The Petitioner named above requests that the Tribunal grant the following relief:

Relief(s) sought.

In view of the facts mentioned in the above paragraphs, and duly considering the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Dale and Carrington that the oppressor should not be allowed to take advantage of his own wrong doings. The petitioner should be permitted to buy out the respondents in order to end the oppression. The Petitioner prays for the following relief(s) in the interest of Justice, and in order to end the oppression and mismanagement of the Company and also to protect the minority interest and other genuine shareholders:

a. Declare that the acts of the Respondent Nos.2 to 4 are prejudicial to the interest of the Respondent No.1 Company and are oppressive against the Petitioner.

- b. Declare that the Respondent No.3 is not an Independent
 Director and all meetings of the Audit Committee and
 Remuneration Committee, which mandates the appointment
 of Independent Director to properly constitute such
 committee as null and void and not binding on the
 Respondent No.1 Company and its shareholders
- c. Declare that the Respondent Nos.2 to 4 failed to perform their duties as a Director under Section 166 of the Companies Act, 2013 and declare that the Respondent Nos.2 to 4 cease[®] to be Directors of the Respondent No.1 Company.
- d. Punish Respondent Nos.2, 3 and 4 for their continued illegal acts and being beneficiaries of the illegal gains as per provisions of the Criminal Procedure Code and also prohibit them from holding any post of Directorship or any office in the Respondent No.1 Company.
- e. Direct the Respondent No.3 to return all the amounts received from the Respondent No.1 Company and the Company owned by Promoters during his tenure as Independent Director of the Respondent No.1 Company.
- f. Pass such further or other orders as this Hon'ble Tribunal may deem fit and proper and thus render Justice
