Why Khadi ?

We all are aware that for the last several years, our PM Narendra Modi has left no stone unturned to popularize Khadi and create a mass movement where everyone purchases Khadi products, specially on the special day of Gandhi Jayanti. Recently PM Modi inaugurated new Khadi Gramudyog Bhavan in Ahmedabad's "Khadi Utsav" and said that "Khadi instils self respect, can inspire India to become developed nation." Modi has always been promoting Khadi and has also mentioned it in his radio address multiple times. His Mann Ki Baat gives utmost importance of Khadi and its role in the empowerment of the countrymen. He even talked about the growth of the Khadi industry in this year's Independence Day address. According to him poor are getting jobs because the sales of Khadi have increased and the recent data revealed by Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC) backs the

claim. In relation with Khadi, Sardar Patel has said that India's freedom lays in Khadi and so does the nation's cultural identity. Our PM himself regularly wears Khadi and has been doing so since the very early days when he was working for the RSS and BJP organisation. He has popularised it among the masses and even among foreign dignitaries, while developing his own styles around khadi. He has given the Mantra of 'Khadi for nation, Khadi for fashion' - the idea that Khadi can become a symbol of national pride and a fashion statement, which can be popular among the youth. The Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC), is a statutory organisation engaged in promoting and developing Khadi and village industries created by the Act of Parliament. Khadi refers to a hand-spun and hand-woven cloth. The raw materials may be cotton, silk, or wool, which are spun into threads on a charkha, a traditional spinning implement.

Khadi was launched in 1920 as a political weapon in the Swadeshi movement of Mahatma Gandhi. The relevance of Khadi and Village Industries is that they are both labour intensive in nature. In the wake of industrialization, and the mechanization of almost all processes, Khadi and Village industries are suited like no other to a labour surplus country like India. Modi repeatedly says that "When we purchase a Khadi, we are brightening the lives of the lakhs of weavers who toil day and night. Buying a Khadi product is like ushering a Diwali in the homes of the weavers. He feels that khadi is getting wide acceptance in the society for the last decade and it would be in the fitness of things for each person to buy at least one pair of khadi dress as the best possible tribute to the Mahatma. Gandhiji was the founder of Khadi, but it was Khadi which inspired Gandhiji at every stage of his life and work. The first

inspiration came to him in the year 1908. He returned to India from South Africa on Jan 9th 1915 and started his ashram at Ahmedabad. Here the Khadi became a practical. Khadi became a common factor among the "satyagrah" and served as unifying thread among Indians. It was right called "the livery of freedom" Gandhiji launched the programme of Khadi and village industries as an integral part of the freedom struggle for the economic emancipation of the downtrodden masses of India by providing them with gain full employment and subsistence to them. The Charkha is a powerful symbol that Mahatma Gandhi used during his fight against colonialism and injustice. It stood for self-sustenance and a war against poverty. Mahatma Gandhi strongly advocated the usage of Khadi products. No doubt, today there is greater awareness about Khadi and it can be a powerful means of empowering the poorest of the poor.

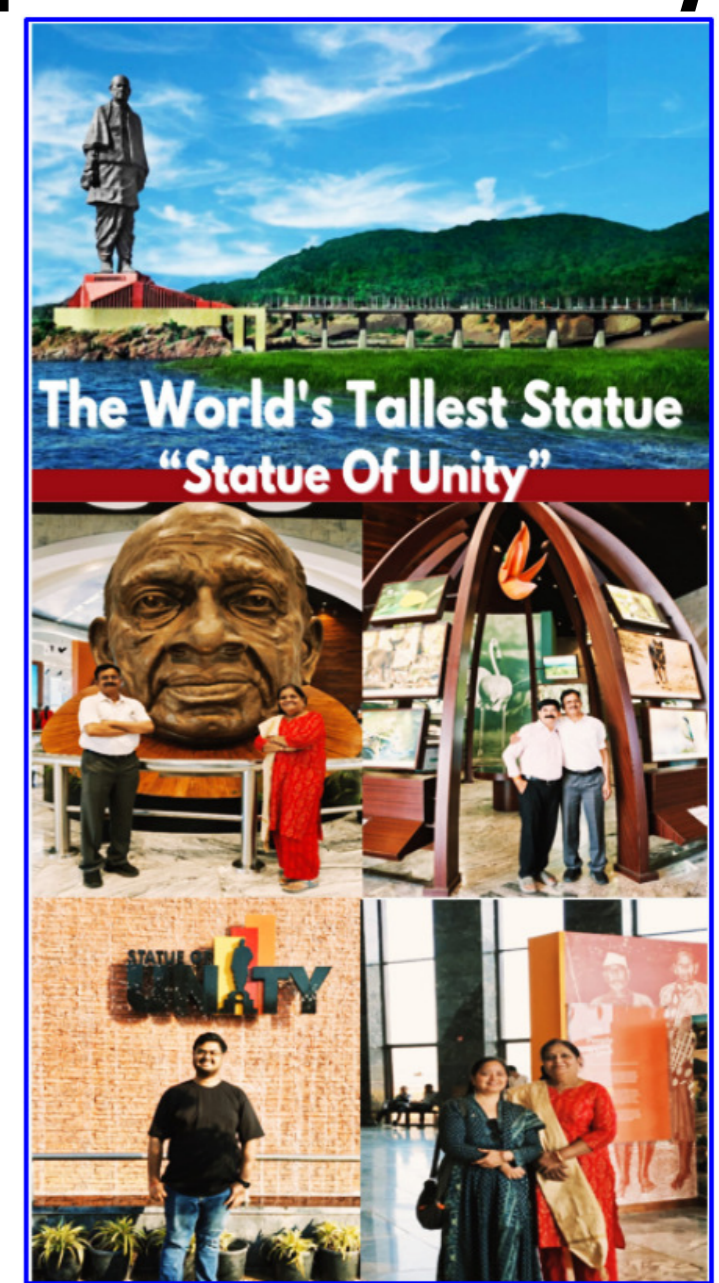
Our Memorable trip to Statue of Unity

I visited the majestic Statue of Unity with my wife Neelu, my son Krutarth, Shrawanji & Chetna Dwivedi. Statue of Unity is one of the most prominent Indian leaders, the statue of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, who is remembered as the Iron Man of India. Sardar Vallabh Bhai Patel, the "Iron Man of India", was the man of firm grit, courage, and enthusiasm. A shrewd and kind-hearted statesman, Sardar Patel played a pivotal role in the unification of post-independent India. Kutch to Kohima, Kargil, or Kanyakumari - if we can travel freely today across the beautiful and bountiful lands of India, it is because of his tireless efforts. The Statue of Unity is the tallest statue in the world. It is 600 ft tall. Its construction took 2,500,000 cubic feet of concrete, 5700 tons of steel structure and 18,500 tons of reinforced steel rods, and 12,000 bronze panels weighing 1700 tons. It is the most visited place and a popular tourist destination. Rajpipla is the nearest city to the statue of unity, which is just 25 km away. Other nearest cities are Vadodara - 90 km away, Surat - 150 km away and Ahmedabad - 200 km away from the Statue of Unity. Once you reach the above-said city by train, air or bus, you can hire

a cab or take a bus to Kevadia district. From there, you need to take local autos from the Kevadia bus stop to the monument. We travelled by car, so we reached the monument directly. We couldn't believe my eyes. It felt heavenly; certainly, incredulous. No wonder that it took 250 engineers, 3,400 laborers, 70,000 tonnes of cement, 18,500 tonnes of reinforcement steel bars, 6,000 tonnes of structural steel, and 1,700 metric tonnes of bronze to build this iconic statue. We thoroughly enjoyed our visit to the iconic Statue of Unity. It was simply amazing to witness the bounties of nature complimenting the impeccable architecture to offer a beautiful panoramic view. The Viewing Gallery at Statue of Unity has been designed in a way so that viewers can enjoy the natural surroundings. There are no obstacles or a glass installed on the facade of the viewing gallery. It has been kept open for the simple reason that people can enjoy the experience of watching the natural beauty from such a height. We also took chance to visit Jungle Safari a state-of-art zoological park with unique collection of indigenous and exotic animals and birds from the various biogeographic regions of the world, is located at the picturesque hills near the tallest statue of the world "The Statue of Unity" and "The Sardar Sarovar Dam" at Kevadia. This zoo rally took us through an adventurous and exciting trip of watching wildlife, enjoying scenic beauty of the hills and entertaining experiences of a lifetime. Apart from the statue itself, there are many more



places nearby, which are worth visiting. After visiting, I would only say that visit to the Statue of Unity is more than just a trip because it is an opportunity to embrace the spirit of unity and explore the rich heritage of India. As we stood before this monumental statue we felt reflect on the values of integrity, courage, and togetherness that Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel embodied. Truly, if you are looking for some fascinating short-break holiday options, then, a trip to the Statue of Unity can definitely fulfill your purpose. Today, Statue of Unity has become the pride of the nation in no time. It is the world's tallest statue and is attracting many tourists from all over the world. Trudeau's legacy: A cautionary tale of 'woke' politics gone wrong



As whispers of Justin Trudeau's resignation as Canadian Prime Minister grow louder, one cannot help but marvel at his astounding and embarrassing fall from grace. Once touted as the epitome of a modern-day "woke" and liberal leader, he now finds himself at the centre of several humiliating international diplomatic fumbles, including his ongoing tussle with India, becoming the butt of many a joke. His harshest critics will attribute this as an obvious ending to a career that was largely driven by a need for a certain kind of optics and powered by a certain lobby for the sole purpose of virtue signalling. On Monday, he became the first Canadian Prime Minister since 1920 to resign without losing an election or officially retiring. So, how did things go so wrong for the oft-hailed "crown prince of woke politics"? By 2021, Justin Trudeau's Liberal Party of Canada found itself in serious trouble, losing a significant number of seats in Parliament due to multiple scandals. These losses compelled Trudeau to form alliances with Canada's left-wing New Democratic Party. In recent times, the departure of several key political supporters and allies, coupled with mounting cost-of-living pressures in Canada, has created a wave of negative publicity and discontent among Trudeau's countrymen. The resignation of Chrystia Freeland, his deputy prime minister and finance minister, proved to be a pivotal moment in Trudeau's political decline. Her abrupt departure stemmed from a dispute over how to respond to the incoming Trump administration and its policies. US President-elect Donald Trump announced plans to impose a 25 per cent tariff on all Canadian products, further escalating tensions. Trump even went so far as to suggest that Canada could become the 51st state of the United States, referring to Justin Trudeau as "Governor Justin Trudeau." Strong words for a weak man? The fallout between Freeland and Trudeau over how to address this looming threat was significant. Adding to the damage, Freeland, in her resignation speech,

criticised the government's recently announced tax holiday and its plan to issue \$CA250 cheques to millions of families, calling it a "costly gimmick that Canada can ill afford." Prior to Freeland's exit, Canada's former housing minister Sean Fraser had also announced his resignation, further compounding

Lavalin challenges. Trudeau's leadership has been marred by multiple ethics scandals that Canadian citizens have not forgotten. On 14 August 2019, Ethics Commissioner Mario Dion released a damning report on the SNC-Lavalin affair, which led to the ousting of two Cabinet members, key aides to Justin Trudeau, and widespread calls for his resignation at the time. SNC-Lavalin, a Canadian engineering company, faced charges of corruption and fraud involving nearly \$48 million in payments to the Libyan government. It was alleged that Justin Trudeau and his aides pressured Jody Wilson-Raybould, the then Attorney General, to intervene in the case to spare SNC-

Lavalin from prosecution. In 2020, Trudeau and the Liberal Party faced further scrutiny over a conflict of interest concerning their contract with WE Charity to manage a \$900 million student grant programme. Allegations surfaced that WE Charity was favoured due to Trudeau's close personal ties to the organisation. It was later revealed that several of Trudeau's family members, including his mother Margaret and then-wife Sophie, were paid six-figure sums by WE Charity for appearances.
