# Perception about UP has changed: Yogi

Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath said that perception about Uttar Pradesh had changed as the state guarantees security without discrimination due to which investors were now willing to invest in the state.

Addressing a business conference organised in view of the municipal elections in Gorakhpur, the chief minister said that in the past, extortion and goonda tax were collected with impunity. "Goons, mafia and people of the ruling party used to encroach upon the properties of the poor and the establishments of the traders," he pointed out.

"Contrary to this, UP is now free of this anarchy. Every person is guaranteed security without discrimination and investors from the country and the world are willing to invest in UP," the chief minister said.

Stating that security and peace were very important for trade, the chief minister said, "The confidence of the people of the country has increased under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi. In the area of trade and industry, numerous reforms have been implemented. Today, the global market is open for India. All these have had a positive impact on per capita income and standard of living."

He said businessmen were eager to support the Bharatiya Janata Party on their own during the Lok Sabha and state



assembly elections. "However, it must also be remembered that the municipal body is the third house and that the importance of its election must not be undermined," he added.

The chief minister maintained that earlier the municipal bodies did not have many schemes. "A world-class city is being created under the BJP government's smart and safe city initiatives," he added.

"The Central government selected 10 cities of Uttar Pradesh under the Smart City Mission, while seven others, including Gorakhpur, were selected by the state government under the State Mission. Today, 17 cities are being developed as smart cities in Uttar Pradesh," he said.

The chief minister noted that the city had single-lane

roads in the past, then double-lane roads, and now a network of four-lane roads was being built.

"There is a multi-level parking facility. A strong house needs to be elected for the municipal corporation in order to expand these facilities," he added.

The chief minister humorously cautioned the traders against being overconfident and warned them, saying, "Don't make the mistake of going to Nepal on May 4. The border will remain sealed."

The chief minister appealed to the people to vote more and more as elections were a celebration of democracy and people should experience this celebration first hand. In elections, each vote has a value, he added.

# BJP to sweep mayoral elections: Chaudhary

Exuding confidence, Bharatiya Janata Party state president Bhupendra Singh Chaudhary said that the party would sweep the mayoral elections because the focus of the party was on development and extending the benefits of the government schemes to the people.

"Where is our rival? No one is near us. People have shown immense faith in Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath because both of them have delivered. Mark my words, the BJP will sweep the mayoral elections," Chaudhary told this reporter in Lucknow.

Chaudhary said that the previous governments did nothing in the name of development.

"Former governments gave protection to mafia and criminals and did politics of appeasement, and now the



public has understood their character. On the other hand, the BJP government has worked for all sections of society," he said.

The BJP state chief said that the criminals were either being killed or being sent behind the bars. "The BJP government promised to improve law and order and

Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath has provided a crime-free society," he added.

"This improvement in law and order has led to an increase in investments across the state. More investment means more jobs for the youth and this in turn will improve the economy of the state," Chaudhary said.

He said the Modi-Yogi government had worked in every field for development and due to this agenda of development, the BJP would win the elections with a huge majority.

"Whether it is clean drinking water or cleanliness, we have worked in each and every field. For example, many important public welfare schemes have brought about a comprehensive change in the standard of living of the people. We have provided toilets,

houses and have given free electricity connections to the people," the BJP state chief said and added that party workers had been asked to seek votes in the name of development.

Hitting out at Samajwadi Party, Chaudhary said the SP was unable to digest the wave of change that the BJP government had brought about in UP. "Before 2017, criminals used to rule in the state but today the rule of law prevails in UP," Chaudhary said.

# 'Effective pursuance of cases led to conviction of Ansari brothers'

The government said that Mukhtar Ansari and his brother and Bahujan Samaj Party MP Afzal Ansari could be sent behind the bars only due to effective pursuance of the cases against them.

A MP/MLA court in Ghazipur district sentenced mafia-turned-politician Mukhtar Ansari and his brother Afzal Ansari to imprisonment for 10 years and four years, respectively, in a 2007 Gangsters Act case and also imposed fines of Rs 5 lakh and Rs 1 lakh respectively on them on Saturday.

In an official communiqué, a government spokesman said the conviction

of the mafia and his brother was the biggest achievement of the Yogi Adityanath government's efforts to establish the rule of the law in UP where earlier mafias and criminals ruled the roost.

"The Ansari brothers were once synonymous with terror in Uttar Pradesh but they are cooling their heels in jail and their families are also languishing in jail. This could be possible due to good governance and effective pursuance of the cases against the mafia by the Yogi Adityanath-led government. Mukhtar Ansari has been sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment and a fine of Rs 5 lakh, while his brother

er Afzal Ansari has been sentenced to four years' imprisonment and a fine of Rs 1 lakh in the Gangster Act case," the spokesman said. The spokesman said, "Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath started taking stern action against crime and criminals under the zero tolerance policy in the state soon after he assumed the office. During the regime of previous governments, the mafia brothers used to win elections and used to openly commit atrocities."

He said Mukhtar's son Abbas Ansari was already behind bars in a money laundering case and Mukhtar Ansari's wife Afsha Ansari, younger son Umar Ansari were also implicated in

many cases and were currently absconding while Mukhtar's daughter-in-law Nikhat Ansari was in jail.

"These are the same mafias who used to flout the law of the land in the previous regimes and used to commit atrocities on the people of the state fearlessly. When these mafia roamed openly, it seemed that the rule of law ended before reaching their fiefdom. They had created a terror in the mind of the people and in front of them words like 'police', 'court', 'justice' had become meaningless. People were compelled to pay respect to the mafias but the Yogi government sent the mafias to their right place," the official said.

# Azam Khan fears threat to his life

Samajwadi Party leader Mohammad Azam Khan, known for making controversial statements, apprehends threat to his life and fears being shot dead in a manner similar to the killing of gangster-turned-politician Atiq Ahmad and his brother Ashraf.

Azam Khan said this on Saturday while campaigning for the SP candidate in urban local bodies elections.

"What do you want from me and my children? Do you want someone to come and shoot us in the head? That's all that is left... save Nizam-e-Hind, save the law," he said.

Azam Khan, who is suffering from a prolonged illness, took to the stage after a long time to campaign



for the upcoming civic polls in Uttar Pradesh.

"We will cast our vote, it is our fundamental right but that too is being snatched from us twice, if it gets snatched thrice then you won't even have the right to breathe," he said while referring to disqualification of himself from the UP assembly

after a court convicted him to three years in jail in a hate speech case. The case was registered against Khan for leveling serious allegations against administrative officials posted in Rampur, during the election campaign for 2019 Lok Sabha election.

Azam Khan campaigned for SP candidate Fatima Zabi, contesting for the post of chairperson of Rampur Nagar Palika Parishad.

Azam Khan, who is well-known for his sarcastic statements, attacked the Bharatiya Janata Party-led governments in UP and at Centre and ended up calling his opponents "political eunuchs".

Azam Khan was elected MLA from the Rampur Sadar constituency in March 2022. He was disqualified from the membership of UP assembly in October last year.

# CPI (ML) backs SP mayoral candidate

The Communist Party of India (Marxist-Leninist) extended support to Samajwadi Party's mayoral candidate in Lucknow.

In a statement issued on Saturday, CPI (ML) state secretary Sudhakar Yadav said SP mayoral candidate Vandana Mishra was giving a tough challenge to the Bharatiya Janata Party candidate and her chances of winning the election were fairly strong.

He said the BJP had harmed the democratic set-up of the country and the UP by its politics of hatred, division and running the government by bulldozer.

# Medical Device Park to create job opportunities

Lucknow (PNS): Uttar Pradesh is making rapid strides toward becoming a hub of medical devices and medicines manufacturing in the country as the Medical Device Park, which is set to be developed on a 350 acre area in Gautam Buddha Nagar, will not only manufacture medical devices but also create employment opportunities on a large-scale.

According to the data released by the Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority (YEIDA), a total of 59 plots of area ranging from 4,000 square metres to 1,000 square metres, have been allotted to companies manufacturing medical device equipment.

"These companies will be investing

more than Rs 415 crore to set up their own factories, which will create employment opportunities on a massive scale and contribute to the growth of the medical industry in the area," Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority Chief Executive Officer Dr Arunveer Singh said.

The list of medical devices that will be manufactured at the park is quite extensive and diverse, ranging from orthopedic implants, oxygen concentrator, anaesthesia needle and kit, anaesthesia workstand, spinal implant, X-ray machine, endoscopic, gastrology medical device, biliary stent, ICU ventilator, ECG machine and trauma management implant to coronary stent, hemodialysis kit, CVC kit, AVF needle,

heart-lung bypass kit, cancer care equipment, video colposcopic machine, chemotherapy device, radiology device, nuclear imaging device, intraocular lens, ophthalmic medical device, portable mobile lab, electrolyte analyser, biosafety cabinet, hematology analyser.

This initiative has the potential to bring about significant positive changes in the healthcare sector of Uttar Pradesh and contribute to the overall growth of the region.

The top 10 companies that have set up units in Medical Device Park include MDD Medical Systems India Pvt Ltd (445 employees), Auxen Medical Pvt Ltd (400 employees), Genuine Medical Pvt Ltd (400 employees), Innovation Meditech Pvt Ltd (350 employees),

Romsons Group Pvt Ltd (300 employees), AGVA Health Care (200 employees), Avience Biomedicals (151 employees), SPM Medicare Pvt Ltd (150 employees), NuLife Care (150 employees), Nareena Lifesciences Pvt Ltd (110 employees).

With excellent connectivity, including the Metro, motorway and Transport Nagar, and the possibility of bullet train connectivity in the future, this park will provide world-class facilities to medical device manufacturers.

According to Dr Arunveer Singh, under the guidance of the Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath, the construction of two flatted factories by YEIDA to help industrialists with a low budget was an excellent initiative.

# Bijli Mitra to help check power theft in state

In a novel initiative to check electricity theft in Uttar Pradesh, the Yogi Adityanath government has launched 'Bijli Mitra'.

The Bijli Mitra link has been introduced on Uttar Pradesh Power Corporation Limited website and it will enable people to report electricity thefts to the UPPCL without disclosing their identities so that the culprits are brought to book.

The state government is taking strict measures to check electricity thefts along with providing uninterrupted power supply to every family. Recently, the government started a campaign to identify people with illegal electricity connections to regularise the illegal connections and Bijli Mitra is part of this drive.

UPPCL Chairman M Devaraj said that until now complainants were required to give their mobile phone numbers, names of the discom and the sub-station for reporting power theft to the UPPCL through the link and chat bot available on UPPCL's website

# UPERC decision on power hike next month

Power sector regulator, Uttar Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission has completed the public hearing on the petition filed by the power distribution companies for hike in power tariff for the current fiscal 2023-24.

The power regulator is likely to issue the revised tariff order by the end of next month.

UP Power Corporation Limited and its five subsidiaries had filed the annual revenue requirement (ARR)

petition seeking a hike of 18-23 per cent in power tariff earlier this year.

The electricity regulator had conducted the public hearing on the petition across the state.

The power consumer organisations opposed the hike in power tariff and also demanded refund of surplus of Rs 25,133 crore to the consumers. Besides reduction in power tariff for the current fiscal, the demand for a probe into the purchase of smart meters was also made.

The issue of power theft

was also raised before the power regulator. Avadesh Verma, member of the state advisory committee on energy, said power worth over Rs 5,000 crore was stolen annually and this happened with the connivance of the engineers and staff of distribution division of the UP Power Corporation Limited and its subsidiaries.

He said the regulator should take tough measures to curb power theft and the consumers should not be penalised for the crime committed by the engineers.

In the next column, the address of the place of theft of electricity will have to be mentioned compulsorily. After this, the name of the district where the electricity theft is taking place will have to be given compulsorily. In the next column, other details like landmarks, information about power theft (if available) will have to be given.

The other column will also

have the facility to upload photos and videos, if available.

As soon as one enters the captcha code, the department will receive the complaint and investigation will begin and legal action will be taken against the culprit.

Earlier, the Yogi Adityanath government had taken the initiative to provide electricity connection to the people using electricity without a connection. In order to make this campaign a success, UPPCL Chairman M Devraj had issued an order to identify all the families without electricity connection and provide them the same.

In this, the help of students, self-help groups and 'Vidut Sakhis' will be taken. According to government data, there are 3.27 crore electricity consumers in the five distribution corporations under UPPCL. The total number of connections for domestic use is 2.88 crore. Looking at the population of the state, it is clear that the number of domestic electricity connections is less in relation to the total number of households. That is why the government has taken this decision.
