# EC issues notice to RaGa for panauti, other jibes

## Congress leader used the words for PM Modi during recent rallies in Rajasthan

New Delhi, 23 November

The Election Commission (EC) issued a show-cause notice to Congress leader Rahul Gandhi on Thursday for his "panauti", "pickpocket" and "loan waiver for the super rich" jibes at Prime Minister Narendra Modi, and asked him to respond by Saturday.

The ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) had approached the poll panel against the former Congress president, saying it was "unbecoming" of a "very senior leader" to use such language.

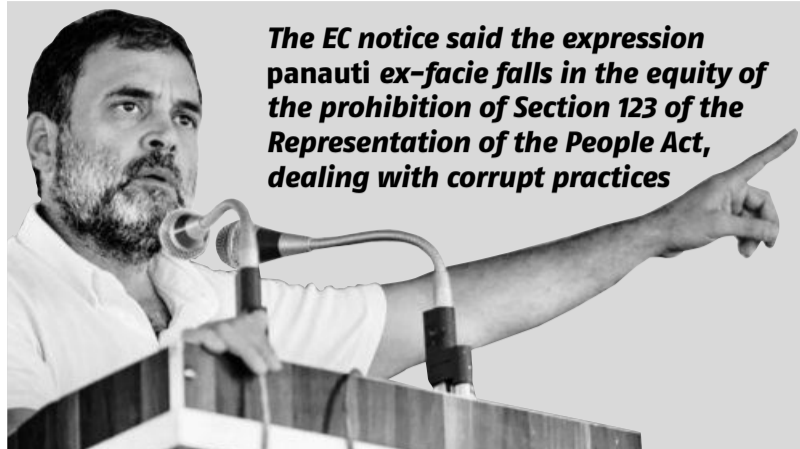
The EC reminded Gandhi that the Model Code of Conduct prohibits leaders from making unverified allegations against political rivals.

The Congress leader used those words targeting the prime minister at recent rallies in poll-bound Rajasthan.

In its representation to the EC, the BJP had asserted that the allegation of grant of waivers to industrialists of ₹14,00,000 crore over the last nine years was "not borne out on facts".

The EC notice said the expression "panauti" ex-facie falls in the equity of the prohibition of section 123 of the Representation of the People Act, dealing with corrupt practices.

Clause 2, sub section (ii) of section 123 states that any person who induces or attempts to induce a candidate or an elector to believe that he, or any person in whom he is interested, will become or will be rendered an object of divine displeasure or spiritual censure, shall be

deemed to interfere with the free exercise of the electoral right of such a candidate or elector, the notice reminded Gandhi.

The Congress leader had used the "panauti" barb against Modi in a poll speech in Rajasthan as the prime minister had attended the World Cup cricket final that India lost to Australia after 10 consecutive wins in the tournament.

A Hindi slang, "panauti" loosely refers to someone who brings bad luck.

The former Congress president took the "pickpocket" dig at Modi during a poll speech on Wednesday, alleging that the prime minister diverts people's attention while industrialist Gautam Adani picks their pockets. This is how pickpockets operate, he had alleged.

The notice also recalled a general

advisory issued by the EC, in which the poll panel had expressed concerns at the "plummeting level of political discourse" during electioneering.

The commission also told Gandhi about a Supreme Court observation that if freedom of speech and expression is protected by Article 19(1)(a) of the Constitution, the right to reputation is also considered to be an inextricable part of the right to life protected by Article 21 and "balancing these two rights is a constitutional necessity".

"Accordingly, you are requested to provide your explanation on the allegation made and to show causes as to why action as deemed fit for alleged violation of Model Code of Conduct and relevant penal provisions is not initiated by the commission."

# Moitra's expulsion from LS being planned, says Mamata

## 'Would help lawmaker before polls'

Breaking her silence on the "cash-for-query" allegation against TMC MP Mahua Moitra, party chief Mamata Banerjee on Thursday said that plans were in the works to expel her from Parliament but any such action would help the lawmaker from Krishnanagar ahead of the 2024 Lok Sabha elections.

Last week, Moitra, who is facing recommendations for expulsion from Lok Sabha, was tasked with strengthening the party's organisation in Nadia district, in a clear message of support from the TMC. "Now, they are planning to

expel Mahua (from Parliament). She will become more popular as a result. Whatever she used to say inside (Parliament), she will now say those things outside. Would anyone do something like this three months before the elections if he is not stupid?" Banerjee said, addressing a special session of the party at the Netaji Indoor Stadium.

BJP MP Nishikant Dubey had accused Moitra of taking bribes for asking questions in the House at the behest of businessman Darshan Hiranandani. PTI

## Lower House underlines confidentiality of replies

The Lok Sabha secretariat has underscored the confidentiality of government's replies to MPs during the Question Hour in the House and asked them to access their portal only for their exclusive use, a development triggered by the raging "cash-for-query" row involving TMC MP Mahua Moitra.

"It may be noted that since the replies are log-in and password protected on the Members' Portal, they are exclusively for the use of Members only," it said in its bulletin dated November 10, a day after the the House's Ethics Committee recommended Moitra's expulsion.

Members are, therefore, requested to maintain confidentiality of the replies and not to share the contents with others until the Question Hour is over, it added. It informed that the replies made in response to a question is "strictly confidential" until the question for oral answer has been asked and answered in the House. PTI

# DKS vs Sidda: Caste census splits Karnataka Congress wide open

Recent developments in Karnataka, where Deputy Chief Minister DK Shivakumar has aligned with Vokkaliga leaders to urge the Siddaramaiah-led government to discard a 2015 caste census report, have ignited a new of power struggle between the two leaders.

The controversy has prompted the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) to highlight the contradictions within the Congress regarding the issue of caste census and the Opposition INDIA (Indian National Developmental Inclusive Alliance) bloc.

Shivakumar, the Congress' foremost Vokkaliga leader and its state unit chief, has signed a petition demanding that the state government scrap the socio-economic and educational survey conducted by the earlier Siddaramaiah government in 2015. The petition calls for a fresh 'scientific' caste census.

In the Congress manifesto for the Karnataka Assembly polls in May 2023, the party pledged to increase reservations to 75 per cent. It committed to raising the quotas for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, and Other Backward Classes, and restoring the 4 per cent reservation for Muslims. The manifesto, and later Siddaramaiah, promised to implement the 2015 caste census report.

On Tuesday, just days before the state backward class commission was scheduled to submit the updated report, Siddaramaiah reaffirmed his commitment to accepting the updated report of the Kantharaj Commission on the social, economic, and educational status of castes. He also supported party leader Rahul Gandhi's call for a nationwide caste census.

Findings of the 2015 report were not officially released but leaked data indicated a substantial decrease in the numbers of Lingayats and Vokkaligas, two of Karnataka's most politically influential castes, from 17 per cent and 14 per cent, respectively, to below 10 per cent. The report could bolster Siddaramaiah's AHINDA (a Kannada

acronym for Alpasankhyataru or minorities, Hindulidavaru or backward classes, and Dalitaru or Dalits) politics but weaken the cause of Vokkaliga and Lingayat leaders within the Congress and BJP, and their respective communities.

Political commentator Gautham Machaiah raised the question, "Why are Lingayats and Vokkaligas opposed to the 'caste census'? Is it because their political superiority will suffer if it is revealed that

they are not the dominant communities of the state, as they have claimed for years?" The BJP's state leadership has been measured in its response to the controversy, as some of its Vokkaliga leaders, including the Leader of Opposition in the Assembly, R.Ashoka, former Union minister D.V.Sadananda Gowda, and Union minister Shobha Karandlaje, have also signed the petition.

The All India Veerashaiva Mahasabha has also demanded that the government order a fresh caste census.

However, the party's IT cell chief, Amit Malviya, tweeted on Thursday afternoon: "Karnataka Congress is split wide open on the issue of caste census. The survey report has also gone missing. While Rahul Gandhi is screaming about the caste census from rooftops, his own leaders do not agree with him. The I.N.D.I. Alliance is full of irreconcilable differences. Dump them."

In Karnataka, where the BJP faced challenges in the elections to replace BS Yediyurappa, its most towering Lingayat leader, and looked beyond him, it appointed his son B.Y Vijayendra as the party's state unit chief on November 10.

Among the constituents of INDIA, the Trinamool Congress is not in agreement with the census demand.

The author of the petition is the Rajya Vokkaligara Sangha. Janata Dal (Secular) leaders, now aligned with the BJP, H.D Deve Gowda and H.D Kumaraswamy, have also signed the letter.

On Wednesday, Shivakumar said that some communities complained they were not contacted before the census and are demanding a scientific caste census. BJP legislator Basanagouda Patil Yatnal has questioned why no action has been taken against officials of the state commission for backward classes for the irregularities in submitting the report.

On October 5, the commission declared it had lost the original copy of the report. However, its Chairperson, K Jayaprakash Hegde, who was set to retire this month, assured that the data is secure. The government has extended the tenure of the commission by a month.
