CM announces arts college in Rishivandhiyam, more facilities at Kallakurichi GH

Top priority for infra projects in rural areas, lists projects for district

Kallakurichi, Aug 11: Chief Minister Edappadi K. Palaniswami announced a new Government Arts and Science College in Rishivandhiyam in Kallakurichi district, infra facilities in

Addressing a press conference, he said that the government had accorded top priority for improving infrastructure in rural areas to enable poor students pursue higher education.

Tamil Nadu is leading the country in the Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) in higher education. The GER, which was 32% in 2011 has now increased to 50%. Mr. Palaniswami also announced the creation of a new taluk headquarters with Kalvayyan hills. This was a long pending demand of the locals, he said.

Palaniswami listed out the measures his government had launched for the newly formed district. The new medical college in Kallakurichi and the upcoming trauma care facility at government Ulundurpet hospital will improve healthcare in the district, he said.

Palaniswami said one medical college hospital, 4 taluk hospitals, 64 primary health centres, and 2 urban health centres are functioning to serve the people in the district.

Palaniswami also announced free patta land to homeless people and residential flats to people living in urban and town panchayat areas.

Kallakurichi GH

Chief Minister announced that a state-of-the-art CT scan facility will be set up at Kallakurichi Government General Hospital at an estimated cost of Rs. 1.57 crores. Palaniswami said that a supply chain management scheme aimed at creating necessary infrastructure to reduce post-harvest loss in vegetables, fruits and other perishable commodities would be implemented in 10 districts.

An underground sewage system is under construction and Rs 32 crore has been allotted for that project, Palaniswami said.

New check dams

The government has also sanctioned Rs. 350



crores for construction of new check dams across the State to harness groundwater, he added. He also reviewed COVID-19 control measures in the district.

Milk productivity

Speaking about the farmer-friendly initiatives of the government, Palaniswami said a live-stock farm and research centre would be set up in Thalaiyalasal near the Kallakurichi-Salem border.

Stating that his foreign

trips helped him realise the milk productivity in the State was less compared to many developed countries, Palaniswami said a institute would be set up in Ooty to do research on developing highly productive breeds. An amount of Rs 48 crore has been earmarked for the project, he added.

“Further, a chain of cold storage facilities for fruits and vegetables is being setup in various places with funds from

both the Central and State governments so that farmers can store their products safely, when the rate is low and sell them when the rate is high. Farmers are given assistance in the form of equipment and subsidy”, CM said.

Ring road

Plans have been made to lay a ring road around Kallakurichi town to reduce traffic. An underground sewage system is under construction and Rs

32 crore has been allotted for that project.

Tribal School

An amount of Rs 15 crore has been allotted for the development of a tribal school on Kalvayyan Hills. Face masks worth Rs 4.5 crore were distributed through ration shops in corporations, municipalities and town panchayats limits. An amount of Rs 327 crore was spent to distribute free laptops to the students.

CM launches 16 completed projects, lays foundation for 60 new projects in Kallakurichi

Hails district authorities for effective measures to control COVID

Chennai, Aug 11:

To give infra boost to the Kallakurichi district, Chief Minister Edappadi Palaniswami launched 16 completed projects worth Rs. 15.16 crores and laid foundation stone for the 60 new projects worth Rs. 20.86 crores.

Following his visit to Madurai, Tenkasi, Tirunelveli, Dindigul and Salem, the Chief Minister visited Kallakurichi as part of his plan to implement COVID 19 prevention works in the Southern districts of Tamil Nadu. During his visit, he held discussions with the Kallakurichi district collector and the health officials regarding the development works and COVID 19 prevention plans in the district.

Palaniswami said “The AIADMK government is reaching out to the people directly instead of asking them to come forward with their needs.

Seeking people's co-operation to eradicate the Covid pandemic, Palaniswami said he was



travelling across districts to review the containment measures.

He conducted a meeting with officials in Kallakurichi to review the steps taken. “Thanks to proper action, the pandemic is under control in the district,” Palaniswami said.

He also listed out the measures his government had launched for the newly formed district.

After his discussion, Edappadi Palaniswami met the reporters. He told them that COVID 19 cases in Kallakurichi are under control due to the district administration's effective regulations set against the pandemic.

“The district administration played a significant role in restricting the spread of coronavirus in the district. Government schemes have also been implemented which have benefitted many farmers, self help group women, and the public,” he said.

Edappadi Palaniswami also met the Farmers' and Women's self help groups.

Concerning the farmers' demands, the Chief Min-

ister said that the alluvial soil from the lakes are fully utilised for agriculture and assured that the food grain production will be increased. He added that Rs 11 crore was allocated for the establishment of eNAM.

Furthermore, drinking water facilities were provided to 42,698 houses and water barriers were installed to conserve and manage water storage.

Law Minister CV Shanmugham, MLAs R z and A Prabhu, Collector Kiran Gurrala and senior officials were present.

70 people from Chicago, US, with 29 being women and 5 children. 38 women and 11 kids of the 180 from Sharjah. 7 children and 38 women of Doha's



171, Abu Dhabi's 96 consisting of 3 kids and 20 women, 17 from Sri Lanka. Vande Bharat mission has brought more than 50,000 Indians as yet. Swab and blood tests from the 534 people were taken at the airport and were sent to quarantine in hotels and medical colleges.
