Amreli SP: 12 cops caught stealing power, asked to vacate quarters

AFTER ELECTRICITY theft was detected in their official quarters, Superintendent of Police (SP) of Amreli district, Niripai Rai, ordered two assistant sub-inspectors (ASIs) and 10 police constables to vacate their quarters within two days. The latter will also be served show-cause notices as to why departmental action should not be taken against them.

A vigilance squad of the Paschim Gujarat Vij Company Limited (PGVCL) and a team of reserved police sub-inspectors in the headquarters of Amreli district jointly conducted a checking drive in the quarters of the Amreli Police Line on August 28. During the drive, power theft through direct tapping was detected in 12 of close to 300 quarters.

While two of these quarters were allotted to ASIs Naran Jagar and Chandangiri Goswami, three were allotted to head constables Shiva Jalaliya, Jyotsnaben Dhamal and Parasben Dhaduk. Four other quarters were allotted to police constables Shivraj Vala, Arvind Chauhan, Hiteshdan Bhevaliya and Parulben Gordhanbhai and one each to Lok Rakshaks Shradha Garaiya, Raviraj Khuman and Ratanben Jadav.

ASI Jagar and Gauswami are posted at police headquarters and Amreli city police station. Head constables Jalaliya, Dhamal and Dhaduk are posted with CID (crime). Amreli city police and Special Operations Group of Amreli, respectively. Vala, Chauha, Bhevaliya and Parulben Gordhanbhai are posted at Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB), Amreli taluka police station, Mounted Squad Amreli city police station,

respectively. Garaiya is posted with Amreli taluka police station, while Khuman and Jadav are posted headquarters and Amreli city police stations, respectively.

In an order issued on Monday, the Amreli SP ordered these 12 personnel to vacate their quarters within two days. "Despite them being employees of the disciplined police force and knowing law well, it appears they all have indulged in criminal acts and misdemeanor. Such conduct does not belong to the police force inside the Police Line and can affect other policemen and their families living near such personnel. Therefore, it is not in public interest to allow them to stay in the Police Line. Therefore, you are hereby ordered to 'Line Out' (sic)," the order stated.

"...You are directed to hand over possession of government quarters, presently occupied by

you, to police sub-inspector, police headquarters, Amreli, within two days, failing which this office will be constrained to take further action to vacate these quarters," the order added.

Rai said that the PGVCL will impose fine on these ASIs, police head constables, constables and Lok Rakshaks for power theft. "We shall issue them show-cause notices. We have asked them to vacate quarters because the police force is recognised by discipline and obedience to law," he said.

The SP added that the checking drive was undertaken after a complaint stated that power theft was rampant there. "I got an anonymous letter and called a team of the GEB (Gujarat Electricity Board). They told me (after the checking drive) that policemen have bypassed the metre and have taken direct connection from the line," Rai added.

Surat civic body collects record tax of Rs 34 crore in single day

AFTER ANNOUNCING rebate on advance payment of property tax, the Surat Municipal Corporation (SMC) received Rs 34 crore on August 31 through online and direct payment of property tax, the highest collection in a single day.

The state government had announced 20 per cent rebate on advance payment of property tax, while the SMC had announced 30 per cent rebate. The SMC also announced 2 per cent extra rebate for online payment. The last date of payment was

August 31.

"On the last day, the SMC received Rs 34 crore through online payment and physical payment at city centres, which has become record. Till now, the single day record was of Rs 18 crore, in 2018," said SMC Assistant Commissioner, Ashwin Naik.

SMC sources said that last year, 1.25 lakh citizens paid advance tax of Rs 95 crore online, while this year 1.46 lakh people deposited Rs 150 crore through the same mode.

"Starting from April to August 31, SMC received property tax of Rs 444 crore from 4.04 lakh property holders in the city and the amount is expected to go up in

the coming days," added Naik.

The SMC had created awareness through various campaigns, including banners and mike announcements.

SMC standing committee chairman, Anil Goplani, said, "We got good response from the citizens to avail of 30 per cent rebate for advance payment of tax. Many of them opted for online payment, availing of the extra benefit."

The Federation of Surat Textile Traders Association (FOS-TTA) has requested SMC to extend the time limit for advance property tax till September 30, as traders had faced huge losses during the Covid-19 lockdown.

2 persons booked for 'loan fraud' in Ahmedabad

TWO PERSONS were booked for fraud after they took a loan of Rs 1.99 crore from Central Bank of India's branch in Ahmedabad to buy machinery and allegedly sold them later to a third party and did not pay back the loan.

According to an FIR filed at Sardarnagar police station on Monday night, two accused -- Krishna Kumar Purohit and Jabaram Purohit, residents of Nikol in Ahmedabad -- were booked under IPC sections 406 (criminal breach of trust), 420 (fraud) and 114 (criminal conspiracy).

The duo allegedly got a loan of Rs 1.99 crore from Central Bank of India's branch at Saijpur Boghai in Ahmedabad in 2019 and later allegedly committed fraud against the bank. According to the complainant in the case, Ashish Shrivastava, Regional Manager of Central Bank of India, the duo had approached the bank for loan under Micro Small and Medium Industries (MSME) scheme.

"The bank had sanctioned a loan of Rs 1.99 crore for the duo for their company Messrs Hir Metal Corporation. The accused duo had to submit a receipt of production and raw goods every month," said the complainant in the FIR.

"However the accused did not submit receipts after which the bank got suspicious and we checked and found that the accused had sold all the machinery and mortgaged land to third parties," the complainant added.

Mobile phone racket in prison: 2 jail assistants held

TWO JAIL assistants of Amreli District Jail were among six persons arrested by the Special Investigation Team (SIT) probing the alleged racket facilitating phone calls from inside the jail for a fee. With this, the number of arrests in the case have gone up to

12. The SIT headed by RK Karamta, incharge inspector of the Local Crime Branch (LCB) of Amreli district police, arrested jail assistants Jayraj Manjariya (30) and Surendra Varu (30) on Sunday for their alleged involvement in the crime.

"During investigation, it came to light that employees of Amreli District Jail were supplying mobile phones and SIM cards to pris-

oners," a release from Amreli police said.

The release added that Naresh alias Narshi Vaghela, a prisoner who was earlier arrested in connection with the crime, used to collect money from relatives of prisoners lodged in the jail in for facilitating mobile phone calls for such prisoners. They would then hand over the collected amount to the two jail assistants.

"The two employees were part of the local checking squad of Amreli District Jail. But they would merely complete the formality of conducting checking of barracks. Even if mobile phones would be found in possession of prisoners,

the duo would not take any action," the release added.

Four others arrested are Kanti Vala of Savarkundla town of Amreli district, Suresh alias Sardul Hadgarda of Nagdhra village of Dhari taluka of Amreli district, Shailesh Chandu of Dolti village of Savarkundla taluka of Amreli and Irfan alias Talki Khimani of Amreli town. Police said Vala is facing three cases, including one of murder, while Chandu is facing cases of triple murder, attempt to murder, robbery, etc. Talki is facing cases of forging documents, and Hadgarda is facing six cases, including those of attempt to murder, rape, cheating, etc.

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section II of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 (No. 30 of 2013) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), the Government of Gujarat hereby declares that the land / lands mentioned in the Schedule annexed hereto is/are required for the purpose of acquisition for the public purpose of "Mumbai-Ahmedabad High Speed Rail Project."

'Community engagement must to tackle malnutrition'

MALNUTRITION AMONG children is a huge challenge and enhancing community engagement and collaboration is a must to help tackle it, health and nutrition experts at an online panel discussion said on Tuesday.

Speaking at the discussion, Dr Meeta Mathur, senior technical advisor to Coalition for Food and Nutrition Security (CFNS), New Delhi, said, "Community engagement is an important aspect, but it becomes superficial in absence of continuous engagement. We have to relook at how we can engage with the community differently. We need to engage religious leaders, faith healers, mothers-in-law, teachers, etc. in addressing the challenges. We must also look to involve women's collectives, self-help groups, and mother support groups."

The online panel discussion on

the theme 'Kuposhan se suposhan ki or-Meeting the challenges of mitigating malnutrition' was organised by FMCG major Adani Wilmar to mark the commencement of poshan maah (nutrition month).

In her address, Urvasi Prasad, public policy specialist at NITI Aayog, said that communities need to be engaged with a rights-based approach to health.

Rup Dalal, Director of Health and Nutrition at Shrimati Malati Dahanukar Trust, said that malnutrition also affects aging and appearance, growth, development, immune system, energy, when the children grow up.

"Thirty-eight percent of children are stunted due to lack of adequate growth nutrients. However, malnutrition does not only mean starving children but also not having proper nutrition. Around 22 per cent of the richest and 30 per cent of the middle-class children are malnourished," she said.

GUJARAT HC TO NCLT

'Either opt for virtual or physical proceedings'

THE GUJARAT High Court has held that a uniform mode of proceeding at the Ahmedabad bench of National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) - either virtual or physical - must be followed with appropriate standard operating protocol in place.

The order, dated August 21, by a division bench of Chief Justice Vikram Nath and Justice J B Pardiwala came following the refusal by the court of Justice Umesh Trivedi earlier to entertain a plea that had complained of several acute problems being faced by lawyers in litigating at NCLT owing to a combined format of virtual as well as physical proceedings, especially since virtual proceedings were often faced with technical snags. Justice Trivedi had further im-

posed a cost of Rs 10,000 for the rejected plea.

The division bench held that if the NCLT wishes to move to physical proceedings, it may but only with the consent of all lawyers appearing in the relevant litigation.

The bench also dissuaded against a mixed approach of some hearings or parties appearing via virtual medium and other hearings or parties heard via physical hearing. In case of lack of consent for physical hearings from lawyers, the proceedings shall have to be conducted over virtual medium.

The HC bench noted, "We would still like to sound a note of caution regarding adopting the mode of physical hearing... What we have been able to gather from the submission of the learned counsel appearing in this matter is that it is dangerous to conduct physical hearing..."

GAJERA GLOBAL SCHOOL

Former teacher accuses school trustee of sexual harassment in Surat

A 50-YEAR-OLD former teacher of Gajera Global School in Surat lodged a police complaint of sexual harassment against high-profile diamond merchant Chuni Gajera, trustee of the school, on Tuesday.

The complainant, who lives in Pipold area of the city with her two children, was employed at Gajera Global School in 2018 and

taught Hindi to students of classes six-10. After she had failed to comply with the school trustee's alleged inappropriate demands, she was expelled from the school on March 27, 2019, she stated in her police complaint. The woman added that she was mentally and physically harassed by Chuni Gajera regularly.

The accused, on December 25, 2018, had called her to his office on the fifth floor of Laxmi Diamonds and physically harassed her, the complainant stated. The survivor mentioned that she managed to escape from his office. The accused continued to harass her by sending her messages and repeatedly calling her, she said.

Subsequently, Gajera Global School principal Shweta Parihar asked the former teacher to not come to school citing "rude behaviour towards students", the complainant stated.

Sources said that the woman made representations to then police commissioner Satish Sharma. When no action was taken, the teacher filed a plea with the Gujarat High Court. The court ordered Surat Police to register an offence a few days ago. On Tuesday, Adajan police took her statements and lodged a complaint against Chuni Gajera under IPC sections 354 (A) and 354 (D) for assault or criminal force on a woman with intent to outrage her modesty. The teacher said, "I want justice. The accused is a high-profile person with political links."

Chuni Gajera could not be reached for comment.
