, a drop of 15.3% over August 2019.
