

Oppn fomenting violence over CAA: CM

ttar Pradesh Chief Adityanath said that the opposition was instigating people and fomenting violence over the Citizenship (Amendment) Act in the cover of democracy.

He charged that an oppo-sition party was running a malicious campaign to mislead the people for strengthening its vote bank for the ultimate

benefit of a political dynasty.
"This is unacceptable. The violence in different parts of the country has clearly established that the country has clearly established to the country be acceptable to the country beautiful t lished that the opposition leaders incited the people of the minority community for their narrow political ends. The name of a senior Congress leader has emerged in the vio-lence at the Jamia Millia Islamia University in Delhi. The Congress MLAs have committed contempt of the House and 23 crore people of UP by wearing badge on their wrist as this House does not belong to a particular political party or dynasty," the chief minister said in UP assembly on Wednesday.

Lashing out at the opposition for questioning the law and order in the state and their protest over the CAA, Yogi Adityanath said that crime and Samajwadi Party were "syn-onymous" while asserting that no riot had taken place during his regime and the state was peaceful.

The chief minister was responding to the adjournment notice given by the opposition parties over the deteriorating law and order in the state, particularly the Bijnor incident in which a murder accused under trial was gunned down in the courtroom of the chief judicial

Yogi Adityanath said that the incidents of gang-rape in Unnao and murder in Bijnor were unfortunate. "But no riot has taken place in Uttar Pradesh during the last two-and-a-half years. The state remained peaceful after abrogation of Article 370 and the Supreme Court verdict on Ayodhya issue," the chief minister said.

"The opposition should learn to accept facts and truth,"

Yogi Adityanath said law and order was the prime concern of his government and no laxity would be tolerated in the maintenance of law and order.

Targeting the Congress and the Samajwadi Party, the chief minister said: "The Bharatiya Janata Party realised the dream of Dr Ambedkar by abrogating Article 370 giving special status to Jammu and Kashmir and brought the border state in the constitutional mainstream, and this was

opposed by the Congress." He said Congress also attempted to delay the Supreme Court verdict on Ayodhya issue and created the impression that hell would break lose after the

"Not even a mosquito was killed in UP after the Ayodhya

verdict", Yogi Adityanath said. Moreover, he said, those behind the 1984 Sikh genocide

in Delhi, had the audacity of lecturing us on law and order.

The chief minister also reminded the Samajwadi Party that 'Kanwar Yatra' was banned by the Akhilesh Yadav regime and the superintendent of police in Mathura was killed in Jawaharbagh violence.

Yogi Adityanath said the Samajwadi Party had always sided with criminals whenever the government took tough

Bijnor incident rocks Assembly

PNS LUCKNOW

The Bijnor incident, in which a murder accused was shot dead inside a court-room, rocked the Uttar Pradesh assembly with opposition stalling the proceeding of the House for most of the question hour on Wednesday.

As the House assembled for the day, members of the opposition parties, including Samajwadi Party and Congress, trouped into the well of the House raising antigovernment slogans and stalled the proceedings.

The Bahujan Samajwadi Party members, however, remained seated on their seats.

The members refused to budge even on the assurance of Speaker Hriday Narain Dikshit that he would allow members to raise the issue at appropriate time.

As the opposition members were raising slogans Labour Minister Swami Prasad Maurya, who was donning the role of parliamentary affairs minister in the absence of Suresh Khanna, said that as the opposition had no issue before them, they were creating din in the House. adjourned the House, first for 30 minutes and then till 12:00

After the adjournment, the House resumed the question hour at 12:00 hours in which just three questions

were taken up.

Ram Govind Chaudhary (of SP) also slammed the state government over the grim law and order situation in the

"When criminals are killing people inside court, how can the common man be safe in the state?" he asked.

UP Congress president Ajay Kumar 'Lallu' demanded resignation of Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath, saying that when criminals were openly killing people inside courtroom, how could the Bharatiya Janata Party make claims of Ram rajya" (in the state).

"The Yogi government has no moral right to continue in the office as law and order has deteriorated. The Bijnor incident is a glaring example of the state of affairs in this regime,"

"They took out candle processions when notorious criminals were gunned down by the police and even approached the court to mount pressure on the government and the law enforcement agencies," he said.

The SP and Congress MLAs staged a noisy scene on the statement of the chief minister and trooped in the well of the House to protest his taking the names of opposition parties behind the CAA violence.

Speaker Hriday Narayan Dikshit rejected the adjournment notice and adjourned the House for the day after completing the agenda amidst slogan-

shouting by the opposition.

The chief minister, listing the crime statistics, claimed that incidents of rape in the state had gone down by 12.9 per cent in 2019 against the figure of 2016. Besides, he said, crime against women, including dowry related and kidnapping, too had decreased.

He said that the UP government had taken tough measures to tone up law and order, forcing criminals to either flee the state or be behind the bars. "BJP has zero tolerance

towards crime and there is no place for violence or crime in

Earlier, leader of the opposition and SP member Ram Govind Chaudhary, BSP leader Lalji Verma and Congress leader Aradhana Mishra slammed the BJP government over the deteriorating law and order in the state.

BJP MLA rues officials not paying heed to him

Lucknow (PTI): Bharatiya Janata Party MLA Nand Kishor Gurjar claimed on Wednesday that officials were openly charging commission and not paying any heed to him in his constituency of Loni in Ghaziabad.

The BJP MLA, who had on Tuesday tried to raise the issue of official apathy and found support from both the opposition and ruling party MLAs in the Legislative Assembly, said "cases are lodged against him" when he raises such issues.
"How will the dream of

Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath become a reality under such a situation? I am very disturbed," he said in the UP Assembly on Wednesday. "The officials had never dared to arrest me during the government of other political parties as they have done this time. An impartial inquiry needs to be ordered into this issue. I am a disciplined worker of the BJP," Gurjar said. "There are only 2-3 per cent officials who are honest. An inquiry needs to be done into their properties. How are NGOs being run in the names of their wives," he asked, amid thumping of desks by both ruling and opposition members with shouts of "shame-shame."

BJP sources said Gurjar was called by the chief minister for a meeting after Tuesday's incident.

Cutting across party lines, Uttar Pradesh MLAs on Tuesday forced the adjournment of the assembly for the day after the Speaker refused to let the BJP legislator discuss the alleged high-handedness of an official.

"Vidhayak ekta zindabad (long live the unity of MLAs)," chanted legislators when the House reassembled after a brief adjournment over the issue during the Zero Hour. Amid the din, Speaker Hriday Narayan Dixit announced the adjournment of the House for the entire day. There had been three brief adjournments earlier as Gurjar tried to raise the matter of

alleged high-handedness by a Ghaziabad food inspector with whom his representatives had reportedly had a quarrel on November 27. Parliamentary Affairs Minister Suresh Khanna and others were seen trying to calm Gurjar down during the

periods of adjournment.

Earlier, the Speaker observed that he was trying to understand the issue and said it would be resolved.

Senior members Raghuraj Pratap Singh (Independent), Aradhana Misra alias Mona (Congress) and Lalji Verma (BSP) said it was perhaps for the first time that the House had been adjourned for the day because of a ruling party MLA.

Even after the Speaker called it a day, some members from both sides kept occupying their

Hriday Narayan Dikshit said the matter would be resolved to which leader of opposition Ram Govind Chaudhari remarked that unless the views of the MLA were heard in the House, it would be difficult to find a solution.

Chaudhari said that the MLA had been humiliated.

The MLAs who kept sitting in the House even after it was adjourned for the day were called by Dixit around 7 pm and assured of a solution after which they departed. Earlier this month, Gurjar's

representative was arrested in Ghaziabad for allegedly manhandling the food inspector at the MLA's office. Gurjar levelled allegations of corruption against the food inspector after the arrest. The Loni MLA is also an accused in the case and has been served a show-cause notice by the party over it. "A lobby of the BJP is active against me and they are hatching a conspiracy to tarnish my reputation. They provoked the food inspector into lodging an FIR against me," he

ongress general secretary, Priyanka Gandhi Vadra continued her attack on Bharatiya Janata Party government over law and order claiming that in Uttar Pradesh the rule of law had turned out to be the rule of the criminals.
