Pandey's appointment to GSTTA 'raises eyebrows'

AHMEDABAD: The appointment of IAS officer Alok Kumar Pandey to the executive committee of the Gujarat State Table Tennis Association (GSTTA) has "raised eyebrows" as it runs contrary to the rules specified in the National Sports Code, which governs the national sports federations. Various state and district sports bodies too operate under the code.

Pandey's appointment as senior vice-president of the state table tennis body was made last week. Asked if Pandey's appointment in the executive committee violated the Sports Code, GSTTA secretary Kunal Sanghania said, "An IAS officer can be nominated to a state sports body. Also, the National Sports Code isn't applicable to state sports bodies. Once a position is vacant, we can nominate an individual to GSTTA. The appointment is then ratified in the next annual general meeting."

However, the appointment and subsequent justification by the GSTTA secretary belies the verdict of the Delhi high court in the Rahul Mehra vs Union of India case. The HC had in its order delivered on August 16, 2022 observed, "The Sports Code must be made applicable to the Indian Olympic Association (IOA) and to every constituent National Sports Federations (NSFs) and to every state and district level association."

Talking to TOI, lawyer and sports activist Rahul Mehra said that though the Supreme Court ordered status quo to be maintained as far as the Committee of Administrators (CoA) is concerned, it's been clarified through observations by Delhi

appointment as senior vice-president of GSTTA. "Another sports activist and former table tennis player Yatharth Pandya, too, termed the appointment as a grave violation of the National Sports Code."

He sought the dissolution of the current executive committee as many members have been holding positions in the governing body for more than a decade and have been switching positions. "GSTTA should dissolve the current executive committee because many of its office-bearers have been holding positions in the governing body for more than one decade," Pandya said.

Senior IAS officer and current chairman of Gujarat Namada Valley Fertilizers & Chemicals Ltd (GNFC) Vipul Mitra had stepped down as the president of GSTTA after two decades following the verdict of Delhi HC asking the Table Tennis Federation of India (TTFI) and other NSFs to strictly follow the National Sports Code. Meanwhile, Pandey's nomination also runs contrary to the Central Civil Service (Conduct Rules), 1964.

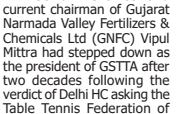
According to the Central Civil Service (Conduct Rules), 1964, to which an inclusion was made in December last year, "A government servant may be allowed to hold elective office in any body, whether incorporated or not, for a period of two terms, or, for a period of five years, whichever is earlier, for which prior sanction would be required when a government servant contests an election in such body, as per existing rules."

Further clarifying on this, Mehra said, "An IAS officer must be elected to the sports body. Any other mode of appointment is an infringement to the CCS (Conduct Rules)."

He added, "I've not received any letter about my

Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation instates lien on defaulting property



AHMEDABAD: To get defaulters to pay their property tax, the Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation (AMC) has begun putting liens on properties whose owners have defaulted on property tax. This move comes with the AMC's newly adopted "zero tolerance policy" against tax defaulters. The first such lien

recovered add up to over Rs 2,000 crore. In its first such instance, the AMC has put a lien on Bandhan Party Plot, which is owned by one Isha Khoda. The owner has not paid the property tax of Rs 17.38 lakh. Vakil said the AMC in an order directed that a lien be put on the said property.

The property owner will now have to reply to the mamlatdar in 60 days and if the owner pays the dues the AMC will issue an NOC to enable them to get the lien removed. Failure will result in a permanent lien, where the property cannot be sold without paying the tax. Officials said this would also ensure that owners pay their dues along with 18% interest as the lien mentions the 18% interest rate. Vakil said the AMC now plans to prepare a standard operating procedure for imposing liens.
