Events Industry Urges Govt to Reconsider Cap of 100 Persons

Mumbai: The events industry, one of the most hit sectors due to the pandemic, has asked the Centre to reconsider the cap of 100 persons even as the government recently announced that political, religious, corporate and other events will be allowed from September 21.

In the wake of opening up of the industry, the Events and Entertainment Management Association (EEMA) representatives have shared a set of standard operating procedures (SOPs) with the government, highlighting their readiness for conducting events as well as the importance of the sector in kick-starting the economic engine.

"We were generating ₹5 lakh crore, out of which ₹1.7 lakh crore was from the organised sector and remaining ₹3.3 lakh crore was from the unorganised sector. But more than that, we are probably the only industry which is adding to the happiness index of the country. What value will you assign to it?" asked Lalit Gattani, chairman of EEMA Government Interaction Committee and CEO, Showcraft Productions.

The events industry which had come to a standstill due to the Covid-19 related restrictions has already lost around ₹40,000 crore as per various estimates. In all over 10 million people have been directly affected due to the crisis and are losing jobs and livelihood.

Gattani said that EEMA formed a task force with experts of various domains and has come up with detailed SOPs. "We have already presented the SOPs to the minister of state for Home Affairs, Nityanand Rai and have urged him to present it to the government task force. We have also requested meeting with the task force to present our points," he added.

On the cap of 100 persons, Gattani said that Events and Entertainment Management Association requests the government to keep it open based on the size of the venue on a 4 square metres per person formula.

"Instead of putting a ceiling, we suggest let's make it as per area available for the venue. We will still adhere to all the protocols," said Gattani.

Talking about the industry, Gattani said that it has 30% women employees out of 10 million and average age of the employees is 35 years, while that of business owners is 45 years.

"The industry was growing at a 23% rate till Covid19 hit," he said.

The events industry encapsulates all kinds of events including M.C.E. (meetings, incentives-convention-exhibition), political events, religious events, weddings as well as entertainment-based events like live concerts, sports meets and award ceremonies.

'General Wards Could be Converted to ICUs'

New Delhi: The empowered group of officers looking at health facilities amid Covid-19 has submitted a report underlining the need for a focus on intensive care unit (ICU) facilities and said an ICU can be created out of a general purpose ward as long as the Covid-19 treatment specific equipment is available. The report on 'Health System Prepa-

redness Needs' for June-August has been submitted by the empowered group-1 (EG-1) chaired by VK Paul, member (health), NITI Aayog, said people aware of the matter.

It comes at a time when the government has been stressing on strengthening hospital facilities, increasing the number of ICUs and oxygen beds, and efficient clinical management, to fight the pandemic.

On September 4, the government had said that less than 0.5% active cases were on ventila-

tor support (2.7), 2% were in ICUs (16,545) and less than 3.5% occupied oxygen supported beds (28,437). "The EG has underlined the fact that there is a need to focus on ICU facilities. It has been emphasised in the report that the ICU beds need not be fashioned for the wide purpose of ICUs that are normally created in typical hospitals. The Covid-19 specific ICUs suggested by EG-1, therefore, should be aligned with the specific and limited needs of Covid-19 patients rather than targeted to function as a generic medical or surgical ICU," a senior government official told ET. Some states have seen a shortage of ICU beds due to the high number of active cases, and the country is now seeing 900-1,000 deaths daily on account of Covid-19.

The report also said that the "Covid-19 specific ICU" can be more like a high dependence unit created out of a general purpose ward,

so long as it has the equipment of supplies that the EG-1 has spelt out. The report has been sent to all states, which have been advised to consult domain knowledge experts available in their districts and medical colleges, and initiate preparation of suitably creating or augmenting Covid-specific ICUs or high dependence units, said the official cited earlier, who spoke on condition of anonymity.
