Notice is hereby given to the members of **ELECTROTHERM (INDIA) LIMITED** ("the Company") pursuant to Sections 108 and 110 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 (the "Act") read with Rules 20 and 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (the "Rules"), including any statutory modification(s), amendment(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof, for the time being in force read with General Circular No. 14/2020 dated 8th April, 2020, 17/2020 dated 13th April, 2020, 22/2020 dated 15th June 2020, 33/2020 dated 28th September 2020, 39/2020 dated 31st December 2020, 10/2021 dated 23rd June, 2021, 20/2021 dated 8th December 2021, 03/2022 dated 5th May, 2022, 11/2022 dated 28th December, 2022 and 09/2023 dated 25th September, 2023 and such other circulars issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (collectively the "MCA Circulars") and Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 and any other applicable laws and regulations, for seeking consent / approval of members of the Company by way of an Ordinary Resolutions through Postal Ballot only by voting through electronic means ("remote e-voting") for (1) Elevation and Re-designation of Mr. Suraj Bhandari (DIN: 07296523) from Whole-time Director to Managing Director with effect from 9th February, 2024 and (2) Re-designation of Mr. Shailesh Bhandari (DIN: 00058866), Managing Director as Executive Vice Chairman with effect from 9th February, 2024.

In accordance with aforementioned MCA Circulars, the Notice of Postal Ballot is being sent in electronic form only. The hard copy of the Postal Ballot Notice along with Postal Ballot form and pre-paid business envelope will not be sent to the Members for this Postal Ballot. The Company will send Postal Ballot Notice by email to all its Members who have registered their email addresses with the Company or Depository Participant(s) ("DPs") and the communication of assent / dissent of the Members will only take place through the remote e-voting system.

Members are requested to carefully read the instructions provided in this Postal Ballot Notice and record their assent (**FOR**) or dissent (**AGAINST**) only through the remote e-voting process by following the procedure as stated in the said instructions. The remote e-voting period shall commence at 9.00 A.M. (IST) on **Monday, 19th February, 2024** and shall end at 5.00 p.m. (IST) on **Tuesday, 19th March, 2024**. The remote e-voting will not be allowed beyond the aforesaid date and time and the remote e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL upon expiry of the aforesaid period.

An Explanatory Statement pursuant to Sections 102 and 110 of the Act and rules made thereunder pertaining to the said resolutions setting out the material facts and the reasons thereof, is appended to this Postal Ballot Notice. The Postal Ballot Notice will also be placed on the website of the Company at www.electrotherm.com, on the website of CDSL at www.evotingindia.com and also on the websites of the Stock Exchanges i.e. BSE Limited at www.bseindia.com and of National Stock Exchange of India Limited at www.nseindia.com.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, as amended and Regulation 44 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, Company is providing only e-voting facility to its members, details of which are given in notes forming part of this Postal Ballot Notice. Reference to Postal Ballot(s) in this notice refers to voting through electronic means only.

The Company has appointed Central Depository Services (India) Limited (“CDSL”) for providing/facilitating remote e-voting to enable the Members to cast their votes electronically. The instructions for remote e-voting are appended to this Postal Ballot Notice.

Pursuant to Rule 22(5) of the Rules, the Board of Directors of the Company have appointed Mr. Arvind Gaudana, Senior Partner or failing him Mr. Bhavya Gaudana, Partner of M/s Gaudana & Gaudana, Practising Company Secretaries, as the Scrutinizer for conducting the Postal Ballot in a fair and transparent manner. The Scrutinizer will submit the report to the Chairman of the Company, or any person authorized by him upon completion of the scrutiny of the votes cast through remote e-voting.

The results of the Postal Ballot will be announced not later than 2 working days from the conclusion of e-voting. The said results along with the Scrutinizer’s Report would be intimated to BSE Limited (“BSE”) and National Stock Exchange of India Limited (“NSE”) where the Equity Shares of the Company are listed. Additionally, the results will also be uploaded on the Company’s website www.electrotherm.com and on the website of CDSL www.evotingindia.com.

In the event, the Resolutions as set out in the Postal Ballot Notice are assented to by requisite majority by means of remote e-voting process, it shall be deemed to have been passed as Special Business at the General Meeting convened in that behalf. The last date of e-voting shall be the date on which the Resolutions would be deemed to have been passed, if approved by the requisite majority.

1. Elevation and Re-designation of Mr. Suraj Bhandari (DIN: 07296523) from Whole-Time Director to Managing Director with effect from 9th February, 2024:

To consider and if thought fit, to give assent/dissent to pass with or without modification, the following resolution as an **Ordinary Resolution**:

“RESOLVED THAT pursuant to the recommendation of the Nomination and Remuneration Committee and in partial modification of the earlier resolution approved by the Shareholders at 36th Annual General Meeting held on 31st August 2022, Mr. Suraj Bhandari (DIN : 07296523), who was appointed as a Whole-Time Director for a period of three years from 13th November, 2022 to 12th November, 2025, be and is hereby elevated and re-designated as a Managing Director of the Company, with effect from 9th February, 2024 for the balance tenure of the appointment upto 12th November, 2025 and he shall function under the supervision, control and guidance of the Board of Directors of the Company and is entrusted with substantial powers of management to manage the affairs of ‘Engineering and Technologies Division’ of the Company and shall also exercise such other powers of management to extent and in the matter delegated by the Board of Directors of the Company.

Managing Director but re-designated as a “Executive Vice Chairman” of the Company, with effect from 9th February, 2024 for the balance tenure of the appointment upto 31st January, 2026 and he shall function under the supervision, control and guidance of the Board of Directors of the Company and is entrusted with substantial powers of management of affairs of the entire Company except Engineering and Technologies Division of the Company and shall also exercise such other powers of management to extent and in the manner delegated by the Board of Directors of the Company.

The Explanatory Statement pursuant to Sections 102 and 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 (“the Act”) read with Rule 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (“the Rules”), as amended, setting out the material facts concerning the above mentioned Resolutions and the reasons thereof is annexed hereto and forms part of this Postal Ballot Notice (“Notice”).
2. The Brief profile of Mr. Suraj Bhandari (DIN: 07296523) and Mr. Shailesh Bhandari (DIN: 00058866) in terms of Regulation 36(3) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 was already provided as Annexure to the Notice of 36th Annual General Meeting held on 31st August, 2022 and Notice of Postal Ballot dated 14th February, 2023, respectively.
3. In accordance with the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, read with Rules made there under and circulars issued by Ministry of Corporate Affairs (“MCA”), the Notice of Postal Ballot is being sent only by email to all the Members and other persons so entitled and who have registered their email addresses with the Depository Participant (“DPs”)/Company’s Registrar and Transfer Agent (“RTA”) or the Company for this purpose. Members of the Company holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialised form as on cut-off date i.e. 9th February, 2024 will receive the Notice through electronic mode.
4. Members should note that in terms of the General Circulars, no physical ballot form is being dispatched by the Company and the Members can cast their vote using remote e-voting facility only.
5. A Member cannot exercise his vote by proxy on postal ballot. However, corporate and institutional members shall be entitled to vote through their authorised representatives with proof of their authorisation.
6. In accordance with the requirements of MCA Circulars, physical copy of this notice along with postal ballot forms and pre-paid business envelope will not be sent to the Members and accordingly, the Members are required to communicate their assent or dissent through remote e-voting system only.

7. Any queries/grievances pertaining to voting by postal ballot including the remote e-voting process can be addressed to Mr. Fageshkumar R. Soni, Company Secretary of the Company by sending an e-mail at sec@electrotherm.com.
8. In compliance with provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management & Administration) Rules, 2014, the Company is pleased to provide its members the facility to exercise their right to vote by electronic means. For this purpose, the Company has engaged the services of CDSL for facilitating e-voting in order to enable the members to cast their votes electronically. Detailed instructions on E-voting are given hereunder.
9. As per Section 110 and other applicable provisions of the Act read with Rule 22 of the Rules, cut-off date for the purpose of reckoning the Voting rights is Friday, 9th February, 2024 ("**Cut-off Date**"). A person who is not a Member as on the Cut-off Date should treat this Notice for information purposes only.
10. The Board of Directors of the Company has appointed Mr. Arvind Gaudana, Senior Partner or failing him Mr. Bhavya Gaudana, Partner of M/s Gaudana & Gaudana, Practising Company Secretaries as a Scrutinizer to scrutinize the Postal Ballot process in a fair and transparent manner.
11. The Scrutinizer will submit their report to the Chairman or any person authorized by him after completion of the scrutiny and the result of the Postal Ballot voting process will be declared within two working days from the end of voting.
12. The Scrutinizer's decision on the validity of the vote shall be final.
13. Resolutions passed by Members with requisite majority, through Postal Ballot shall be deemed to have been passed at a General Meeting of Members convened on that behalf.
14. The result of the Postal Ballot shall be communicated to all the Stock Exchanges where the equity shares of the Company are listed. The Ordinary Resolutions, if passed by the requisite majority, shall be deemed to have been passed on Tuesday, 19th March, 2024, being the last date specified by the Company for e-voting.
15. All relevant documents referred to in this Postal Ballot Notice requiring the approval of the members shall be available for inspection by the members until last date of e-voting. Members who wish to inspect the documents are requested to send an e-mail to sec@electrotherm.com mentioning their Name, Folio No./ Client ID and DP ID.

The Procedure and instructions for members for voting electronically under Postal Ballot are as under:

- (i) The Voting period begins on 9.00 A.M. (IST) on **Monday, 19th February, 2024** and shall end at 5.00 p.m. (IST) on **Tuesday, 19th March, 2024**. During this period, shareholders of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date of Friday, 9th February, 2024, may cast their vote electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.
- (ii) Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 9th December, 2020, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders/retail shareholders is at a negligible level.

Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.

In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through

their demat accounts/ websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants. Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease and convenience of participating in evoting process.

- (iii) In terms of SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 9th December, 2020 on -Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.
