THIRTY FOURTH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF THE EQUITY SHAREHOLDERS OF 8K MILES SOFTWARE SERVICES LIMITED HELD ON SATURDAY 30<sup>th</sup> NOVEMBER, 2019 AT 10:30 AM AT THE RAINTREE, ST MARY'S ROAD, CHAMIERS HALL, 120, ST MARY'S ROAD, ALWARPET, CHENNAI-600018.

I, P. Sriram, Proprietor of P. Sriram & Associates, Practicing Company Secretaries, was appointed as Scrutinizer by the Board of Directors of **8K MILES SOFTWARE SERVICES LIMITED**, CIN: L72300TN1993PLC101852 ("the Company") for the purpose of voting by electronic means i.e. remote e-voting and voting by poll at the Company's Annual General Meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 at the venue mentioned above (AGM). Pursuant to Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 (the Act) read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 as amended ('Rules') in respect of resolutions contained in the Notice dated 02<sup>nd</sup> November, 2019 of the AGM held on 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2019.



The management of the Company is responsible to ensure the compliance with the requirements of the Act and Rules relating to voting through electronic means [i.e. by remote e-voting and voting by poll (Insta Poll) at the AGM for the resolutions contained in the Notice of the AGM. My responsibility as a scrutinizer is restricted to ensure that the voting process through remote e-voting and poll at the AGM is conducted in a fair and transparent manner and to make a Consolidated Scrutinizer Report of the votes cast 'For' or 'Against' the resolutions contained in the Notice.

#### **Report on scrutiny:**

- 1. The Company has entered into an arrangement with Central Depository Services (India) Ltd (CDSL), the Agency authorized under the Rules and engaged by the Company to provide e-voting facilities for voting through electronic means to all the members who were eligible to take part in the remote e-voting.
- 2. The cut-off date for the purposes of identifying the shareholders who will be entitled to vote on the resolution placed for approval of the shareholders was  $25^{th}$  November, 2019.
- 3. As prescribed in the Rules, remote e-voting facility was kept open for three days from Friday, 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 (09:00 Hours IST) till Monday 29<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 (17:00Hours IST) preceding the date of the AGM.
- 4. As on the cut-off date i.e. 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 there were 34,972 Shareholders.
- 5. At the end of remote e-voting period on 29<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 at 17:00 HRS IST, voting portal of CDSL was blocked forthwith.



- 6. After the poll ordered by the Chairman at the AGM, One poll box kept for polling were locked in my presence with due identification marks placed by me. The key of the poll box was handed over to the Chairman of the AGM after locking it.
- 7. After completion of the poll at the AGM, the poll boxes kept for voting were immediately opened by me in presence of two witnesses who were not the employees of the Company.
- 8. The Shareholders present in person and through proxy at the AGM were 115 & 8 respectively.
- 9. On Saturday, 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 at 13:07 PM. after counting votes cast at the AGM, the votes cast through remote e-voting were unblocked by me in the presence of Ms. Nithya Pasupathy and Mr.Kiran Bhaskar.
- 10. The voting ballot papers for the Poll conducted at the AGM and remote e-voting records were reconciled with the records maintained by M/S Adroit Corporate Services Private Limited, the Registrar and Share Transfer Agents (RTA) of the Company along with the authorizations/ proxies lodged with the RTA/Company. The voters were also scrutinized for the purpose of eliminating duplicate voting (i.e.,) on remote e-voting as well as by use of ballot.
- 11. The poll papers which were incomplete and/ or which were otherwise found defective have been treated as invalid and kept separately
- 12. The total votes cast in favour or against all the resolutions proposed in the Notice of the AGM are as under:
