1.26 million subscriber additions to ESIC in April, same as FY20

New Delhi, June 24

A TOTAL OF 1.26 million new subscribers joined various social security schemes run by Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) in April this year, similar to the monthly average of new subscribers joined in 2019-20, the year that preceded the pandemic.

ESIC is applicable to all factories and other establishments employing 10 or more persons earning up to ₹21,000 a month. The ESI Act 1948, which governs the corporation, does not apply to the unorganised sector now. In the contributory scheme, the employer contributes 3.25% and the employee 0.75% of the wages towards the scheme.

On an average, 1.24 million people newly registered with the ESIC scheme in a month in 2018-19, which went up to 1.26 million in 2019-20, but fell to a monthly average of 960,000 in 2020-21 when the pandemic hit on the country hard. There were some improvements in the monthly average of new registrations in 2021-22 at 1.24 million, despite the second wave.

TOWARDS A GREEN FUTURE NTPC's installed RE capacity hits 2GW

Power producer commissions 92 MW floating solar capacity in Kerala

STATE-OWNED NTPC ON Friday said its installed renewable energy capacity has crossed the 2 gigawatt mark, with the commissioning of the 92 MW floating solar capacity in Kerala.

The company began commercial operations of the last part capacity of 35 MW out of 92 MW Kayamkulam Floating Solar PV Project at Kayamkulam, Kerala. Most big players complying with card tokenisation

MOST OF THE large merchants have implemented the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) card-on-file tokenisation norms, sources familiar with the matter said.

The RBI on Friday extended the deadline for merchants to delete the card storage data of their customers under the card-on-file tokenisation system by three months till September 30.

As many as 195 million tokens have been issued so far and the number is going up fast, they said, adding that the system is already well-prepared to adopt the new mech-



and debit cards of customers that are saved at their end, and comply with its tokenisation norms by June 30, 2022.

Tokenisation usually refers to the replacement of actual credit and debit card details with an alternate code called the 'token'. This will be unique to a particular combination of card, token user and device. The 'token' can be used in place of an actual card number for online purchases. This is expected to make online transactions a lot safer for customers.

However, the tokenisation of card data will have to be done only with customers' consent, which requires an additional factor of authentication by them.

Exports of castor oil decline amid low demand

IN THE WAKE of lower international demand, especially from China, exports of castor oil have decreased by almost 10% during the first five months of 2022 compared to previous year. As per the data of the Solvent Extractors' Association of India (SEA), during the first five months of 2021, castor oil exports were around 312,000 metric tonne, which has declined to almost 282,000 metric tonne in the current calendar year.

"China is witnessing industrial disruption post the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic. As a result, Chinese buying has gone down by almost 30,000 metric tonne. Demands from other parts of the world also remain the same," says Atul Chaturvedi, president, SEA.

Castor oil and its derivatives are used in many industries, including air-conditioning, air-fuel, pharmaceutical, dyes & chemical and others. With 40% share in India's total exports, China is the biggest buyer of castor oil from India. The USA and the European Countries are also importing castor oil in large quantities from India. Apart from these markets, India also exports castor oil in Middle East and Latin American countries in comparatively smaller quantities.
