YATINOZA'S APOLOGY REJECTED

Liberty of free expression not licence to make unfounded allegations: HC

UNCONVINCED THAT the "unqualified and unconditional" apology tendered by the Gujarat High Court (HC) president Yatin Oza was neither genuine nor bonafide, a division bench of the high court (HC) refused to accept his apology on Wednesday.

The HC bench said that the order would send a "clear and loud message", and held that "the liberty of free expression is not to be confused with licence to make unfounded allegations against any institution much less the judiciary."

The court had initiated criminal contempt proceedings against Oza for making "scurrilous" remarks, what the court deemed undermined the authority of the courts. A press conference held in the first week of June and live-streamed over Facebook drew the court's ire. Oza had alleged "Tautovism" and "forum shopping" by advocates and the administrative side of the court.

The bench said that the judgment was Oza's "repeated acts and conduct of contempt" in

to every healthy criticism respecting the fundamental right of freedom of expression and at the same time, we are obligated not to permit any attempt to tarnish the image of the institution... Entire gamut of facts (with respect to Oza's apology) when dispassionately and objectively viewed, we are unable to accept these words as true words of remorse and contrition and therefore, refuse to accept apology even if termed as unqualified, cannot be accepted to," noted the judgment.

The division bench of Justices Sonia Gokani and NV Anjaria also relied on precedents set by the Supreme Court in earlier judgments. The HC also noted that the bench adjudged that "mere apology may be no answer to an act, utterance or publication of contempt which is grave in nature so as to scandalize the majesty, dignity and authority of the court."

The HC also noted that Oza's affidavit mentions that he holds the judges of the HC in the highest esteem and that his outburst was meant against the registry alone and not the judges, for which he admitted that causing such a stir could have been avoided, the court was unconvinced by Oza's reasoning.

Not mandatory to hear the victim for bailable offences under SC/ST Act: HC

INTERPRETING PROVISIONS of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Act, 2015 (1 of 2016), the Gujarat High Court held that if an accused under the Act is charged with offences that are bailable, it is not mandatory to grant opportunity of hearing to the victim.

The judgment on August 6, by a division bench comprising Chief Justice Vikram Nath and Justice JB Pandhara, came in a case where a manager of Western Auto Spares in Ahmedabad, Hemal Jain, had challenged the provisions within the Act that stipulates issuance of notice and opportunity to hear victim of SC/ST atrocity crime.

Advocate Virat Popat who was representing Jain, said that an FIR was registered after Jain had "abused an employee of the factory" and was charged under sections 3(1)(v) and 3(1)(vi) of the Act along with IPC section 506 (criminal intimidation). While Jain was granted bail, a special trial court, he moved HC to challenge the existing provisions that mandate hearing of the victim.

The specific provisions challenged by Jain, dealt with the rights of victims and witnesses under the Act's Section 15A (3), a victim or his dependent "shall have the right to reasonable, accurate, and timely notice of any court proceeding, including any bail proceeding, and the Special Public Prosecutor or the State Government shall inform the victim about any proceedings under this Act."

Section 15A (5) of the Act, which states that a victim or his dependent "shall be entitled to be heard" at any proceeding under this Act, was also challenged. Jain submitted that these two provisions are directory in nature and not mandatory.

The court was largely unconvinced by the applicant's arguments and held that the provisions are mandatory in nature. It also held that the primary objective of section 15A (3) is to prevent atrocities upon the members of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and "if a certain provision "enables the victim to appear before the competent court... one cannot imply that such a provision is "laying any fetters or unreasonable restrictions on the court..."

PM's Next Gujarat Tour

ASTHE situation limps back to normalcy from the pandemic, speculations are doing rounds about Prime Minister Narendra Modi's next visit to Gujarat. Some speculate that the PM is likely to visit Gujarat on September 17 to seek blessings from his mother on his birthday. However, top officials in the Secretariat say that the PM seems certain about visiting the Statue of Unity at Kevadja Colony in Narmada on October 31. The PM has declared to celebrate October 31 as Rastriya Ekta Diwas (RED). Last year, he had started the celebration with armed forces at RED. This year, he looks certain to visit the SC for the RED celebration to take to a level of Republic Day celebrations, "said a senior IAS officer. However, another senior IAS officer said, "Instead of coming to Gujarat on his birthday, he may celebrate the day with soldiers posted on any of the borders."

'Historic Revolution'

AUGUST 25 marked the fifth year of the Patidar reservation agitation. Garnering national attention in 2015, the agitation had catapulted Hardik Patel as a youth leader when he addressed a massive rally at GMCDC ground in Ahmedabad. Violence had erupted and left 14 Patidars dead owing to police action. On Tuesday, Hardik greeted Patidar community members on social media for the "historic revolution". Now the working president of Gujarat Congress, Hardik listed three benefits of the agitation: Mukhyamantri Swavlamban Yojana, 10% reservation on economic grounds and relaxation of five years in age limit for government jobs for communities without social reservation. On Wednesday, Hardik recollected August 25, 2015 as "Patidar Shakti Din" even as tree plantation programmes were held in Gandhinagar, Mehsana and Rajkot to pay homage to those killed.

Case filed for spreading fake information about family

THE SURAT police on Thursday lodged a complaint against unknown persons for spreading fake information about a family on WhatsApp.

According to the complainant, a 20-year-old woman, some unknown persons circulated false news on WhatsApp that she had eloped with her 45-year-old father-in-law, who runs a sand mining business. The content also carried her pictures.

The message also claimed that the woman's husband had announced a reward of Rs 50,000 for information on them. Based on her complaint, Kamrej police registered an offence under IPC sections 500, 507, 509, against unknown persons and started a probe. Talking to The Indian Express, the woman's father-in-law said, "We don't know who had done this to defame us. I got calls from my friends and relatives in Surat as well as from my native place, Junagadh, after seeing the message."

Kamrej police inspector JB Vanar, who is also investigating the case, said, "We are taking help from the cyber cell department in Surat at rural police to crack the case."
